

### INTRODUCTION

This publication has been prepared as a resource to persons who wish to prepare and publish an article on some aspect of criminal justice, and who need information about where to get it published.

The contents were originally developed to assist the staff of the Santa Clara Criminal Justice Pilot Program and encourage publication of project results. The contents are stored in machine readable form at the Stanford Computation Center's Campus Facility as a subfile, which can be accessed via Stanford's SPIRES System. SPIRES is an on-line information storage and retreival system. Through a terminal located in the offices of the Santa Clara Criminal Justice Pilot Program, the contents of the subfile were extracted for inclusion in the present publication.

Information contained in this publication can be used to: (1) "zero in" on the journal, magazine or newsletter which would be most appropriate for the type of article the author is submitting, and (2) provide the publication's address and other information needed by the author. "Zeroing ir" is accomplished most efficiently by the retreival component of SPIRES, but can nevertheless be accomplished by simply reading through the publications information in Section II of this publication.

This information is now being made available generally with the hope that it will: (1) aid others who seek information on publication channels and (2) serve as a model for the selection of appropriate publication channels for the dissemination of written material.

# The Organization of the Material

Section I contains an alphabetical listing of each publication by title. This is a title listing only and omits the more detailed information about each publication which is presented in Section II of this document.

The list of publications is not an exhaustive one; it is continually being expanded.

If you know of publication sources which you believe should be added to the list, we would appreciate hearing from you.

Section II contains specific information about each publication. Titles followed by dates are those for which full information has not yet been entered. When the information is added to the record, the date is removed. The date is the day on which a request for information was mailed to the publication's source. Additions to the list are made almost daily.

Information includes: Title, contact person, address, format, editorial policy, maximum length of articles accepted, how often published, lag time - submission to publication, substantive area, size of circulation (distribution), distribution range, and any special instructions.

Section III describes the SPIRES subfile in which the publications' information is stored and the way in which information is retrieved. It shows the results of a specific information request.

# Information Storage and Retrieval System

# Description of SPIRES

The JOURNALS SUBFILE is stored in machine readable form at the Stanford Computation Center's Campus Facility. The JOURNALS SUBFILE was created and is stored and accessed via SPIRES (Stanford Public Information Retrieval System). SPIRES is a generalized computer information storage and retrieval system. It operates as one of the interactive systems on the IBM 360/67 computer of the Stanford Computation Center's Campus Facility. SPIRES allows a user to create, update, maintain, interrogate, and display stored information. This information may be kept in either the user's own private data base of records or in a public data base. As an on-line, interactive system, SPIRES enables the user to communicate with the data base in a conversational mode and receive a response at once.

# Journals Subfile

The subfile in which the publications information is stored has been labelled the JOURNALS SUBFILE. As part of SPIRES, the user may request an explanation of any subfile. When the user enters "explain subfile journals," he receives the following information:

TITLES FOLLOWED BY DATES ARE THOSE FOR WHICH FULL INFORMATION HAS NOT YET BEEN ENTERED. WHEN THE INFORMATION IS ADDED TO THE PECOPD, THE DATE IS REMOVED. THE DATE IS THE DAY ON WHICH A PEOUEST FOR INFORMATION WAS MAILED TO THE PUBLICATION'S SOUPCE.

ADDITIONS TO THE JOURNALS SUBFILE ARE MADE ALMOST DAILY.

### Search Request

Information is retrieved from the JOURNALS SUBFILE by a search request. A search request takes the form:

find <simple index <value>

The simple indexes available to a user of the JOURNALS SUBFILE are given when the user enters "show search terms."

-? show search terms
