This section introduces a report that summarizes the Police Foundation's review of the organization and operations of the Atlantic City, New Jersey Department of Public Safety. This was accomplished through a series of meetings and collection of information relevant to the scope of the review.

ORIGIN OF THE REVIEW

Public safety services—police, fire, emergency management, and beach patrol—in the City of Atlantic City are an executive branch responsibility housed in the Department of Public Safety. The growth of the Department has paralleled the growth of the City following the approval of casino gambling two decades ago.

The Mayor and the Director of Public Safety want to ensure that the development of the Department and the provision of public safety services in Atlantic City are organized, staffed, and managed to provide high-quality, cost-effective services. Accordingly, the City retained the Police Foundation to complete a review of the Department, with special emphasis on the Police Division.

OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE

The organization and operations review was framed by the following objectives:

- To evaluate the overall organization and operation of the Department of Public Safety with special emphasis on the Police Division.
- To identify strengths of and opportunities for improving the costeffective and efficient delivery of public safety and law enforcement services.
- To recommend actions for improving police services and the overall management of police and other public safety services for the City of Atlantic City.

The scope of the review included the overall organization of the Department of Public Safety and the organization and operations of the Police Division. The review did not include an evaluation of the performance of any employee of the City of Atlantic City.

APPROACH

The review of the organization and operations of the Department of Public Safety and Police Division was accomplished primarily on site and included:

- Interviews with the Mayor and Business Administrator.
- Interviews with officers, supervisors, and managers in the Police Division, at the department director level, and throughout City government.
- Observations of police operations, including patrol and community policing.
- Assembly, analysis, and review of workload data, crime reports, and related information including:
 - Department policies, procedures, and general orders
 - The Code of the City of Atlantic City
 - State of New Jersey statutes
 - Litigation summaries
 - News articles
- Identification and development of opportunities for improvement.
- Interim reports to, and meetings with, the Director of Public Safety and his staff.

The observations and analyses led to the development of the recommendations that are included in this final report.

REPORT ORGANIZATION

The report of the review of the organization and operations of the Department of Public Safety is organized as follows:

- I. Introduction (this section).
- II. Executive Summary—presents a snapshot of the key opportunities for improving the organization and operations of the Department and the Police Division and the recommendations that stem from the opportunities.
- III. Department Organization and Operations—discusses the relationship between the Department of Public Safety and the Police Division and the management and delivery of police services.
- IV. Protocols Affecting Police Operations—considers the opportunities to revise and improve the policies and general orders that guide the operations of the Atlantic City Police.
- Community Support for Public Safety—uses media coverage of the Atlantic City Police as one benchmark for gauging community support.
- VI. Evaluation of the 3-2-1 Police Officer Residency Program—summarizes the results of an initiative that provides mortgage assistance and take-home cars to qualifying officers.
- VII. Appendices—includes supplemental material developed during the operations review.

The Executive Summary accompanies this final report of a review of the organization and operations of the Atlantic City, New Jersey Department of Public Safety. The review was accomplished by the Police Foundation between April and October 1998.

OVERVIEW

Atlantic City's preeminence as America's number one tourist destination creates special public safety challenges. The Mayor and Council of the City of Atlantic City house responsibility for meeting the public safety challenges in the Department of Public Safety, an organizational unit that includes the:

- Police Division
- Fire Division
- Beach Patrol and Emergency Management Division

The Police Foundation reviewed the organization and operations of the Department of Public Safety. The review, which placed special emphasis on the Police Division, was guided by the objectives of identifying the strengths of and opportunities for improving the organization of the Department and the delivery of police services. The objectives included as well the development of recommendations based on the opportunities that were identified. The review did not include an evaluation of the performance of any employee of the City of Atlantic City.

OBSERVATIONS

Police services in Atlantic City are framed by the dedication of its police officers. Atlantic City's police are highly responsive—average response time to a call-for-service is less than three minutes—and tailor the operation of the Police Division to meet the unique requirements of the resort community.

Substantial emphasis has been placed by the Department on developing and implementing a community policing program. Community policing is structured to provide police services that complement patrol operations in zones ranging from the Boardwalk to Venice Park. Community policing is working well but can be improved by closer coordination with patrol operations. The eventual integration of patrol and community policing presents a major opportunity for improving police services in Atlantic City.

The City of Atlantic City recognizes that policing is part of the overall make-up of the community and that policing effectiveness is complemented by the presence of police officers who live in the community. Accordingly, the City has developed and implemented the 3-2-1 Police Officer Residency Program that provides mortgage assistance and forgiveness terms in addition to take-home cars to Atlantic City police officers who live in Atlantic City. The program works. Visibility and community commitment by police officers are two important benefits.

Police operations can improve substantially as outdated rules and regulations are revised. The improvement can be enhanced by better information sharing, including roll-call training for police officers.

Implementing management improvements, especially training and employee performance evaluation, will help increase public support for the Atlantic City Police and will also improve internal accountability. Based on a review of over 1,500 newspaper articles spanning five years, public perception of the Atlantic City Police is adversely affected by discipline, sexual harassment, and civil litigation issues. All of these issues can be mitigated by attention to training and standardization of rules, regulations, and operating procedures.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Develop a longterm plan for integrating patrol and community policing functions.

The Department of Public Safety should be responsible for overall planning and allocation of resources, as well as quality.

The Police Division should be responsible for day-to-day operations.

Performance evaluations should be implemented.

The rank of Lieutenant should be phased into the structure. An emphasis on community policing should frame the operational strategy of the Atlantic City Police. As part of the strategy, a long-term plan for integrating patrol and community policing resources should be developed. The plan should emphasize the involvement of Atlantic City's police in the community and the success of specific programs in promoting that involvement, e.g., the 3-2-1 Police Officer Residency Program.

As a complement to the emphasis on community policing, the overall planning and allocation of police resources should be accomplished at the Department of Public Safety level. Department level focus will ensure that community-wide concerns, such as fire service and emergency management planning and coordination, are considered when police resource allocation decisions are made.

Day-to-day police operations planning, and personnel assignment to specific posts and tasks should be accomplished at the Police Division level. Quality control of police operations should be the responsibility of the Chief of Police and the Police Division management team.

Quality assurance concerning police services should be the responsibility of the Director of Public Safety. Quality assurance should be coordinated by a department-wide professional standards unit that reports to the Director of Public Safety.

Day-to-day operations improvement and increased accountability should include a structured evaluation of the performance of police officers. The development of the performance evaluation system should be accompanied by the development of a program that provides training for police supervisors in the evaluation process.

The rank structure of the Police Division should be modified to phase in the rank of lieutenant and scale back the number of captain positions. This change will improve the management of police operations, especially patrol, by increasing accountability and defining more clearly the role of sergeants and captains and will extend the career ladder of police officers.

III. DEPARTMENT ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

This section of the report focuses on the overall organization of the Department of Public Safety and the organization and operations of the Police Division.

OVERVIEW

Organization

The City of Atlantic City Department of Public Safety is responsible for protecting Atlantic City's 36,000 residents and up to 200,000 daily visitors. The Department is managed by the Director of Public Safety and is organized into three operating divisions:


- Police
- Fire
- Emergency Services/Beach Patrol

The overall organization of the Department is shown in Exhibit III-1.

The Police Division—known typically as the "Police Department"—provides a full range of police services. The Division is organized into two bureaus, Field Operations and Support Services, and includes:

- Patrol
- Community Policing
- Traffic
- Investigations
- Booking and Detention
- Communications
- Internal Affairs
- Various administrative services


Atlantic City Department of Public Safety




Staffing

Police services are provided by 419 sworn personnel and 112 civilians. The rank structure in the Police Division is organized into five levels: Chief of Police (1), Inspector (2), Captain (26), Sergeant (59), and Police Officer (331).

Calls-for-Service

Atlantic City's police receive approximately 300,000 calls-for-service annually. These calls-for-service result in a response that includes some form of police action. Response time, with few exceptions, is three minutes or less. This response time compares favorably with response profiles of other cities.

Deployment

Patrols are deployed in zones throughout the City. The zones conform generally to established neighborhoods. Investigations are managed on a city-wide basis. Liaison with the casinos is coordinated by an officer who is assigned at each casino. Booking and detention, communications, internal affairs, and other division-wide operations are centrally managed.

Community policing deployment is focused in eight designated neighborhood areas. Sixty officers are assigned to community policing activities in these neighborhoods. Additionally, 55 officers who participate in the 3-2-1 program provide off-duty, community-oriented services in their neighborhoods.

Budget

The current year operating budget for the Police Division is \$38 million, excluding benefits which are budgeted on a city-wide basis.

OBSERVATIONS

Strengths

The Department of Public Safety and its operating units appear to provide high quality public safety services to Atlantic City's residents and visitors. From fire prevention and suppression to hurricane evacuation planning and ocean rescues, the Department and its operating units are regarded highly. This report focuses only on the overall organization and operations of the Police Division. Observations and recommendations, therefore, will be limited to areas within this scope.

The strengths of the Atlantic City Police—especially the dedication of its personnel—are the foundation for the improvements identified in this report.

Governance and Management

Notwithstanding the common reference to the "Atlantic City Police Department," the Police Division is in fact an operating unit of the Department of Public Safety. The department model concentrates services that affect all divisions in a department-wide unit and delegates direct services and operations to the divisions. Under this model, the overall planning for police service resource allocation, for example, is based at the department level, while planning and deploying patrol units on a particular shift is a division level responsibility.

The operating relationship between the department level and the division level is in transition and is being developed by the Director of Public Safety and the new Chief of Police. The transition will likely result in an alignment of responsibility that differs from the model that was in place while the Police Division was led by an Acting Chief.

The overall roles of the Director of Public Safety and Chief of Police are framed by the Code of the City of Atlantic City, and New Jersey Statutes Annotated 40A:14-118, known as the Police Chief's Responsibility Act. A copy of the statute and accompanying analysis are included as Appendix A to this report.

Consistent with the Code and New Jersey Statute, the Director of Public Safety is responsible and accountable for all service areas of the Department of Public Safety. The Chief of Police is a key manager and member of the Public Safety team, not the leader of an autonomous unit of city government.

The Director, working with the Chief, is responsible for the planning and allocation of police resources and for ensuring that quality control is maintained. The Chief, working with the Inspectors and Captains, is responsible for the day-to-day assignment, management, and supervision of police services, and for the maintenance of standards of police conduct.

Governance and management of police operations appear to be affected by:

- The absence of a system for evaluating the performance of individual police officers.
- Operating autonomy of departmental units.

- · Outdated and incomplete rules and regulations.
- Inadequate training programs and opportunities, including leadership training.

These opportunities for improvement have been identified as high priorities by the Director of Public Safety and the Chief of Police.

Patrol Operations

Patrol—the basic building block of a police department—operates separately from community policing. As a result, there is the potential for improved coordination between the two units.

About 15,000 calls-for-service were received by the ACPD in June 1998. The call-for-service pattern on an hour-by-hour basis is typical of an urban police department. There is a drop in calls after 0200.

Response time to calls-for-service appears to be excellent. Response time reflects the availability of patrol, community policing, and marked traffic units on the street and the communications center operating effectiveness.

Patrol platoons appear to operate differently by shift. The shifts do not rotate, creating the potential for the appearance of three separate "police departments" in the City.

Patrol officers receive information during a roll call at the outset of each shift. Roll-call training, e.g., orientation to new statutes, does not occur regularly. The isolation among the three shifts is reinforced by lack of training for patrol officers and by the absence of current rules and regulations.

Community Policing

Community policing appears to have the management attention of the ACPD and appears to benefit from strong community-wide support. Community policing's principal strengths include visibility. On a bicycle or in a patrol car, community policing officers have a visible presence citywide. The presence was increased by the recent decision to make the Boardwalk area a community-policing zone.

Community policing is affected by a lack of performance measures used to allocate resources and by community policing's apparent intentional separation from patrol.


Community policing visibility is enhanced by the 3-2-1 Police Officer Residency Program that provides mortgage assistance and forgiveness terms in addition to take-home cars to Atlantic City police officers. The program, supported by a grant from Casino Reinvestment Development Authority and design assistance from the Police Foundation, makes it clear that police officers live in, work in, and are committed to, Atlantic City's neighborhoods.

Community policing is affected by a lack of performance measures used to allocate resources and by community policing's apparent intentional separation from patrol. This issue presents a major opportunity for improvement of the ACPD.

Resource Allocation

The police department's growth—currently 419 sworn officers—parallels the growth of Atlantic City following the approval of casino gambling 20 years ago. In 1978, there were approximately 200 sworn personnel. The Atlantic City Police appear to have less concern about budgets than the concern demonstrated by other large municipal police departments. Resource allocation decisions do not have the built-in requirement to set priorities that is found in typical police agencies. Consequently, units located throughout the organization, e.g., the Police Athletic League and County Major Crimes Squad, would benefit from scrutiny to determine if the personnel assignment justifies the expense.

Rank Structure

The absence of the rank of lieutenant in the Police Division affords an opportunity for improvement. The jump from sergeant to captain dilutes the importance of the captain position and does not provide adequate career steps for officers, especially those in uniform positions.

Training

Training warrants attention on a division-wide basis. Training opportunities are too few overall and management training is virtually nonexistent. Further, there appears to be a common practice of accommodating training requests if the requesting officer pays for his or her own tuition and fees. Training is too important to be managed in this manner.

Performance Evaluations

Lastly, the absence of performance evaluations and the lack of knowledge on the part of supervisors on how to evaluate personnel present major barriers to improving the overall effectiveness of the Atlantic City Police. Without a performance evaluation system, the Department lacks the tools necessary for management to hold staff accountable for their actions.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Governance and Management

Overall responsibility for public safety should be vested in the Director of Public Safety.

Overall responsibility for public safety should, consistent with the Code of the City of Atlantic City, be vested in the Director of Public Safety. The Director, reporting directly to the Mayor, should be responsible for:

- Planning and managing the overall strategy for police, fire, emergency management, and beach patrol services.
- Directing and evaluating the performance of the Chief of Police, Chief of Fire, and Chief of Emergency Management and Beach Patrol.
- Directing the central management services that support the operating divisions. These services include:

- Planning and Research
- Budget, Finance and Personnel (in support of city-wide management of these services)
- Staff Development and Training
- Special Funding Management, including Federal program funding and Federal and state asset forfeiture funding
- Mayor and Council protocol and protection
- Coordinating intelligence activities with Federal, State of New Jersey, and County of Atlantic law enforcement agencies.

The Director should establish a professional standards unit.

Further, the Director should establish and be responsible for a department-wide professional standards unit. The unit should investigate complaints against Department personnel or personnel of its operating divisions, e.g., police and fire.

Overall planning for public safety service response, e.g., the designation of patrol zones, should be a department-level responsibility.

Police Operations

The Director and Chief should develop a plan for integrating patrol and community policing. The Director and Chief should jointly develop a plan for integrating patrol and community-policing operations over a three-year period. The first step in the integration process occurred with the recent reorganization in Field Operations and should be expanded in accord with a plan.

As part of the police operations planning process, the establishment of, and assignment to, special units throughout the Police Division should be evaluated.

Budget, Finance, and Personnel Management

Consistent with the City of Atlantic City's decision to centralize personnel, budget, and finance for all departments, coordination between these city-wide services and the Department of Public Safety should be housed in the Director's office.

Rank Structure

The rank of lieutenant should be phased into the Police Division table of organization. The goal should be to reduce captain billets while establishing lieutenant billets. Patrol should receive the initial allocation of lieutenant assignments.

Training

Training should receive high priority.

Training should receive high priority. Responsibility for planning training should be at the department level. Managing and scheduling training should be a division-level responsibility. The overall training budget and the monitoring of training performance and accomplishment should be coordinated at the department level.

Performance Evaluation

Police officer performance should be evaluated as part of a structured performance evaluation system. Integral to the establishment of the evaluation system should be training for supervisors in how to evaluate employee performance.

IV. PROTOCOLS AFFECTING POLICE OPERATIONS

This section of the report focuses on the policies, rules, regulations, and general orders of the Atlantic City Police

OVERVIEW

Atlantic City police officers are guided by rules and regulations that stem from Federal law, New Jersey statute, the Code of the City of Atlantic City, the City of Atlantic City Personnel Manual, Attorney General guidelines, general and special orders, and bargaining unit agreements.

As part of the operations review of the Atlantic City Police, the Department Rules and Regulations, Department General Orders, New Jersey Statutes Annotated, Code of the City of Atlantic City, and bargaining unit contract were considered. This process led to the observations and recommendations that follow.

OBSERVATIONS

The framework for guiding police operations in Atlantic City can be improved. Outdated general orders and inconsistent rules and regulations need to be revised. This revision needs to be accompanied by a review of the Code of the City of Atlantic City to ensure that the operating relationship between and among the Police Division, Department of Public Safety, and other City agencies is clear.

As part of the revision process, the rules and regulations need to be reviewed for conformance with the State of New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines and New Jersey Statutes Annotated.

The revision process can be accomplished as part of the revised organization plan of the Department of Public Safety. Final revision of the Rules and Regulations needs to be coordinated with the approval of a new bargaining unit agreement for Atlantic City police officers.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Revision and adoption of the Police Division Rules and Regulations should be deferred until the:

- Reorganization envisioned by the Director of Public Safety is completed.
- Ratification of a current agreement with the police officer bargaining unit occurs.

The revised Police Division Rules and Regulations should be a subset of revised Department of Public Safety Rules and Regulations and the City of Atlantic City Personnel Manual.

V. COMMUNITY SUPPORT FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

This section of the report uses newspaper coverage as a benchmark for gauging community support of police operations.

OVERVIEW

Community support for police services is affected by a variety of qualitative and quantitative factors. The overall level of support stems from judgments—mostly subjective—of individuals, ad hoc groups, and established enterprises, e.g., neighborhood associations and the casino association. One benchmark for assessing community support is the coverage that the Atlantic City Police receive in the local newspaper.

As part of the operations review of the Atlantic City Police, a review of newspaper coverage from January 1993 through August 1998 was conducted. A listing of over 1,500 headlines from *The Press of Atlantic City* during this period is included in Appendix B to this report. This review led to the observations and recommendations that follow.

OBSERVATIONS

A review of newspaper coverage for the five-year period demonstrates that issues not directly associated with the level and quality of police services have consumed disproportionate time and attention from Department and City management. This observation is supported by the summaries in Exhibit V-1. These issues include:

- Litigation and settlements associated with sexual harassment, recruiting, retention, and other personnel concerns.
- Disputes concerning the design and overall management of the Department of Public Safety.

When the high profile litigation and organization issues are set aside, no single area of police services dominates newspaper coverage. This even distribution of coverage suggests that community support as measured by newspaper articles has been fairly constant for the five-year period.

Community support (as indicated by the absence of significant conflict) appears to validate the success of the community policing initiative and the presence of police officers in Atlantic City's neighborhoods.

RECOMMENDATIONS

A quarterly review and categorization of *The Press of Atlantic City* coverage should be accomplished by the Department of Public Safety professional standards unit. This review should focus on identifying trends and community concerns. This review should be independent of the Department's public and media relations initiatives.

ACPD SUMMARY The Press of Atlantic City

The following references are a summary of the articles that appeared in *The Press of Atlantic City* newspaper between 1993 and 1997 involving the Atlantic City Police Department (ACPD). This summary does not include every article in which the ACPD was mentioned, however it covers the majority of the articles that have a direct impact on issues of management and liability. It is important to note that some of the stories have several articles.

- Brod, J. (1995, October 27). Atlantic City detective charged with assault by auto, DWI. The Press of Atlantic City. The Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office charged an Atlantic City detective with assault by auto and DWI plus other motor vehicle charges for allegedly striking a pedestrian one morning in Atlantic City.
- Degener, R. (1996, December 28). Ventnor man sues A.C. police over alleged brutality. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A Ventnor man is suing the city Police Department, accusing officers of brutality. The man says he was beaten after being pulled over for a traffic violation. Damages unspecified.
- Diamond, M. (1993, March 17). A Pleasantville man sues A.C. cop over false charge. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A Pleasantville man has sued a police officer here for putting him through a municipal court trial when the officer knew he was innocent of a careless driving charge. Damages unspecified.
- Keough, W. (1993, July 25). A.C. cops sue city for \$1M. back pay. The Press of Atlantic City. A suit filed against the city Police Department charges that since 1990 more than half the Department's officers have been required to work thousands of hours of overtime for no pay. Damages sought: \$1 million. (Additional articles: 7-27-93; 3-17-93)
- Keough, W. (1993, July 31). Mother plans to sue A.C. police for \$10M. in son's jail death. The Press of Atlantic City. The mother of a 24-year-old man who was found dead in a cell at the Atlantic City Police Department has notified the city she intends to sue, alleging negligence led to his death. Damages sought: \$10 million.
- Keough, W. (1994, February 18). Atlantic City must pay fired cop \$83,000 in back pay. The Press of Atlantic City. A former patrolman, fired for fighting another officer and then later barred from being a police officer for racially harassing a black woman, is entitled to nearly two years back pay. The back pay is for the fight. The harassment issue is pending. Damages: \$183,000, includes \$100,000 in legal fees. (Additional article: 7-27-95)

- Levine, S. (1996, February 14). A.C. police sued for sexual harassment. The Press of Atlantic City. A female police sergeant sued the Police Department for sexual harassment claiming a hostile atmosphere was created by constant sexually denigrating innuendos and graffiti. Damages: \$1.3 million, later reduced to \$875,000. (Additional articles: 2-1-96; 1-15-96; 12-14-95; 11-28-95; 6-26-93)
- Peele, T. (1996, February 4). ACPD officers say racist works in their ranks. *The Press of Atlantic City*. The Knights, a group of black Atlantic City officers, had a self-appointed mission to keep an eye on white Atlantic City officers who had a history of brutality against nonwhites.
- Peele, T. (1997, July 24). Sex-suit target leaves ACPD. The Press of Atlantic City. City Council agreed to a retirement payment for the Captain who was a central figure in a sexual harassment suit. Damages: \$68,258. (Additional articles: 12-20-96;10-15-96)
- Peele, T. (1997, July 25). A.C. police investigate claims white cops beat black suspect. *The Press of Atlantic City*. After the suspect was handcuffed following a struggle with officers in a stairwell, three residents of the apartment building claim he was beaten and kicked until he was bleeding and begging for his life. Damages pending. (Additional article: 9-4-97).
- Peele, T. (1997, October). A.C. tow-lot supervisor arrested. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A former city police officer who supervised the municipal tow lot was arrested on charges that he stole more than \$16,000 from payments made for the return of impounded vehicles.
- Peele, T. (1997, July). A.C. detective charged in theft of cocaine. The Press of Atlantic City. An Atlantic City Police detective was arrested on charges he stole cocaine from an evidence drawer in the Department's vice unit. The detective was charged with misconduct and released on a summons. He is the third department employee arrested and subsequently suspended without pay in the past ten days. (Additional article: 10-97).
- Peele, T. (1997, November 19). A.C. cop allegedly drinking at time of hunting incident in EHC. The Press of Atlantic City. An Atlantic City Police officer charged with illegal deer hunting and assault was drinking and repeatedly hitting and shoving the state Division of Fish, Game and Wildlife officer who arrested him.
- Pope, L. (1995, March 1). A.C. cop denies hitting woman during 1990 arrest. *The Press of Atlantic City*. Two police officers were accused of punching, kicking, and cursing a woman whom they arrested on a disorderly charge. The officers were later cleared of the charges.
- Pope, L. (1995, March 5). A.C. cop accused of beating a suspect after a drug raid. The Press of Atlantic City. A narcotics detective was accused of beating a suspect during a drug raid. The officer was later acquitted of the charges. (Additional articles: 5-16-95; 3-31-95;4-21-93)

- Pritchard, M. (1997, January 28). A.C. cop fired for using a racial epithet. *The Press of Atlantic City*. An A.C. police officer was overheard using a racial slur while arresting a black suspect on trespassing charges near the Atlantic City library.
- Russell, T. (1997, June 5). Civil jury awards A.C. man \$171G. for mistreatment on way to jail. The Press of Atlantic City. The jury found that an Atlantic City police officer was negligent and acted in a malicious, wanton and willful manner in his treatment of a prisoner. Damages: \$171,000.
- Shelly, K. (1993, January 4). Board: Stop use of slurs by A.C. cops. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A draft report by a civilian advisory board on police organization and training recommends the City take firm steps to stem the use of racial epithets and abusive language by police officers.
- Staff Report (1997, May 3). A.C. cop faces DWI charges in Margate. The Press of Atlantic City. An off-duty Atlantic City patrol officer was charged with driving while intoxicated in Margate.
- Staff Report (1996, July 19). A.C. police and hospital face lawsuit over death of woman's brother. *The Press of Atlantic City*. The wife of a mob underboss intends to sue the Police Department and hospital over the unsolved death of her brother. Damages unspecified.
- Staff Report (1994, May 21). A.C. to pay \$10,000 to man officer allegedly assaulted. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A tourist alleged that an Atlantic City police officer grabbed his testicles to punish him for seeking the services of a prostitute. Damages: \$10,000.
- Swift, A. (1996, October 12). A.C. police sued for wrongful termination. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A police officer who secretly recorded fellow officers who were later charged by the FBI in a drug case, sued the Police Department for subsequently terminating his employment. Damages: \$3.1 million. (Additional articles: 7-22-96; 7-20-96; 7-12-96; 7-11-96; 7-10-96; 7-5-96; 6-28-96; 6-21-96; 5-24-96; 5-17-96; 6-10-93; 5-19-93)
- Swift, A. (1996, July 26) A.C. police face another lawsuit. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A captain, who testified in the wrongful termination lawsuit against the Department, has filed a lawsuit concerning his transfer. The suit claims that the transfer is in retaliation for his testimony that resulted in a verdict against the Department. Damages unspecified.
- Swift, A. (1996, September 21). ACPD hit with \$7.7M suit. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A Jewish police officer says the Atlantic City Police Department and the Chief of Police committed fraud by inducing him to settle a previous lawsuit. Damages sought: \$7.7 million.
- Swift, A. (1996, November 23). A.C. police department hit with another lawsuit. *The Press of Atlantic City*. The ex-wife of a former police officer imprisoned for shooting at her new

- husband is suing the City and the Police Department, alleging they did not investigate a prior shooting and hindered Internal Affairs probes. Damages unspecified.
- Swift, A. (1997, May 3). A.C. dispatcher files lawsuit for supervisor's alleged exposure. *The Press of Atlantic City*. Female dispatcher filed a law suit alleging that her supervisor exposed himself and that other officers ignored guidelines to prevent sexual harassment. Damages sought: \$18.5 million.
- Swift, A. (1998, March 5). A.C. loses appeal over police sergeant's disputed pay. *The Press of Atlantic City*. City lost appeal to prevent a sergeant involved in two drunken-driving crashes from collecting back pay. Damages: \$13,359.
- Tyler, M. (1997, April 25). Public Safety Director calls ACPD 'racist'. The Press of Atlantic City. "The reality is that the Atlantic City Police Department is a racist department. There's no question that there are individuals with different biases and I have been taking a look at it. The Department's racist attitude and perception among residents, deployment practices and internal squabbling must all change in a team effort."
- Tyler, M. (1997, September 4). Female cop harassed A.C. woman. *The Press of Atlantic City*. Residents in an apartment complex allege that an officer took off her service weapon, directed racial slurs at the victim, challenged her to a fight, and pushed her head into a wall.
- Tyler, M. (1996, February 2). Cop probed in alleged sex assault. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A.C. detective under investigation in connection with an alleged sexual assault. The detective was on duty and driving a police car at the time of the alleged assault. (Additional Articles: 3-20-96; 2-1-96)
- Tyler, M. (1996, May 5). Civilian A.C. police employee files a sex-harass lawsuit. *The Press of Atlantic City*. A police clerk-typist, accuses her former supervisor of grabbing her breast. Damages unspecified.
- Tyler, M. (1997, March 1). A.C. cop suspended for trading leniency for favors from citizens. The Press of Atlantic City. A.C. detective suspended without pay pending a departmental hearing. The detective allegedly asked a casino executive to give his wife a job in exchange for leniency in a traffic matter. (Additional article: 3-13-97)

VI. EVALUATION OF THE 3-2-1 POLICE OFFICER RESIDENCY PROGRAM

This section of the report summarizes the results of an initiative that provides mortgage assistance and take-home cars to qualifying officers.

OVERVIEW

The link between residency and community commitment of police officers has been assumed for years. The Atlantic City Police determined that having police officers live in the City is a benefit for the community. Accordingly, with the sponsorship of the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority and design support from the Police Foundation, the City of Atlantic City implemented a program that provides benefits ranging from mortgage assistance to take-home cars for police officers.

The Police Foundation evaluated the effectiveness of the 3-2-1 program. The evaluation report is included as Appendix D to this report.

OBSERVATIONS

The 3-2-1 Program works. Police presence in, and commitment to, the community appears to have increased. To date, 32 officers receive mortgage assistance and take-home cars. An additional 23 officers have take-home cars only. All 55 participants provide off-duty community policing presence and services in their neighborhoods.

An important element of 3-2-1 is the week-long training module for officers in the program. Only half of the officers who were scheduled for training participated in the week-long session. Officers who did participate became more knowledgeable about the goals of 3-2-1 including:

- Increasing familiarity with Atlantic City's neighborhoods.
- Increased police presence.
- Deterring crime.
- Strengthening communication and collaboration among police and neighborhood residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The 3-2-1 Police Officer Residency Program should continue. Modification should be considered as presented in the evaluation report included as Appendix D.

These appendices to the operations review include information that supports and supplements the observations and recommendations.

MEMORANDUM

Re:

Inter-relationship between municipal police chief
and municipal police director

Submitted by: Thomas M. McCormack, Esq. 1

This memorandum sets forth a brief overview of the respective rules and responsibilities among the governing body, the police director/director of public safety, and the chief of police in a New Jersey municipality.

If a municipality is desirous of establishing a law enforcement unit or police force, the governing body must adopt an ordinance creating same and providing for a line of authority relating to the police function. If the ordinance creates the position of chief of police, it shall further provide that the chief shall be directly responsible for the efficiency and routine day-to-day operation of said police force.

POLICE DIRECTOR/DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY

A municipality may, in addition to the foregoing, create through said ordinance the position commonly referred to as police director. Generally, the police director is vested with policy making authority and, if so designated, shall serve as the "appropriate authority" vested with powers to establish rules and regulations for the governance of the police force and the discipline of its members.

As a department director the police director serves at the pleasure of the appointing authority.

CHIEF OF POLICE

Subject to the rules and regulations established by the governing body or the police director, the chief of police shall be responsible for (a) the administration and enforcement of rules and regulations; (b) discipline of the force, its officers and personnel;

(c) prescribe the duties and assignments for all subordinates and other personnel; (d) delegation of his authority as he/she deems necessary for the efficient operation of the force; (e) report at least monthly to the director and/or the governing body on the operation of the force.

Apparently, in response to friction between municipal governments' attempts to hold police chiefs and their subordinates accountable and police administration's attempts on the other hand to resist what they perceive to be political interference with the duties of the chief of police, the legislature enacted amendments to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118 effective August 24, 1981. (Copy is annexed hereto.) This statute, commonly referred to as the Police Chief Responsibility Act, endeavors to set forth a statutory scheme to address these competing interests.

Unless a municipality has, in the creation of its police force, complied with the statutory procedure the demarcation of the respective rights of a police director and a police chief may not only be unclear, but also unenforceable.

The governing body of any municipality, by ordinance, may create and establish, as an executive and enforcement function of municipal government, a police force, whether as a department or as a division, bureau or other agency thereof, and provide for the maintenance, regulation and control thereof. Any such ordinance shall, in a manner consistent with the form of government adopted by the municipality and with general law, provide for a line of authority relating to the police function and for the adoption and promulgation by the appropriate authority of rules and regulations for the government of the force and for the discipline of its members. The ordinance may provide for the appointment of a chief of police and such members, officers and personnel as shall be deemed necessary, the determination of their terms of office, the fixing of their compensation and the prescription of their powers, functions and duties, all as the governing body shall deem necessary for the effective government of the force. Any such ordinance, or rules and regulations, shall provide that the chief of police, if such position is established, shall be the head of the police force and that he shall be directly responsible to the appropriate authority for the efficiency and routine day to day operations thereof, and that he shall, pursuant to policies established by the appropriate

- a. Administer and enforce rules and regulations and special emergency directives for the disposition and discipline of the force and its officers and personnel;
- b. Have, exercise, and discharge the functions, powers and duties of the force:
- c. Prescribe the duties and assignments of all subordinates and other personnel;
- d. Delegate such of his authority as he may deem necessary for the efficient operation of the force to be exercised under his direction and supervision; and
- e. Report at least monthly to the appropriate authority in such form as shall be prescribed by such authority on the operation of the force during the preceding month, and make such other reports as may be requested by such authority.

As used in this section, "appropriate authority" means the mayor, manager, or such other appropriate executive or administrative officer, such as a full-time director of public safety, or the governing body or any designated committee or member thereof, or any municipal board or commission established by ordinance for such purposes, as shall be provided by ordinance in a manner consistent with the degree of separation of executive and administrative powers from the legislative powers provided for in the charter or form of government either adopted by the municipality or under which the governing body operates.

Except as provided herein, the municipal governing body and individual members thereof shall act in all matters relating to the police function in the municipality as a body, or through the appropriate authority if other than the governing body.

Nothing herein contained shall prevent the appointment by the governing body of committees or commissions to conduct investigations of the operation of the police force, and the delegation to such committees or commissions of such powers of inquiry as the governing body deems necessary or to conduct such hearing or investigation authorized by law. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the appropriate authority, or any executive or administrative officer charged with the general administrative responsibilities within the municipality, from examining at any time the operations of the police force or the performance of any officer or member thereof. In addition, nothing herein contained shall infringe on or limit the power or duty of the appropriate authority to act to provide for the health, safety or welfare of the municipality in an emergency situation through special emergency directives.

APPENDIX C: SELECTION, TRAINING AND PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT

This appendix to the report considers the selection, training, and performance assessment of police officers.

Issues surrounding the selection and training of Atlantic City police officers are apparent. A number of highly publicized cases dealing with harassment and sexual misconduct have been costly to the Department. In one recent academy class, all of the African-American candidates failed to become police officers. In fact, the only recruits who did not succeed in the academy were African Americans. This circumstance raises issues as to the recruitment process as well as the level of training and other resources provided to see that qualified candidates succeed in the Department.

It is important to consider the caliber of individuals selected so that they will:

- Be successful in the academy.
- Be successful as police officers in the Department.
- Demonstrate an absence of behavior that brings embarrassment or expense to the Department.

Typical selection models include a "screening in" and a "screening out" model. In the former, individuals with qualities deemed important for good performance are selected. In the latter, individuals are screened out based on indicators from their past and/or psychological profiles.

Psychological screening of police has received renewed attention recently. While many departments continue to use clinical instruments such as the Minnesota Multi-phasic Personality Inventory (MMPI) or California Psychological Inventory (CPI), other departments have moved to use more job-relevant scales such as the Inwald Personality Inventory (IPI), or have abandoned psychological screening altogether. A review of the internal screening mechanisms should be conducted to determine alternative strategies that would produce desired results in the most efficient manner.

Screening should be accompanied by a more vigorous attempt to recruit qualified individuals from within the Atlantic City community. Previous discussions with the Department regarding a potential cadet program as a career development tool for young people should be re-opened. This program would provide a more qualified pool of individuals who could potentially be selected into the Atlantic City Police.

Training programs in police departments help to reinforce departmental values and goals, and occasionally provide new skills to help facilitate improved performance. It is important to routinely evaluate the degree to which training (both academy and in-service) is selected consistent with departmental mission and objectives. A training needs assessment should be

conducted to make such a determination. Training in areas of sexual harassment and working in diverse communities is appropriate.

With the transition to community policing, it is difficult to define "good policing". When community policing is a separate unit in a police department, or has been fully integrated as a philosophy, it becomes more important to define the independent roles of traditional and community policing officers. Without role clarity, standards of performance are hard to define. In order, however, to hold officers accountable for their behavior and facilitate the effective delivery of services, a performance management system must be adopted. Such a system includes the development of performance standards, as well as a tool for evaluating police performance. Although there are many problems with traditional performance evaluation tools (e.g., subjectivity and bias), research has demonstrated that such tools can be made more objective by making them more behaviorally based. With such a system, it is difficult to document performance that was not demonstrated. In addition, a comprehensive performance management system provides for remedial intervention (as opposed to straight discipline) when officers are not fulfilling their responsibilities.

This appendix presents a summary of officers' feedback regarding the 3-2-1 Police Officers' Residency Program and associated training.

The 3-2-1 Program was sponsored by the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority (CRDA) working in conjunction with the Atlantic City Police Department and the Police Foundation. The program was designed to create a public safety anchor in the city by encouraging police officers to live in the city in exchange for off-duty services in the neighborhoods. Specifically, the program was designed to stabilize neighborhoods, making them safer and more economically viable for the citizens who live and work in them. Initially, the program was designed to encourage officers to move into the city, but it was concluded that some loans and other incentives would be reserved for those officers already residing in the city.

To date, there are 32 officers in the program who have received mortgages, and an additional 23 who have take-home cars only. All 55 of the officers participating in this program are responsible for providing off-duty community policing services in their respective neighborhoods. Participants in the program include 69% White officers, 25% Black officers, 4% Hispanic officers, and one American Indian (2%). There are 15% females and 85% males in the program. 34% of the officers are in special function assignments, 33% of the officers are assigned to patrol, 22% are in community policing, and the other 11% are in administration.

Last year, the Police Foundation provided a week-long training program for officers who had moved into their homes. The goal of that training program was to provide the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to facilitate the ability of officers to interact more effectively with community residents. The training program was intended to make officers more knowledgeable about the neighborhoods in which they live and serve, make the citizens feel safer, increase police presence in hopes of deterring crime, and provide increased communication and collaboration among police and residents. Since the training was delivered, additional officers have been accepted into the program. A representative of the Department who participated in the training session was to subsequently serve as an internal trainer providing the training program, curriculum, and participant notebook to new 3-2-1 program officers.

To examine resident officers' perceptions regarding the training, and obtain feedback about the program's effectiveness, a follow-up review was recently conducted. The review consisted of a feedback session and individual interviews with participating officers. The information gathered in this review has been summarized as a benchmark for future departmental feedback sessions.

A feedback session was held on the evening of September 30, 1998. Of the 55 officers in the program, 47 (85%) participated in the evaluation feedback session and follow-up interviews.

The feedback session was designed to elicit general responses from the participants, and provide an overview of the upcoming individual interview sessions so that the officers would have some time to reflect on their experiences in the program. The outline and topics covered in the feedback session are presented in Attachment A.

Over the course of the following two days, all officers were scheduled for 20 minute interviews. In the interviews, officers were given the opportunity to discuss suggested improvements, provide general comments and feedback, as well as respond to a number of specific questions regarding the program and training provided. The questions asked during the structured interview are included in Attachment B.

For those officers we interviewed (47 of the 55), the average number of years in the Department was 8.25 with a range of 2 to 25. Forty-five percent had cars only (no mortgages). Of 47 resident officers recently interviewed, 42 (89%) lived in the city prior to their participation in the 3-2-1 program. In other words, the program has effectively attracted 11% of its participants back into the city, and worked to maximize the benefits of existing resident officers. Only 49% of those interviewed had actually received the week-long training program presented by the Police Foundation last year. The remaining individuals we met with apparently did not receive any training or materials, although most claimed to have received the general order.

When comparing those who received training to those who did not, it is very clear that those not receiving training felt a need for it. Whereas 35% of those trained felt more training was necessary, 67% of those who did not get trained felt that they needed it. Many of these individuals felt a need for a general orientation to the program (31%), some also felt the need for the entire week-long session (25%), or information on starting neighborhood groups (25%). The others felt the need for training in survival skills or communication (19%). For those receiving training, just under two-thirds (61%) found the training to be useful. Specifically, the module reported to be most useful was "Culture, Prejudice, and Diversity" (5 individuals). Three officers each reported that the segments entitled "Resources for Crime Control and Police Effectiveness" and "Building Support for Crime Control" were most beneficial. Two other individuals stated that the module on "Conflict Resolution" was the most useful.

Besides considering the reactions of the officers to the training program, we conducted a comparison of the trained (23 officers) versus not-trained (24 officers) groups. Almost half (48%) of the individuals who were trained reported doing things to make residents aware of their presence. For those not trained, only 42% did so. Specifically, 26% of the trained officers made face-to-face contacts with citizens, and 13% created crime prevention programs. For the untrained group, only 17% made contact with citizens and just 8% started crime prevention programs. It appears that participation in the training resulted in a greater level of community interaction.

The results of the interviews showed that officers generally felt that the program was very useful in creating an increased presence and improving the quality of life in their neighborhoods (62%). Many interact more frequently with their neighbors and perform more regular community policing activities. Clearly, this is an indication of the program's success in Atlantic City.

One officer said that as a result of the program, there is increased competition in the neighborhood to fix-up the yards and houses. Another officer said he is personally more conscientious about his own behavior, since the neighbors know him to be a cop. Many officers said that their neighbors come to them more with information or questions. Several officers also stated that their presence helped to get drug dealers out of the neighborhood, deal with landlord-tenant problems, or reduce burglaries.

A number of issues were raised at the feedback session, some of which were repeated in the individual interviews. Many officers indicated a desire for laptop computers in the vehicles so that they can run names, etc. In the individual interviews, 19% of the officers raised this concern. One individual suggested having at least one computer at roll call to indicate problems encountered in the earlier shift. Some officers indicated that more referral sources such as "hot sheets", handbooks, or the Neighborhood Policing Information System (database) developed by the Police Foundation would help them in carrying out their roles. Nine percent of those interviewed stated a desire to use the database, with one person stating that it would be a "big potential loss if it were not used." Although these resources exist, none of the officers who were trained on the database last year have used it since. Most felt it could be very helpful to them. The majority of the other officers had never even heard of it. In any case, in order for this system to be useful, officers will need to update the information by conducting surveys and gathering more up-to-date referral sources.

There was a general consensus from the feedback session that there needs to be more monitoring of the program and its participants; over one-fourth of officers interviewed brought up the need for such monitoring. Four individuals noted that officers in this program needed to get more involved in their neighborhoods. Since there has been no form to follow up on neighborhood activity or to ensure that officers are following the General Order, officers had, earlier in the day, agreed to recommend modifications to the General Order to bring it up-to-date. A couple of individuals interviewed felt the need to change the car requirements (i.e., regarding others riding in the vehicle).

Most feedback session participants also agreed that more regular feedback sessions (in smaller groups) would be helpful. Officers felt that being able to come together with other resident officers would be a plus, and would keep them more aligned since most do not work together in their regular assignments. In the interviews, this was voiced by 13% of those to whom we talked. One officer suggested the need for greater coordination between resident officers,

vice, and patrol, a suggestion that makes sense given some of the successes reported to us using such a collaborative approach. Another officer indicated his desire for a hotline to help him with resolving problems in his area. Regular feedback sessions would provide a forum for the discussion and resolution of such problems and concerns.

In terms of equipment, some officers expressed interest in supplemental equipment in the vehicles for specific types of responses (radios, bike vests, radar guns, etc.). Some expressed concern about not receiving the patrol vehicles due to their assignments, i.e., detective. Although the Department has stated that individuals in assignments requiring unmarked vehicles will not get the cars, many claim that their neighbors already know them to be police officers. Others mentioned a potential need for replacement cars or take-home cars for everyone in the Department.

The vast majority of officers participating in this evaluation expressed concerns about the changes in the program's selection criteria, particularly in the later rounds of the application process, which may have limited access for some interested officers. In fact, many stated that the original neighborhood boundaries and ratings were changed, as were the requirements for only one officer per block and other standards, creating multiple rejections for some applicants across the new loan phases. About one-fourth of the individuals interviewed brought this issue up again.

Overall, officers were extremely favorable about the program, not just because of the personal benefits they received, but also because they believe it works. Many stated that they wished there would be more loans made available so that any police officer who wanted to live in the city could get such an incentive. There seemed to be a genuine sense of pride over being selected as a participant in this program; one officer even stated that the Department should provide a patch or jacket identifying the officers as resident [community] police officers. Finally, two individuals mentioned a very important point: although officer perceptions about the program matter, so too do the perceptions of the residents. These officers suggested that a survey of citizens be conducted in the neighborhoods to assess their perception of the program's success.
