INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institution, satellite housing unit and halfway house under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on December 31, 1989. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Terms.

The Prison Complex includes the New Jersey State Prison, East Jersey State Prison, Bayside State Prison, Riverfront State Prison, Mid-State, Southern State, Northern State Prison and males housed at the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women. The Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC is a facility for adult male sex offenders) and Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women, although a part of the Prison Complex, are reported separately.

The Youth Correctional Complex consists of the Garden State Reception and Youth Correctional Facility, the Albert C. Wagner Youth Correctional Facility, and the Mountainview Youth Correctional Facility. The Juvenile Facilities include the New Jersey Training School for Boys, the Lloyd McCorkle Training School for Boys and Girls and the Juvenile Medium Security Facility.

On December 31, 1989 there were approximately 2936 State-sentenced offenders temporarily housed in County Facilities awaiting transfer into the State Prison System. Characteristics data on these offenders are not included in this report. Similarly, the 1819 Prison and Youth Reception residents, Juvenile Group Center Residents, Kalfway House, County Contract, County Assistance, Central Medical Unit residents are not included in these tabulations.

"Not Coded" are records for offenders in the correctional system for whom admission characteristics data have not been entered into the computerized information system as of December 31, 1989.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The preparation of this report entailed the assistance of numerous individuals and reporting units. The extensive data collection effort was significantly enhanced by the assistance of the Correctional Information and Classification Services Data Base, the Prison and Youth Reception Units and the Correctional Institutions that report to the Data Base daily. Special acknowledgement is given to Mrs. Terry Lihvarcik, Head Statistical Clerk of the Office of Policy Analysis and Planning for the compilation of data and the layout of the report format.

HIGHLIGHTS

Fifty-four percent (54%), or 8430 out of 15572, of <u>all</u> New Jersey Offenders were committed for crimes against persons which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Assault, Robbery, Sodomy, Sexual Abuse and Other Person Offenses. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission, only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in the data.

Almost 50% (7360 out of 15,572) of all New Jersey Offenders were committed with maximum statutory sentences of 10 years or more. Of these, 5% or 768 offenders are serving Life Sentences and 24 offenders are under Capital Sentences.

Sixty-two percent (62%) of New Jersey's offender population is black, while 22% are white and 16% are Hispanic.

Fifty-five percent (55%) of all offenders in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are under 29 years of age.

Of the 21 New Jersey counties, seven (Atlantic, Hudson, Essex, Camden, Union, Passaic, and Monmouth) account for seventy percent (70%) of Total State Correctional Residents. Essex County is the highest contributor with nineteen percent (19%).

Forty-seven percent (47%) of all adult offenders housed in the State System have mandatory minimum sentences.

Twenty-four percent (24%) of all Department of Corrections offenders have been committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution.

OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON DECEMBER 31, 1989 BY BASE OFFENSE

In these tabulations, the Base Offense for an offender is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in the data.

Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery, and other sex offenses i.e. incest, carnal abuse, sodomy and impairing the morals of a minor.

Other Persons Offenses include simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter.


Property Offenses include burglary, arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving or possessing stolen property.

Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, violation of probation, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family related offenses and conspiracy.

Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs.


Sixty percent 60% of the offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of a crime of a violent nature which includes homicide, sexual assault, robbery, sex abuse/sodomy and other persons offenses.

Twenty-eight percent of violent crime offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of homicide.

Almost one half (46%) of all offenders at New Jersey State Prison have been convicted of homicide.






Thirty-two percent (32%) of Juvenile Complex offenders were committed for violent crimes, 40% of which were assaults.

Two hundred forty-five, or 38% of the 650 offenders at the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women were incarcerated for violent crimes or crimes against persons. Thirty-five percent were committed for narcotics law violations and 15% for property offenses.













Eight-one percent (81%) of the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center offenders are 30 years of age or older, with 19% being 50 years of age or older. This compares with 66% of the Prison Complex males who are 30 or older and 5% who are 50 or older.

One half (50%) of the women at the Edna Mahan Facility are aged 25-34 with 205 (32%) being 35 years or older. These figures are relatively consistent with data for adult males in the Prison Complex.



The breakdown of mandatory minimum terms for ADTC residents roughly parallels that for State Prison Complex inmates with fewer, however, serving lengthy mins of 16 or more years.

Eighty-three percent of the female inmates with mandatory minimum terms have mins less than ten years. This compares to 66% in the Prison Complex and 93% in the Youth Complex.
