




### TIME SERVED IN PRISON

During 1987 there were 28,134 inmates paroled for the first time from the California Department of Corrections (CDC). The total mean time served in CDC institutions and preconfinement time for felons was 23.6 months, the median time served was 17.1 months.

- The total mean time served including preconfinement time was 24.0 months for males, and 18.7 months for females.
- The mean and median time served in CDC institutions was 16.9 and 12.0 months, respectively.
- The total mean time served in CDC institutions was 17.3 months for males and 12.4 months for females.
- Preconfinement time for males and females was 6.7 and 6.3 months, respectively.

Violent offenders served the longest time in CDC institutions and also served the most preconfinement time. Only in the violent offense category was there a large difference in time served between males and females.

- The total mean time served for violent offenses was 34.8 months, with males serving 6.3 months longer than females (35.1 months for males and 28.8 months for females).
- The total mean time served for property offenses was 19.8 months.
- The total mean time served for drug offenses was 18.1 months.
- The total mean time served for all other offenses was 19.7 months.
