### Offenders Released from Wisconsin Adult Correctional Institutions Calendar Year 1991

### HIGHLIGHTS

\*

A total of 3,825 offenders, 3,545 men and 280 women, were released from Wisconsin's correctional institutions for adult offenders during calendar year 1991. Over three-fourths (76.9%) of the group were first releases, less than one-fifth (18.4%) were classified as re-releases, and the remainder (4.7%) were released after alternative to revocation placements, after completion of revocation hearings, or for other reasons.

(See Table 1.)

The majority (91.1%) of the persons released left the institutions for supervision in the community in the community on parole (60.4%), mandatory release (30.6%), or special action early release (0.1%) status. The remainder of the releases were discharged at completion of sentence (3.3%), discharged by order of the court (0.8%), released after completion of revocation hearings (0.5%), released following alternative to revocation placements (4.2%), or died while institutionalized (0.1%).

(See Table 2.)

Men first and re-released from the institutions during calendar year 1991 had most often been sentenced for unarmed burglary (21.2%), other drug violations (14.5%), and theft (6.4%). Other drug violations (18.3%), forgery (16.1%), and theft (15.8%) were the crimes for which women released during 1991 had most often been imprisoned.

\* Men released during 1991 were serving average sentences of 63.0 months; women, 48.3 months. The average sentence for all offenders released during the year was 61.8 months. Ten men and one woman serving life sentences were excluded from these computations.

- \* Over one-third (35.5%) of the men and three-tenths (30.8%) of the women released during 1991 had been committed from Milwaukee County. An additional one-fourth (25.4%) of the men and over one-third (36.6%) of the women had been committed from Dane, Kenosha, Racine, and Rock Counties. (See Table 5.)
- \* Men spent an average length of stay of 23.0 months prior to release; women, an average of 17.3 months. The average length of stay since most recent admission for all offenders was 22.5 months.

(See Table 6.)

\* Men re-released during 1991 had spent an average of 55.9 months in the institution since last new admission; women, an average cf 35.6 months. The average time spent in institutions since last new admission for all offenders re-released was 54.9 months. Forty re-releases, 38 men and 2 women, were excluded from these computations since the date of last new admission pre-dated the development of the Department of Corrections computerized data collection.

\* One-half (54.6 percent) of the men released were White while about two-fifths (37.6 percent) were Black. Women releases were evenly divided between Blacks (47.0 percent) and Whites (46.6 percent).

\* About one-half (47.5 percent) of the men released during calendar year 1991 were classified as assaultive offenders, one-fifth (21.3 percent) as drug offenders, and one-tenth (11.1 percent) as sex offenders. These three categories are not mutually exclusive. Men classified solely as property offenders accounted for one-third (34.8 percent) of the releases.

(See Table 9.)

\* Two-fifths (42.7 percent) of the women were categorized as property offenders, one-third (34.0 percent) as assaultive offenders, one-fourth (25.4 percent) as drug offenders, and 3.5 percent as sex offenders. The latter three categories are not mutually exclusive.

\* Less than one-tenth of the men (2.9 percent) and women (1.4 percent) were released to detainers.

(See Table 10.)

\* Men serving sentences for the most common offenses among those firstreleased during 1991 (unarmed burglary, other drug offenses, and theft) spent an average of 23.0, 15.1, and 17.1 months in the institution prior to release.

(See Table 11.)

\* First-released women, who were most often sentenced for other drug offenses, theft, and forgery, served an average of 10.2, 14.7, and 18.9 months respectively in the institution.

(See Table 11.)

\* Re-released men, who were most often sentenced for unarmed burglary, armed robbery, and forgery, served an average of 19.6, 35.6, and 12.0 months between the time of re-institutionalization following revocation of community supervision and re-release during 1991.

- Women serving sentences for the most common offenses among those rereleased during 1991 (forgery, other drug offenses, and theft) spent an average of 24.4, 8.4, and 33.5 months in the institution prior to re-release. (See Table 12.)
- \* Men and women who entered the institution with five year sentences and were first-released in 1991 were incarcerated for an average of 25.3 and 22.2 months prior to release.

(See Table 13.)

- Men and women with five-year sentences who were previously released and returned to the institution following revocation of field supervision spent an average of 13.2 and 26.5 months in the institution prior to re-release in 1991. (See Table 14.)
- \* About three-fourths (73.4 percent) of the men and nine-tenths of the women (91.8%) intended to live in Wisconsin following release.

Information about participation in academic, vocational, substance abuse, and clinical and/or social work treatment programs is not available for publication in this bulletin due to problems associated with revisions of both the data collection and the computerized data system. Reporting of this type of information will resume with the publication of C-54 for calendar year 1992.
