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
**FOREWORD**


This constitutes the 33rd Crime In Michigan annual report prepared by the Uniform Crime Reporting Program pursuant to PA 319 of 1968, as amended.

The Department of State Police appreciates the cooperation and support of the nearly 600 police departments, sheriffs' offices, and specialized law enforcement agencies that provide offense and arrest data for the report. The contributions of all involved in the collection and preparation of this report permit the department to provide a clear picture of the nature, volume, and extent of crime in Michigan. Without the concerted and dedicated effort of the people who serve in the many local and state agencies which comprise our criminal justice system, the publication of this report would not be possible.

The statistics indicate that crime is on the rise in Michigan. Violent crime rose 2.7% from last year and property crime rose 3.5%. Collectively, index crimes (murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, and arson), used by law enforcement as a standard measure of criminal activity, were up 3.4% in 1991 compared to 1990 figures. However, motor vehicle theft was down 4.0% from 1990 figures, continuing a decline over the past 7 years.

This report, when analyzed, can significantly contribute to management and planning activities at local, state, and federal levels, especially by state officials, the law enforcement community, the legislature, and nonprofit organizations.

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
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# MICHIGAN



Michigan ranks 23rd in size among the fifty states. It is characterized by a potpourri of industrial cities, vast stretches of wilderness, 19 million acres of forest, acre upon acre of fruit orchards, and hundreds of small towns and villages. Its two peninsulas are divided into 83 counties. The 1990 Census indicated a population of 9,295,297 with dense concentrations in the south. Nearly half of the total population is clustered in the southeast with other metropolitan areas located along major highways I-94, I-96, and I-75.

## Public Act 319 of 1968, (as amended)

### 28.251 Uniform crime reports; duties of police departments to file, contents.

Sec. 1. The police department of each city or village, any duly constituted police department of a township, and the sheriff's department of each county, once each month upon a date and form prescribed and furnished by the director of the department of state police, shall forward to the department of state police a crime report. Each reporting department shall report only on cases within its jurisdiction and upon which it is making, or has made, the primary police investigation. The report shall be called the uniform crime report and shall cover crimes reported and otherwise processed during the month preceding the month of the report. It shall contain the number and nature of offenses committed, the disposition of such offenses and such other information as the director of state police shall specify relating to the method, frequency, cause and prevention of crime. Under no circumstances shall the name of any person be reported.

### 28.252 Compilation of monthly uniform crime reports; use.

Sec. 2. Upon receipt of the monthly uniform crime reports from the reporting agencies, the department of state police shall prepare a statewide compilation of the statistics contained therein and the resulting statistical compilation shall be available to any governmental law enforcement agency in the state, the judiciary committees of the Michigan state senate and the Michigan state house of representatives, and the federal bureau of investigation, upon request. The statistics made available through the uniform crime report shall be used for the purpose of studying the causes, trends and effects of crime in this state and for intelligence upon which to base a more sound program of crime detection and prevention and the apprehension of criminals.

### 28.253 Voluntary crime reports; inclusion in compilation.

Sec. 3. Any governmental police agency, not falling within the description of those required to submit the monthly uniform crime report set forth in section 1, which desires to submit such a report, shall be furnished with the proper forms by the department of state police. When a report is received by the department of state police from

a governmental police agency not required to make such report, the information contained therein shall be included within the monthly compilation provided for in section 2.

### 28.254 Reports of wanted persons and stolen vehicles.

Sec. 4. The chief of police of each city or village and of each township having a police department, and the sheriff of each county within this state, shall report to the department of state police, in a manner prescribed by the department, all persons wanted by, and all vehicles stolen from, their primary police jurisdictions. The report shall be made as soon as is practical after the investigating department either ascertains that a vehicle is stolen or obtains a warrant for an individual's arrest or determines that they have reasonable grounds to believe that the individual committed a crime. In no case shall this time exceed 12 hours after the reporting agency determines that it has grounds to believe that a vehicle was stolen or that the wanted person should be arrested.

### 28.255 Reports of apprehension or recovery.

Sec. 5. When at any time after making a report required by section 4 it is determined by the reporting agency that a person is no longer wanted because of his apprehension, or any other factor, and when a vehicle reported stolen under section 4 is recovered, the chief of police or sheriff of the reporting agency shall immediately notify the department of state police in a manner prescribed by the department.

### 28.256 Inapplicability of act as to traffic misdemeanors.

Sec. 6. The provisions of this act do not apply to misdemeanor traffic cases or to persons wanted for misdemeanor traffic offenses, or for the violation of any city, village or township ordinance. The provisions of this act shall not be construed to in any way affect existing or future laws and procedures governing the reporting of persons wanted for traffic law violations or for the violation of city, village or township ordinances.

### 28.257 Crimes of domestic assault; report to state police; contents.

Sec. 7. The chief of police of each city or village, the chief of police of each township having a police department, and the sheriff of each county within this state shall report to the department of state police, in a manner prescribed by the department, the following information related to crimes of domestic assault:

- (a) The number of assaults reported which involve an adult and a minor and the disposition of those offenses.
- (b) The number of assaults reported which involve 2 male adults or 2 female adults and the disposition of those offenses.
- (c) The number of assaults reported which involve 1 male adult and 1 female adult and the disposition of those offenses.
- (d) The number of assaults reported which involve a person and his or her spouse and the disposition of those offenses.
- (e) Other statistics the director of the department of state police considers necessary to obtain accurate and reliable data on the incidence of domestic assault in this state.

Sec. 7a. The chief of police of each city or village, the chief of police of each township having a police department, and the sheriff of each county within this state shall report to the department of state police, in a manner prescribed by the department, information specified under section 1 related to crimes motivated by prejudice or bias based upon race, ethnic origin, religion, gender, or sexual orientation.

**28.258 Certain persons reported missing; preliminary investigation; entering information into law enforcement information network and national crime information center; dental records; retention of information; broadcasting information; forwarding information to registrar; notice and information to last known school district; request that registrar and school district be notified; emancipated missing child; cancellation of information; policy preventing immediate investigation prohibited; unidentified body; unknown identity of person found.**

# THE MICHIGAN UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING SYSTEM

Michigan participates in a voluntary national program to collect crime statistics. The program is administered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The state's Uniform Crime Reporting system was instituted in 1959 when the State Police requested all law enforcement agencies voluntarily submit crime data to them for the purpose of compiling a uniform crime report. Michigan's Uniform Crime Reporting program (UCR) is designed to meet federal reporting requirements as well as to provide detailed statistical information for state law enforcement agencies.

The number of participating agencies was small in the beginning. The larger agencies made up the majority of the contributors. The enactment of Michigan Public Act 319 in 1968, making submission of crime data mandatory, greatly spurred the growth of the program. Smaller agencies began to participate as well as campus police departments and airport security police.

Initially, only summary data was collected. Since the introduction of incident-based reporting in 1976, the Michigan UCR program has operated dual systems. The main difference between the summary and incident based system is the degree of detail in reporting. Agencies submitting *SUMMARY DATA* report aggregate counts of offense and arrest information for both index and non-index crimes. The types of data collected include the number of offenses, clearances, types and values of stolen and recovered property, and the age, race and sex of persons who are arrested. Under the *INCIDENT SYSTEM*, agencies collect more detailed information regarding individual crime incidents and arrests. This information is submit-

ted by incident using prescribed data elements and data values to describe each incident and arrest.

Due to the great variation in definitions of criminal offenses, standardized definitions were adopted for all offenses to provide nationwide uniformity. Reporting agencies are required to submit data in accordance with these national definitions. Offenses are divided into Index and Non-Index categories. Because of their seriousness and frequency of occurrence, eight offenses (murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, and arson) comprise the crime index and serve as indicators of our nation's crime experience. Unfounded complaints are not included in the crime tables. Sub-categories are added for the index offenses of robbery, assault, burglary, and larceny to provide a more detailed look at these offenses. Agencies also provide statistics on domestic assaults. When reporting both homicides and incidents where law enforcement officers are killed or assaulted, a separate paper report is required by all law enforcement agencies.

Michigan's UCR program supports various levels of submission ranging from manually processed forms, to automated tapes, to on-line data collection. The majority of contributors participate in the incident-based system, reporting three fourths of the state's crime statistics. The remaining agencies report on the summary system. Information submitted through both these systems provides a comprehensive data base to define the type and extent of crime in Michigan. Data is extracted monthly and submitted to the FBI Uniform Crime Reporting program which currently operates a summary system.

Each contributing agency reports offenses or arrests for offenses committed within its jurisdiction. These offenses represent violations of Michigan statutes and local ordinances. Crime figures presented in this report are law enforcement statistics submitted to the federal program and are not to be confused with judicial or penal statistics.

Following several years of extensive study requested by the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the National Sheriffs Association, **BLUEPRINT FOR THE FUTURE OF THE UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING PROGRAM**, published in 1985, provided the guidelines and specifications used to develop the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). In 1988, this incident-based system was unanimously endorsed by the nation's law enforcement community. Implementation began in 1989.

In 1989, the Michigan UCR Program, with the endorsement of the MACP and MSA, applied for a federal grant to redesign the state program. The grant was approved in 1990 and will take approximately four years to complete. Eventually, all agencies will be on one incident system and when it is implemented, summary collection of data will cease. The new system will retain two calendar years of data on the on-line database, providing less chance of error, access to current year and previous year data, along with the ability to provide comparison reports. The redesigned system will provide the descriptive characteristics and tools necessary for managing resources, policy analysis, program development and research.

# COMMENTARY ON 1991 CRIME DATA

The information presented in this report provides a study of crime location, frequency and type of offenses and arrests. It can be used to assist law enforcement agencies in identifying crime patterns. It should not be used as a measure of an individual agency's workload.

## CRIME FACTORS

When reviewing and comparing crime statistics, it is important to keep in mind that many factors affect the type and volume of crime that occurs in a given area. These factors have a great impact on the incidence of crime.

### CONSIDER:

*Economic conditions, including median income and job availability*

*Composition of the population (age, sex, race)*

*Density and size of the population (urban vs rural)*

*Climate, including seasonal weather conditions*

*Relative stability of population (seasonal, transient)*

*Effective strength of the police force*

*Educational, recreational, and religious characteristics*

*Attitude of public towards law and enforcement problems*

*Degree of adherence to crime reporting standards*

*Policies of the prosecuting officials and the courts*

*Administrative and investigative emphases of local law enforcement*

offenses by 100,000. That number is then divided by the population of the service jurisdiction based on 1990 census figures.

When using this rate for comparisons, keep in mind that certain large cities and tourist areas report crime that may be the result of transient populations. The crime rates for these areas do not reflect these special populations. Also, student populations for colleges and universities are used only to compute the crime rate for the facility, not for county and total state rates.

## URBAN VS RURAL CRIME

Taking into account the demographic changes in Michigan during the eighties, the criteria used to differentiate between urban and rural crime was changed in 1984. **URBAN** crime is defined as all activity reported by the following:

A law enforcement agency servicing an area that is within an area designated by the Census Bureau as urbanized (regardless of the size of its service population or type of agency). Note: an urbanized area is comprised of incorporated places and adjacent densely settled surrounding areas that together have a minimum population of 50,000;

A township police department servicing an area that may be only partially included in an urbanized area but with a population density of at least 500 persons per square mile;

A municipal police department servicing a population of 5000 or more, located outside an urbanized area (Exception: a municipal department with a service population of less than 5000 with boundaries that are adjacent to a municipality with a population of 5000 or greater);

A campus police department with a service area located in a municipality designated as urban, or with a student population of 5000 or more.

**All other crime is defined as RURAL.**

## CRIME RATES

A Crime Rate represents the number of crimes reported for each 100,000 population. It provides a measure of the severity of a crime problem within a given jurisdiction. The rate is calculated by multiplying the number of

## TERMINOLOGY

Certain terms are used consistently throughout the report. Definitions for Uniform Crime Reporting purposes include:

**Clearance** - refers to the solution of a particular crime, either by the arrest of the offender or through an Exceptional Clearance.

**Exceptional Clearance** - made when an investigation has established an offender, there is enough information to support an arrest charge, the location of the offender is known, but there is a reason outside police control that prevents arresting, charging and prosecuting the offender.

**Clearance by Arrest** - an offense is cleared when an offender has been identified, sufficient evidence to formally charge the suspect has been obtained, and the offender has been ordered to appear in court.

**Trends** - show the fluctuation from year to year, provide an added perspective to study crime.

**Index Crimes** - serve as indicators of the state's crime experience, include *Murder, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson*. Definitions for these crimes are included with the *Offense and Arrest Data*.

**Non-Index Crimes** - violations of state and local law including:

### ***Negligent Manslaughter***

- deaths determined by police investigation to be primarily caused by gross negligence (except motor vehicle accident).

### ***Other Assaults***

- all non-aggravated assaults and attempted assaults.

### ***Forgery & Counterfeiting***

- making, altering, uttering and possessing forged documents.

### ***Fraud***

- making, altering, presenting, advertising, converting and obtaining money under false pretenses.

### ***Embezzlement***

- all offenses concerning embezzlement and conversion.

### ***Stolen Property***

- offenses and attempts involving buying, receiving, and possessing such property.

### ***Vandalism***

- malicious destruction of property.

### ***Weapons***

- (carrying, possessing) all violations of firearm registrations.

### ***Prostitution & Commercialized Vice***

- sex offenses, attempts of a commercialized nature.

### ***Sex Offenses***

- all offenses and attempts against chastity, common decency and morals (except rape and prostitution).

### ***Drug Laws***

- possession and unlawful use, sale, or distribution of controlled substances.

### ***Gambling***

- promoting, permitting or engaging in gambling.

### ***Offenses Against Family & Children***

- non-support, desertion, neglect and abuse.

### ***Driving Under the Influence***

- operating a vehicle under the influence of liquor or drugs.

### ***Liquor Laws***

- all violations of the liquor laws with the exception of driving under the influence and common drunkenness.

### ***Drunkenness***

- drunk and disorderly and common drunkenness.

### ***Disorderly Conduct***

- offenses involving committing a breach of the peace.

### ***Vagrancy***

- offenses of vagabonds, beggars and loiterers.

### ***All Other Offenses***

- all other violations.

## MICHIGAN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS KILLED OR ASSAULTED

Since 1972, the Uniform Crime Reporting Program has been collecting data concerning the number and nature of assaults and deaths of on-duty law enforcement officers. The total number of assaults on officers in 1991 decreased 30.9 percent from 1990 figures.

In 1991, there were 1003 murders in the state, an increase of 4.6 percent from 1990 figures. The majority of the victims were *black (69.3%), male (77.3%)* and in the *25-39 age group (37.0%)*. *68.7 percent were killed by some type of firearm* and *43.3 percent were murdered by a family member or acquaintance*. In *39.2 percent of the incidents*, the relationship of the victim to the offender was *unknown*. The greatest number of the murders resulted from *arguments (36.8%)* followed by *undetermined causes (27.1%)* and during the commission of *another crime (15.0%)*.
