

# TECHNICAL REPORT

ADJUDICATION OF YOUTH IN DFY OPERATED PROGRAMS - 199



#### **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

DFY Operated Programs are Secure, Limited Secure, and Non-Secure facilities and, Foster Care, Community Care and other non-residential treatment programs. Excluded are Voluntary Agencies.

Custody Entries are youth admitted for the first time, youth admitted on a new placement following discharge from a prior placement, and Parole Violators. Excluded are youth already in custody who receive a new placement order or a modification of an existing order.

<u>JO</u>: Juvenile Offender a person convicted in adult criminal court of Murder 2nd degree committed while they were 13 years old or a person convicted of certain crimes of homicide, kidnapping, arson, assault, rape, sodomy, aggravated sexual abuse, burglary, or robbery committed while they are 14-15 years old.

JO-YO: JO Youthful Offender a juvenile offender who has been granted Youthful Offender sentencing status under the Penal Law § 60.02(2).

JD: Juvenile Delinquent a person 7-15 years of age who has committed an act that would constitute a crime if committed by an adult.
RJD: Restricted Juvenile Delinquent a JD committing specific designated felony acts, including certain crimes of homicide, kidnapping, arson, assault, rape, sodomy, aggravated sexual abuse, burglary, or robbery.

JD III: Juvenile Delinquent Title III a JD who may be placed in any facility except secure, and who may be transferred to a secure facility following a transfer hearing under the Family Court Act § 353,3(b).

JD3-60 DAY: Juvenile Delinquent III - 60 day option a JD III who may be placed in a secure facility without a transfer hearing at any time during the first 60 days of residency in DFY under the Family Court Act § 353.3(a).

JD II: Juvenile Delinquent Title II a JD who may not be placed in a secure or limited secure facility under the Family Court Act § 353.3(c). PINS: Person In Need of Supervision a person less than 16 years of age who does not attend school in violation of the education law, or who is incorrigible, ungovernable or habitually disobedient and beyond the lawful control of parent or other lawful authority or who unlawfully possesses marihuana.

OTHER: Other Adjudications include youth sentenced as youthful offenders, placed after a criminal finding in Family Court, placed with DFY as a condition of probation, adjourned in contemplation of dismissal, temporary adjournments, youth voluntarily admitted under FCA 358(a), or youth placed under interstate compact agreements.
