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INTRODUCTION

This report presents selected demographic data on persons currently incarcerated in the D.C. Department of Corrections' Detention Facility, seven sentencing institutions, Community Correctional Centers (CCC), Out-of-State Prisons (ICC), and Electronic Monitoring. The data used in this report was extracted from the Correctional Records Information System (CRISYS) and covers all persons incarcerated at the end of the First Quarter FY 1992 (12/31/1991). Since this report is descriptive in nature, no indepth analysis is provided. However, highlights of the major findings and summary of the dominant profile characteristics by institutions are included. It should be noted that the findings relating to most of the demographic characteristics are based on self-reported data. This report will be updated and distributed upon request or on a periodic basis.

INSTITUTIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

The following variables were found to represent the dominant profile characteristics for the population of each facility.

DEMOGRAPHIC SUMMARY
CDF AND LORTON

The current incarcerated population housed in D.C. Jail and seven sentencing institutions at the Lorton Complex is 8547, compared to 8101 inmates who were incarcerated during the First quarter of Fiscal Year 1991. This represents a (5.5%) increase over the same quarter in FY 1991.

CHARGES

- Table 1 indicates that persons charged or convicted of violent crimes accounted for 2868 or 33.6% of offense categories. Drug offenses (drug sales and drug possession combined) comprised the largest crime category (3724 or 43.6%), followed by robbery (1229 or 15.5%). Property crimes such as burglary, larceny, and auto theft made up 881 or 10.3% of the remaining categories. Noticeably, violent crimes showed a 12.7% increase, while property crimes decreased by 3.7% and drug law violations increased by 3.9% in comparison with the First quarter of FY 1991. It is noted that Homicide showed a 20.3% increase over the First quarter of FY 1991.

RACE/SEX

- Table 2 shows that 7706 or 90.2% of the population were Black males, while 572 or 6.7% were Black females. White males accounted for 109 or 1.3%, while White females and all other ethnic groups comprised the remaining 1.8%.

MARITAL STATUS

- Table 3 depicts that nearly 7050 or 82.4% of the incarcerated population were single, while 937 or 11.0% were married. Of those remaining 279 or 3.3% were separated and 173 or 2.0% were divorced. Widowed (.4%) and common law (.9%) make up the remaining categories. An increase of 2.0% was noted for the married category in comparison with the same group over the First quarter of FY 1991.

EDUCATION

- The data indicate that 3167 or 37.1% of the inmates incarcerated in the DCDC Facilities completed grade 12, while 4519 or 52.8% completed grades 7 to 11. Only about 8.3% were considered to have an educational level beyond high school. A comparison of the First quarter of FY 1991 and FY 1992 reveals that there was a 3.9% increase noted in the number of inmates who completed high school. (Table 4)

AGE

- Table 5 shows that inmates aged 21-35 accounted for 5331 or 62.4% of the incarcerated population. Persons under 21 made up 660 or 7.7% of the population, while 2556 or 29.9% are between the ages of 36 and above of the total population. The Department's population aged 36 and over increased by 14.5% when compared with the same category over the First quarter of FY 1991.

OCCUPATION

- Analysis reveals that 5102 or 59.7% of the offenders population were unemployed at the time of commitment. Of those employed, 2465 or 28.8% were working in miscellaneous occupations and 599 or 7.0% were employed in the service occupations. The percent of persons who have been unemployed increased by 7.3%, while those who worked in service occupations prior to their commitments increased by 28.3% in comparison with the same categories over the First quarter of FY 1991. (Table 6)

COMMITMENT STATUS

- The data in Table 7 indicate that 6001 or 70.2% of the incarcerated population were classified as sentenced serving, while 1080 or 12.6% were in pre-trial status. Of those remaining, the distribution was DCYRA (6.9%), Other (6.9%) and Guilty-Awaiting Sentencing (3.3%). A decline of 4.9% was noted for the pre-trial population when compared with the same category over the First quarter of FY 1991.


RELIGION

- Further analysis also indicate that 2073 or 24.3% were Protestants, followed by 1186 or 13.4% who were Catholics. Muslims accounted for 330 or 3.9%. In addition, it should be noted that 3402 or 39.8% of the inmates indicated that they were not affiliated to any specific religious groups. Another 1534 or 17.9% stated that they belonged to some other religious affiliation. (Table 8)

CHARGE TYPE

- As indicated in Table 9, 92.5% of the inmate population were confined on felony charges, while the remaining 7.5% were incarcerated on misdemeanor offenses. A comparison of the data for First quarter of FY 91 and FY 92 reveals that the inmate population charged with felony offenses increased by 8.4% and misdemeanor decreased by 20.5%.

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS
FEMALE POPULATION

The current female population of DCDC held in DC Jail, CCC's, Minimum Security and Medium Security is 744, compared to 742 inmates during the First quarter of FY 1991.

CHARGES

- Table 1 indicates that 87 or 12.3% of Black females were confined for violent crimes. The majority of Black females (459 or 65.1%) were charged with drug law violations (drug sales and drug possession combined). White females were mostly convicted in other crime categories. (14 or 1.9%)

INSTITUTIONS

- 449 or 60.3% of the female population were held at the Central Detention Facility, while 173 or 23.3% were housed at the Minimum Security Annex. Noticeably, there are only 22 or 3.0% of the female population held at the Medium Security. Of those remaining, 100 or 13.4% were housed in the Community Correctional Centers. (Table 1)

RACE/SEX

- As of December 31, 1991, there were 744 female prisoners in the D.C. Department of Corrections facilities. Of those 744 females in the DCDC, 32 or 4.3% were white, while 705 or 94.8% were black. Other racial groups accounted for the remaining 0.9%. (Table 1)

MARITAL STATUS

- Table 2 shows that nearly 82.0% of the female population at the DCDC were single, while 6.2% were married. Of those remaining, 6.3% were separated, 2.7% were divorced, 1.9% were widowed, and .9% was in an unknown status.

EDUCATION

- The data in Table 2 also indicate that 318 or 42.7% of the black females completed grade 12. About 47.5% of the females completed grades 7 to 11, and about 65 or 8.7% were considered to have an educational level beyond high school.

AGE

- About 514 or 69.1% of the female population in the DCDC are between the ages of 21-35 years, while 2.1% are between the ages of 18-20 years. Another 214 or 28.8% are between the ages of 36 and above. (Table 3)

COMMITMENT STATUS

- Further analysis of Table 3 shows that 526 or 70.7% of the female offenders were classified as sentenced serving, while 129 or 17.3% were in pre-trial status. Of those remaining, the distribution was DCYRA (15 or 2.0%), CNS (43 or 5.8%), and Other (31 or 4.2%).


OCCUPATION

- 586 or 83.1% of the Black females were unemployed at the time of commitment, while 23 or 71.1% of the White females were unemployed at the time of their arrests. 87 or 94.6% of the females employed in miscellaneous occupations were black females. (Table 4)

RELIGION

- The analysis in Table 4 indicates that 203 or 28.8% of the Black females were Protestants, followed by 105 or 14.9% were Catholics. 12 or 1.7% of the black females belonged to the Nation of Islam faith. It is noted that the remaining Black females pointed out that they either belonged to another faith or had no known religious affiliation.

COMMUNITY CORECTIONAL CENTERS (CCC)
DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

The following information contains the total population of all District run Community Correctional Centers, Contract Houses, Electronic Monitoring and Independent Living Persons. Currently, 1177 inmates are incarcerated in those facilities. The CCC population has declined 11.6% since the First quarter of FY 1991.

RACE/SEX

- Table 1 indicates that 986 or 83.8% of the CCC population are Black males, while 140 or 11.9% are Black females. White males accounted for 20 or 1.7%, while White females and all other ethnic groups formed the remaining 2.7% of the population.

OFFENSE

- Persons charged or convicted of violent crimes accounted for 288 or 24.5% of the offense categories. Drug offenses (drug sales and drug possession combined) formed the largest crime category (640 or 54.4%), followed by robbery (135 or 11.5%). (Table 2)

MARITAL STATUS

- 964 or 81.9% of the CCC population were classified as single, while 129 or 11.0% were married. Of those remaining, 46 or 3.9% were separated and 30 or 2.5% were divorced. (Table 3)

EDUCATION

- More than 470 or 40.4% of the CCC residents are high school graduates. About 570 or 48.2% completed grades 7 to 11, while 2.0% had lower than a 7th grade education. The remaining 9.4% had some college and training beyond high school. (Table 4)

AGE

- Table 5 shows that inmates aged 21-35 accounted for 766 or 65.1% of the total CCC population. Of those remaining, persons over 35 made up 357 or 30.3% of the population, while persons under 21 accounted for 54 or 4.6%.


OCCUPATION

- Table 6 shows that 713 or 60.6% of the CCC population were unemployed at the time of commitment. Of those employed, most were in miscellaneous occupations (351 or 29.8%), followed by 66 or 5.3% in service occupations.

COMMITMENT STATUS

- As indicated in table 7, 858 or 72.9% of the CCC population were classified as Felons, while 319 or 27.1% were Misdemeanors.

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS
OUT-OF-STATE PRISONS

The current population of DCDC held in Out-of-State contract houses is 476, compared to 728 inmates during the First quarter of FY 1991, a 34.6% decrease.

RACE/SEX

- Table 1 indicates that 468 or 98.3% of the population in Out-of-State Prisons were Black males. Of those remaining, White males represented 1.3% of the population and another 0.4% were classified as Other males.

MARITAL STATUS

- 399 or 83.6% of the population were single, while 49 or 10.3% were married. Of those remaining, 15 or 3.2% were separated and 8 or 1.7% were divorced. (Table 1)

AGE

- Table 2 indicates that the residents of Out-of-State prisons aged 21-35 accounted for 333 or 69.9%, while those under 20 made up 20 or 4.2%. The remaining 123 or 26.0% were over 35 years old.

EDUCATION

- About 162 or 34.0% of the ICC population are high school graduates. 269 or 56.5% completed grades 7 to 11, while 11 or 2.3% had lower than a 7th grade education. The remaining 34 or 7.1% had some college or training beyond high school. (Table 3)

OCCUPATION

- The data in table 3 indicate that 277 or 58.2% of the population in Out-of-State prisons were unemployed at the time of commitment. Of those remaining, most were in miscellaneous occupations (149 or 31.3%), followed by 31 or 6.5% in service occupations.


CHARGES

- Analysis shows that 263 or 55.3% of the population were charged and convicted of violent crimes, while 48 or 10.1% charged for property crimes. The majority of population (156 or 32.8%) have been incarcerated on the sale and possession of illegal drugs. (Table 4)

RELIGION

- The religious affiliation of Out-of-State prisoners in table 5 shows that 152 or 31.9% were Protestants followed by 56 or 11.8% who were Catholics. Nation of Islam accounted for 20 or 4.2%, while the remaining 248 or 52.1% reported either no religious preference or other category.
