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Introduction

The primary purpose of this Directory is to provide criminal justice researchers with a detailed description of the types of data that are available through the Florida Statistical Analysis Center (SAC). The data bases are readily available upon written request on diskette, 9-track tape, or in printout form.

This document describes the ascii data bases formatted and maintained by the SAC. The Florida SAC uses these data to conduct analyses of the Florida criminal justice system to aid practitioners and policy makers in their efforts to combat crime.

A description of each data base is included which presents a detailed record layout of the data, the nature of the data, and the source of the information. The data files are designed to be used for time series as well as cross-sectional analysis. No personal identifiers exist in the SAC's data bases.
