THANK YOU PAUL. I'D LIKE TO WELCOME ALL OF YOU TO THIS MEETING. WE'RE GRATEFUL TO YOU FOR PARTICIPATING IN THIS IMPORTANT DISCUSSION.

I'M SURE YOU'VE ALL BEEN READING ABOUT LAST WEEK'S SHOOTING
IN A BETHESDA OFFICE BUILDING. AN EMPLOYEE WALKED IN AND KILLED
THREE OF HIS CO-WORKERS, AND WOUNDED ANOTHER, BEFORE KILLING
HIMSELF. ACCORDING TO REPORTS OF THE INCIDENT, HE WALKED INTO
THE OFFICE, PULLED A GUN OUT OF HIS BAG AND SAID TO ONE OF HIS
CO-WORKERS, "DO YOU KNOW WHAT THIS IS?" AND THE OTHER PERSON
SAID "IT LOOKS LIKE A TOY GUN."

I MENTIONED THIS BECAUSE IT POINTS UP THE CONFUSION BETWEEN TOY GUNS AND THE REAL THING THAT PEOPLE FACE. NOT JUST THE POLICE, BUT EVERYBODY. I'M NOT SAYING THAT THOSE PEOPLE IN THAT OFFICE WOULDN'T HAVE DIED. BUT WE CAN ALL IMAGINE SITUATIONS WHERE BEING ABLE TO TELL THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A REAL GUN AND A TOY COULD AVERT A FATALITY.

I'D LIKE TO SPEAK FOR A MOMENT FROM MY EXPERIENCE AS AN OFFICER.

- O TOY GUN/PELLET GUN -- NEVER GOT A CHANCE TO SEE IT
- O CAR KEYS

CONGRESS PASSED AND THE PRESIDENT SIGNED ON NOVEMBER 4,

1988, LEGISLATION CALLING FOR PENALTIES FOR ENTERING INTO

COMMERCE OF IMITATION FIREARMS. THIS LEGISLATION MAKES IT

"UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO MANUFACTURE, ENTER INTO COMMERCE,

SHIP, TRANSPORT, OR RECEIVE ANY TOY, LOOK-ALIKE, OR IMITATION

FIREARM UNLESS SUCH FIREARM CONTAINS OR HAS AFFIXED TO IT, A

MARKING APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF COMMERCE." THE MARKING

CALLED FOR IN THE LEGISLATION IS A BLAZE ORANGE PLUG INSERTED IN

THE BARREL (SHOW EXAMPLE OF TOY GUN).

THE REGULATION OF SPECIFYING MARKING SYSTEMS GOES INTO

EFFECT ON MAY 5TH, AND THE INSTITUTE IS MANDATED TO CONDUCT A

TECHNICAL EVALUATION OF THE EFFECTIVENESS OF MARKING SYSTEMS IN

POLICE COMBAT SITUATIONS. THIS EVALUATION IS TO BE COMPLETED BY

AUGUST 1989.

CONGRESS ASKED NIJ TO DO THIS EVALUATION, BUT THEY DID NOT

INCLUDE FUNDING IN THE LEGISLATION. THEREFORE, WE'VE BEEN ASSIGNED THE JOB OF SHEDDING SOME LIGHT ON THIS, BUT WE'RE SUPPOSED TO BRING OUR OWN BATTERIES.

WE WANT TO DO THE BEST WE CAN WITH THE MANDATE BEFORE US
BECAUSE WE ARE TALKING ABOUT PEOPLE'S LIVES. AND IN ADDITION,
THIS STATUTE IS LIKELY TO HAVE AN IMPACT ON EVERY POLICE
OPERATION IN THE COUNTRY, AND ON POLICE TRAINING. IT'S ALSO
GOING TO AFFECT THE TOY MANUFACTURERS AND THE PUBLIC.

AS DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTE IT'S BEEN MY GUIDING PHILOSOPHY
THAT PRACTITIONER INVOLVEMENT IS CRITICAL TO RESEARCH AND
DEVELOPMENT. TODAY I AM APPEALING TO YOUR EXPERTISE AND YOUR
PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY TO HELP US WITH OUR MISSION.

WE'VE ORGANIZED THIS MORNING'S PROGRAM TO GIVE YOU THE
BENEFIT OF DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES ON THIS ISSUE. WE'RE GOING TO
BE HEARING FROM RICHARD W. "PETE" VELDE, PREVIOUS COUNSELOR TO
SEN. BOB DOLE, ABOUT THE HISTORY AND INTENT OF THIS LEGISLATION I DON'T KNOW IF ALL OF YOU ARE AWARE THAT AMONG HIS MANY OTHER

ACCOMPLISHMENTS, HE IS THE FOUNDING FATHER OF NIJ -- A MATTER IN WHICH I FEEL A CERTAIN PERSONAL GRATITUDE. IT'S GOOD TO HAVE YOU HERE, PETE. WE'LL BE GETTING LOTS OF OTHER VIEWPOINTS AS WELL -- FROM THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT, REPRESENTED BY STANLEY WARSHAW; FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT, THE PERSPECTIVE THAT MOST OF YOU REPRESENT. WE'RE ALSO PLEASED TO HAVE KEN CARLSON HERE FROM ABT ASSOCIATES, WHO'S BEEN RESEARCHING THIS ISSUE. AND ROBERT REID AND CRAIG PHILLIPS (AMONG OTHERS) REPRESENTING THE MANUFACTURERS.

BUT LET ME UNDERSCORE THE FACT THAT YOU -- ALL OF YOU AROUND THIS TABLE -- ARE THE MAIN SPEAKERS AT THIS MEETING. THOSE ON THE AGENDA THIS MORNING ARE HERE TO GIVE YOU THE INFORMATION YOU NEED. THE MEETING IS REALLY DESIGNED TO GET YOUR INPUT. SO I HOPE ALL OF YOU WILL CONTRIBUTE. WE HAVE PURPOSELY KEPT THIS GROUP SMALL ENOUGH SO THAT WE CAN HEAR ALL OF YOUR OPINIONS.

THAT MAKES YOUR CONTRIBUTION ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT. WE ARE RELYING ON YOUR BRAINPOWER. WE NEED YOUR HELP IN DESIGNING AN EVALUATION PROCEDURE -- AND CARRYING IT OUT. LET ME TELL YOU MY

FIRST THOUGHTS ON HOW WE MIGHT CONDUCT THIS EVALUATION. ONE

POSSIBILITY IS TO GO INTO AN ONGOING TRAINING SITUATION TO SEE IF

POLICE OFFICERS COULD RECOGNIZE THE MARKING UNDER DIFFERENT

LIGHTING CONDITIONS -- FOR EXAMPLE, DURING DAYLIGHT, AT DUSK, AND

AT NIGHT. WE WOULD LIKE TO GET A COUPLE OF POLICE DEPARTMENTS TO

VOLUNTEER TO TEST OFFICERS' RECOGNITION IN COMBAT SITUATIONS -
TO HAVE SOMEONE COME UP WITH A GUN TEST WHETHER THE ORANGE PLUG

IS VISIBLE TO AN OFFICER. OUR GOAL IS AN OBJECTIVE EVALUATION OF

THIS REGULATION. HOW WELL DOES IT WORK? WHAT ARE THE VIRTUES

AND WHAT ARE THE LIMITATIONS -- FOR EXAMPLE, HOW EASILY COULD IT

BE DEFEATED BY DISGUISING OR CONCEALING THE PLUG?

CONCURRENTLY WITH OUR EFFORT, THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE
STATISTICS WILL BE SURVEYING POLICE ABOUT TOY GUN INCIDENTS. WE
ARE ALSO CHECKING WITH INTERPOL, BECAUSE THIS TYPE OF LAW IS
ALREADY IN EFFECT IN ITALY AND SPAIN, AND WE WANT TO UNDERSTAND
THEIR EXPERIENCE WITH IT.

SO ONCE AGAIN, A WARM WELCOME, AND PLEASE, SPEAK OUT. LEND

US YOUR EARS, LEND US YOUR VOICE -- AND PLEASE LEND US A HAND IN CONDUCTING THIS EVALUATION.

OVER THE YEARS THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE HAS PLAYED AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND TESTING OF NEW TECHNOLOGIES THAT AFFECT YOUR DAY-TO-DAY OPERATIONS -- BULLET-PROOF VESTS, POLICE WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION, AND NOW WE'RE WORKING ON LESS THAT LETHAL WEAPONS. THESE DEVELOPMENTS HAVE IMPROVED POLICE OPERATIONS. SOME HAVE SAVED LIVES. THIS KIND OF PROGRESS BENEFITS ALL OF US. IT'S ONLY POSSIBLE WITH YOUR HELP.
