

Inmate Status Population

- The inmate status population increased by 435 (less than 1%) in May 1993 to 49,733 from 49,298 in April 1993.
- The annual increase in inmate population was 2,209 (+4.6%) from May 1992.

June 1991 - May 1993




Admissions to Prison

- Admissions in May 1993 were 2,352, down by 138 (-5.5%) from April 1993.
- There were 436 (-15.7%) fewer admissions in May 1993 than in May 1992.

Admissions to Prison


June 1991 - May 1993



- Admissions in May 1993 were 317 less than forecast by the Criminal Justice Estimating Conference, a difference of 12.3%.
- Under the prior CJEC forecast, actual admissions from November 1992 through April 1993 at 14,347 fell below the 17,470 for ecasts for the period by 3,123 (-17.9%).

September 1991 - May 1993




Releases From Prison

- Inmate releases totaled 2,157 in May 1993, down by 223 (-9.4%) from April 1993.
- Control Release Authority (CRA) releases at 1,611 constituted 60.0% of releases in May 1993.


Inmate Releases

Escapes

- There were 5 escapes from major institutions and 13 escapes from community facilities in May 1993.
- Average monthly escapes in FY 92-93 to date (July-May) at 17.5 are below the FY 91-92 average of 17.6 per month.
- Average monthly escapes from major institutions in FY 92-93 to date at 4.6 are below the FY 91-92 average of 4.8 per month.
- Average monthly escapes from community facilities in FY 92-93 to date at 12.2 are below the FY 1992 average of 12.8 per month.
- In FY 92-93 to date, the average monthly escape rate per 1,000 inmates was 0.12 in major institutions, 2.88 in community facilities, and 0.36 systemwide.
- There were 29 recaptures in May 1993.




Death Row

• Inmates on Death Row increased to 342 in April with 3 admissions and 2 losses.
