Florida's Prison Population: Monthly Changes from March, 1989 to March, 1991

This document examines the changing nature of Florida's prison population from March, 1989 to March, 1991. The Population Projection Section within the Department's Bureau of Planning, Research and Statistics has been producing a monthly report which highlights how the end-of-month prison population differs from the same month one year in the past. This report compiles the first year of these monthly reports so the major shifts in the status population over the past two years can be displayed. The detailed numbers are contained in Tables 1 through 17 of the report. For those who choose not to wade through the specific data, a text highlighting the significant trends is provided.

#### Highlights of Changes in Florida's Prison Population March, 1989 to March, 1991

8,533 more inmates and prison capacity increase of 9,185.

Female population has risen then fallen.

Black inmate population has more than doubled the white inmate population during this period.

Hispanics share of total population declining.

Percent of population which are older inmates was greater during this period.

Youthful Offender population declining significantly.

Dade county leaps over Broward as number one.

Violent Offenders dropped initially during the period but are beginning to increase.

Drug Offenders increased but now are on a downturn.

Inmates with prior Florida prison commitments increased.

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Close custody population reached a high of 61.6% of the population.

Longer sentenced inmates increased while those with shorter sentences declined.

Mandatory Minimum sentences skyrocketed.

Habitual Offenders leaped to 1 in 10 inmates.

#### Monthly Population and Capacity Changes (Table 1):

Florida's prisons housed 8,533 more inmates in March, 1991 than in March, 1989 (+23.5%). To put the magnitude of this growth in perspective, the number of new inmates alone exceed the entire prison populations in 27 of the 50 United States (as of January 1, 1990). On average, the prison population increased by 356 inmates per month.

The tremendous prison workload experienced by the Department is also reflected in the 200,135 prison intakes and releases which occurred over the past two years (104,650 intakes and 95,485 releases). This translates into an average of 8,339 movements into and out of prison each month.

The 99% capacity of Florida's prison system increased by 9,185 beds over the two year period (+24.9%).

#### Male and Female Inmate Population (Table 2):

The male inmate population increased by 8,112 (+23.7%) while the female count increased by 421 (+19.5%). The significant trend to note is that the female population increased steadily from March, 1989 to September, 1990 (2,163 to 2,827, + 664) and then declined to 2,584 in March, 1991. This decline is associated with two changes. First, the advent of the Control Release Authority in November, 1990. Second, female intakes have begun to decline after steady increases over the past several years. Female intakes rose from 1,320 during the period October, 1987 to March, 1988 to 2,322 during the period October, 1989 to March, 1990 (+1,002, +75.9%). In contrast, the October, 1990 to March, 1991 female intakes declined to 1,984 (-332, -14.3%), from the same period in 1989-90.

#### Racial Composition of the Prison System (Table 3):

Blacks are comprising a larger portion of Florida's prison population with almost each passing month. Blacks show a steady increase from 54.5% in March, 1989 to 57.6% in March, 1991. The average month resulted in 250 more blacks in prison compared with 104 whites. Over the entire two year period, the black population rose by 5,994 (+30.3%) while the white population increased by 2,491 (+15.7%). In other words, for every increase of one white inmate, there was an increase of almost 2.5 black inmates.

#### Hispanic Inmate Population (Table 4):

The Hispanic inmate population increased at a slower rate than the non-Hispanic population (+18.2% and 25.3% respectively). The proportion of the inmate population made up of Hispanics declined over the past two years, from 7.5% to 7.1%.

#### Age of the Inmate Population (Table 5):

The age group 36 to 55 experienced the most significant percentage growth over the past two years (+34.0%). The age group 18-35 had the highest numerical growth (+5,285), but had the lowest percentage growth rate of the four age groups examined (+19.8%). The age group 17 and younger increased from March, 1989 to August, 1990 (540 to 781) and then declined to 679 in March, 1991. The oldest inmate group, 56 years and older increased by 174 (+21.9%) over the 24 month period.

#### Youthful Offenders (Table 6):

Inmates designated as youthful offenders by the courts or the Department decreased significantly over the past two years. This change resulted from the Department's decision to eliminate the youthful offender designation of two institutions (Apalachee C.I. - East and Sumter C.I.). There were 1,300 less youthful offenders is prison in March, 1991 than there were in March, 1989. Youthful offenders comprised only 4.9% of the inmate population at the end of this period compared to 9.7% at the beginning.

#### County of Commitment (Table 7):

Dade county became the number one county of commitment for Florida's total inmate population during the past two years. In March, 1989, Broward county accounted for the largest share of the inmate population (5,046, 13.9%). Dade county has had the largest proportion since October, 1990 and now comprise 13.9% of the total prison population. Additionally, unlike the other four largest prison contributors who exhibited significant growth during the first portion of this 24 month period and then followed with stationary numbers or declines, Dade county has shown no signs of abatement in growth. The monthly growth of 60 inmates from Dade county far exceeds the next closest county by 27 per month (Pinellas, 33).

#### Violent, Non-Violent and Drug Offenders (Table 8):

The net change in the number of inmates with primary offenses involving violence, non-violence, and drugs are similar over the two year period examined (+2,923, +3,044, +2,919 respectively). However, there were some significant changes which occurred within the general offense groups and indications of the future of note.

The percentage of the inmate population which are violent offenders (using the definition of most serious convicted offense) decreased from 49.0% to 44.5% from March, 1989 to October, 1990. The violent offender share of the total population then increased to the 45.8% level for March, 1991. This change is consistent with the implementation of the Control Release Authority in November, 1990. Non-Violent offenders had the largest overall growth over the two year period (+3,044), however, their share of the total population increased minimumally from 31.4% to 32.0%.

Drug offenders in the inmate population increased dramatically from March, 1989 to October, 1990 (7,017 to 10,385). However, beginning in November, 1990, the drug population has declined to a level of 9,936 or 22.2% of the total inmate population. In addition to a reduction in drug offender admissions, this significant change in the type of offender in Florida's prisons is aligned with the advent of the Control Release Authority.

#### Offense Types in Prison (Table 9):

The crime category "other violent" offenses (aggravated assault, battery, etc.) exhibited the highest percentage growth over the past 24 months (+46.4%). As noted earlier, drug offenders also increased considerably over most of this period and then declined over the past five months. Interestingly, the four offense groups which are violent in nature (murder, sexual offenses, robbery, and other violent offenses) have demonstrated consistent growth up through March, 1991. In contrast, the other offense groups have exhibited a leveling or slight declining trend over the last month to five months of the time period.

#### Felony Class (Table 10):

Second degree felons increased the most (+3,462) over the past two years with the monthly increase of 144 exceeding the next highest (third degree felons) by 60 per month. Life felons had the largest percentage increase (+55.2%) with their share of the total population increasing from 8.0% to 9.7%. Third degree felons comprised the same proportion of the prison population in March, 1991 as they did in March, 1989.

#### Prior Florida Prison Commitments (Table 11):

One of the most dramatic changes the Florida prison system has experienced over the past two years is the growing rate of prior prison commitments. In March, 1989, 39.6% of the inmates were repeaters. This increased to 49.7% by March, 1991. One in four inmates in March, 1991 had been to Florida's prisons two or more times before their current commitment. In contrast, in March, 1989, two of every ten inmates were on their third or more commitment. The number of inmates with three or more priors increased by 107.2%, a rate of 119 per month.

#### Custody Classification (Table 12):

Close/Maximum custody inmates increased from 11,968 (35.1% of the population) in March, 1989 to a high of 25,892 (61.6% of the population) in July, 1990. The Close/Maximum custody population has since declined to 21,436 (47.7% of the population) in March, 1991. There are fewer inmates in Minimum and Medium custody (-2,170 and -1,442 respectively) in March, 1991 than there were in March, 1989. The new classification type Medium-In began in September, 1990 and has increased to 4,982 or 11.1% of the inmate population in March, 1991.

#### Sentence Lengths (Table 13):

Inmates with shorter sentences declined over the past two years. One year sentenced inmates declined by 349 (-37.3%) while those with sentences of more than one to three years declined by 188 (-2.2%). In contrast, sentence lengths of more than three years to five years increased by 2,629 (+39.8%) and those five or more years rose by 5,832 (+36.8%). Life sentences also increased (+672, +18.0%). These downward and upward trends were exhibited consistently over the 24 month period.

#### Death Row Population (Table 14):

On average, almost one death row inmate was added each month during the two year period (+19, +6.4%). The Death Row population peaked in November, 1990 at 323 and declined to 314 in March, 1991.

#### Mandatory Minimum Sentences (Table 15):

Of all the changes noted thus far, none compares to what the Department of Corrections has experienced with inmates sentenced under some form of a mandatory minimum sentence. Overall, inmates sentenced under mandatory minimum terms increased from 23.6% of the population to 31.0% over this relatively short period of time. The number of inmates with mandatories increased by 5,338 while those without mandatory terms increased 3,154 over the period.

#### Habitual Offenders (Table 16):

In March, 1989, there were 308 habitual offenders in Florida's prisons, comprising 0.8% of the population. In just 24 months, the habitual offender population has risen to 3,858, or 9.5% of the inmate population. These offenders will accumulate in the prisons at an accelerated rate for two reasons. First, the average sentence length of an habitual offender is 14.6 years, compared to 4.3 years for non-habituals. Second, habitual offenders are eligible for Incentive Gaintime only and cannot be released early by the Control Release Authority. Therefore, <u>habitual offenders will</u> serve a minimum of 65% of their sentence and data shows that the average is approximately 75% or 11 years. The Criminal Justice Estimating Conference predicts that the habitual offender population will exceed 25,000 inmates by June, 1996.

#### Parole Eligibility Population (Table 17):

Inmates eligible for release via parole has declined over the past two years from 7,534 to 5,700 (-1,834, -24.3%). With the virtual elimination of parole eligible sentences in 1983, this trend is certain to continu
