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HIGHLIGHTS

During 1990, 81 men and women escaped from institutions and camps, which is a rate of .09% per 100 Average Daily Population (ADP).

During 1990, the male escapes continued to decrease with a rate of .02% per 100 ADP for the institutions and 1.76% for the camps.

During 1990 there were 1,324 escapes from Community Based Facilities, which is a rate of 7.7% for the population at risk. This rate decreased from 9.5% in 1989.

The percentage of escapes that were apprehended as of January 31, 1991 was 97.6%.

The number of inmates who attempted to escape during 1990 was 46. This was an increase from 44 in 1989.
