Average Daily Population

The average number of offenders incarcerated in DOC institutions in July, 1993, was 17,074. This is a 0.3% increase from the 17,019 average inmate population in custody last month and a 1.0% increase from the average population (16,902) recorded one year ago.

Operational Capacity

For July, 1993, there were 17,056 inmates (excluding pre-release) housed in state facilities having an operational capacity of 14,711*. The Virginia DOC was thus operating at 115.9% of capacity.

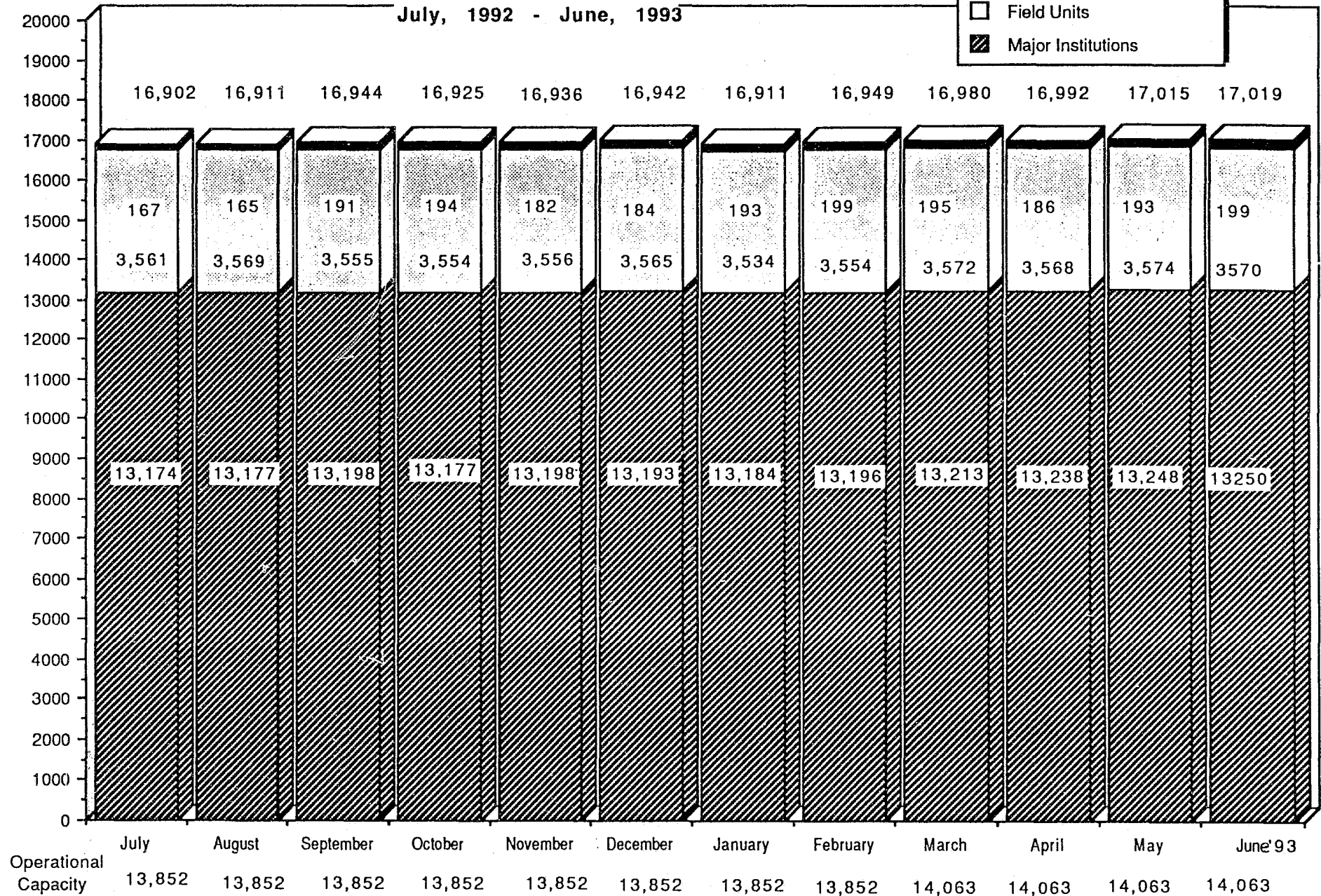

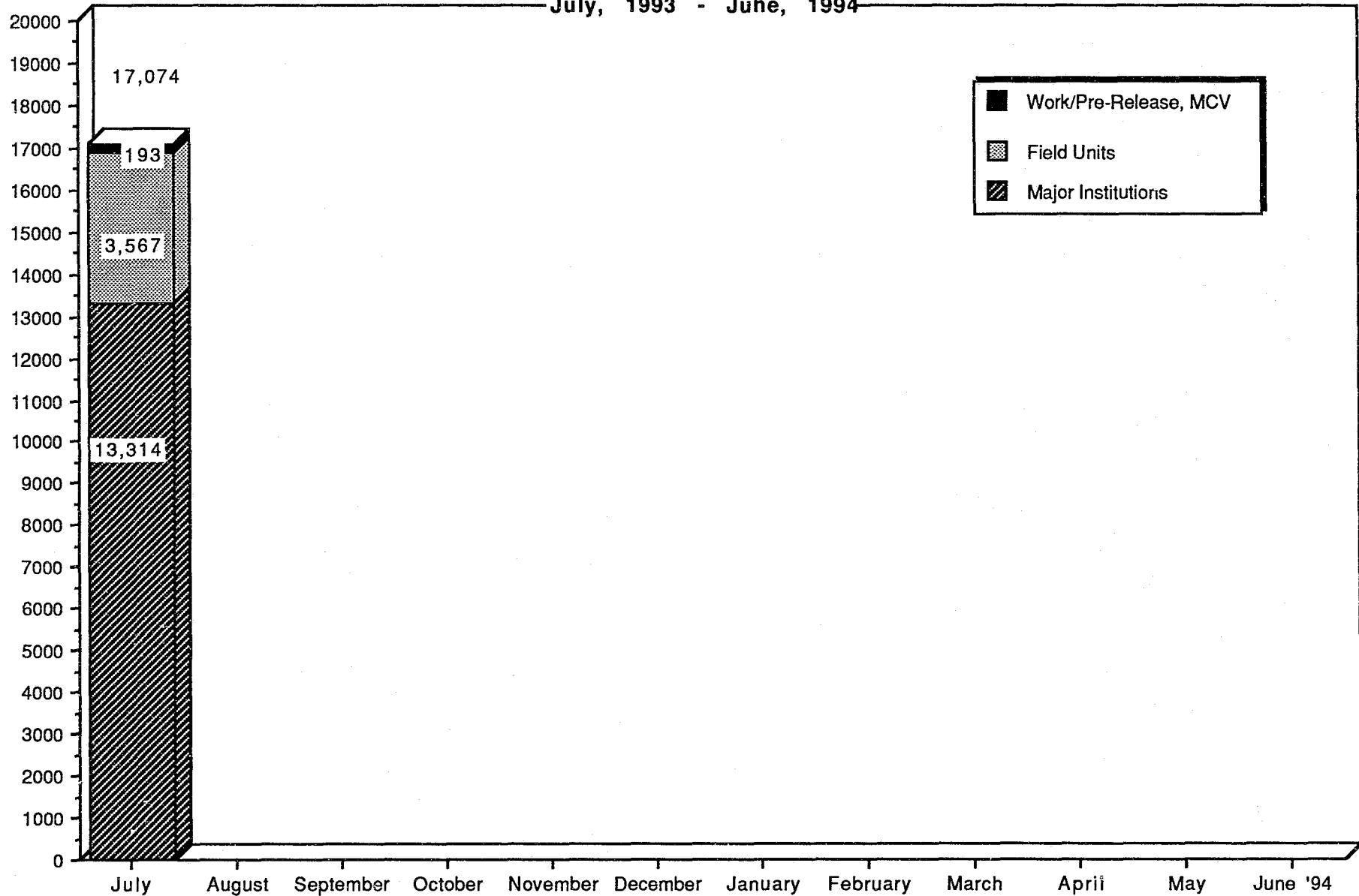
Division of Institutions - Average Daily Population

SOURCES OF POPULATION INFORMATION

The source for the average daily population is a Management Information System (MIS) generated printout "Average Daily Population for (Month) (COR03856)." This MIS printout uses an automated file: "COR.NEWIRS.LOCH.DISK." This file contains OBSCIS movement and location history information.

The operational capacity is provided by the Planning Unit in Planning & Engineering Services. Mixed Field Units refers to Correctional Field Units that house work release inmates. The sources for the number of inmates in Mixed Field Units and Work Release Units are the Daily Work Release Participant Activity Record and Monthly Population Report, Work Release Accounting, Accounts Receivable Department, Accounting Operations Unit. The source for the operational capacity for Mixed Field Units and Work Release Units is the Division of Institutions, coordinated with the Budget Office.

Inmates in a work release job have had \$5/day deducted from their pay for each day in work status (includes W,R and F). Inmates expecting compensation for unemployment (C) are also added into this category while cadre and cadre pending are excluded.
