

Inmate Status Population

- The inmate status population increased by 870 (+1.7%) in June 1993 to 50,603 from 49,733 in May 1993.
- The annual increase in inmate population was 3,591 (+7.6%) from June 1992.

July 1991 - June 1993




Admissions to Prison

- Admissions in June 1993 were 2,694, up by 342 (+14.5%) from May 1993.
- There were 262 (-8.9%) fewer admissions in June 1993 than in June 1992.

Admissions to Prison


July 1991 - June 1993



- Admissions in June 1993 were 141 less than forecast by the Criminal Justice Estimating Conference, a difference of 5.2%.
- Under the current CJEC forecast, actual admissions from May 1993 through June 1993 at 4,848 fell below the 5,306 forecast for the period by 458 (-8.6%).

September 1991 - May 1993




Releases From Prison

- Inmate releases totaled 2,138 in June 1993, down by 19 (less than 1%) from May 1993.
- Control Release Authority (CRA) releases at 1,346 constituted 63.0% of releases in June 1993.

Inmate Releases


July 1991 - June 1993



Escapes

- There were 17 escapes from major institutions and 15 escapes from community facilities in June 1993.
- Average monthly escapes in FY 92-93 at 18.6 are above the FY 91-92 average of 17.6 per month.
- Average monthly escapes from major institutions in FY 92-93 at 5.7% are above the FY 91-92 average of 4.8 per month.
- Average monthly escapes from community facilities in FY 92-93 at 12.9 are above the FY 91-92 average of 12.8 per month.
- In FY 92-93, the average monthly escape rate per 1,000 inmates was 0.15 in major institutions, 2.88 in community facilities, and 0.39 systemwide.
- There were 26 recaptures in June 1993.

July 1991 - June 1993




Death Row
