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PURPOSE OF DUF PROGRAM


- To provide each city with information for—
 Detecting drug epidemics earlier
 Planning allocation of law enforcement resources
 Determining treatment and prevention needs
 Measuring the impact of efforts to reduce drug use and crime.
- To provide national-level estimates of illicit drug use among offenders.
- To track and forecast national drug use trends.



OVERVIEW

- Voluntary urine specimens and anonymous interviews obtained from male and female arrestees.
- Sampling of 200 to 250 new male arrestees and 50 to 100 new female arrestees every 3 months.
- Male arrestees primarily charged with nondrug felony offenses.
- DUF expanded to include juveniles in 1988.
- Response rates consistently high.
- DUF to be expanded to 25 cities in 1989.






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR ANY DRUG, INCLUDING MARIJUANA






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR ANY DRUG, EXCLUDING MARIJUANA










PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR MARIJUANA






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR PCP






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR COCAINE






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR OPIATES






PERCENTAGE OF MALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR AMPHETAMINES







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


PERCENTAGE OF MALE AND FEMALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR MARIJUANA






PERCENTAGE OF MALE AND FEMALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE **FOR PCP**






PERCENTAGE OF MALE AND FEMALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR COCAINE




PERCENTAGE OF MALE AND FEMALE ARRESTEES TESTING POSITIVE FOR AMPHETAMINES



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


PERCENTAGE OF DRUGS FOUND IN MALE AND FEMALE ARRESTEES IN WASHINGTON, D.C.
