INTRODUCTION

This report has been developed to provide information regarding selected offender characteristics in each correctional complex, major institutions and satellite housing units under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Department of Corrections on December 31, 1991. The selected characteristics compiled in this report are Base Offense at Admission, Total Term at Admission, Ethnicity, Age, County of Commitment, and Mandatory Minimum Terms.

The Prison Complex includes the New Jersey State Prison, East Jersey State Prison, Bayside State Prison, Riverfront State Prison, Mid-State, Southern State, Northern State Prison, Edna Mahan Correctional Facility for Women (females and males) and the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center (ADTC is a facility for adult male sex offenders).

The Youth Correctional Complex consists of the Garden State Reception and Youth Correctional Facility, the Albert C. Wagner Youth Correctional Facility, and the Mountainview Youth Correctional Facility. The Juvenile Facilities include the New Jersey Training School for Boys, the Lloyd McCorkie Training School for Boys and Girls and the Juvenile Medium Security Facility.

On December 31, 1991 there were approximately 3,426 State-sentenced offenders temporarily housed in County Facilities awaiting transfer into the State Prison System. Characteristics data on these offenders are not included in this report. Similarly, characteristics data for the 2,571 Prison and Youth Reception residents, Juvenile Group Center Residents, Halfway House, County Contract, County Assistance, Central Medical Unit and Electronic Monitoring/Home Confinement residents are not included in these tabulations.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Fifty-one percent (51%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections residents were committed for crimes against persons which include Homicide, Sexual Assault, Assault, Robbery, Sexual Abuse and Other Person Offenses.
- Forty-four percent (44%) of all New Jersey Department of Corrections residents were committed with maximum statutory sentences of 10 years or more. Of the total, five percent (5%) are serving Life Sentences and 13 offenders are under Capital Sentences.
- Sixty-three percent (63%) of New Jersey Department of Corrections residents are Black, while 18% are White and 16% are Hispanic.
- Forty-eight percent (48%) of all residents in the New Jersey Department of Corrections are under 29 years of age.
- Of the 21 New Jersey counties, seven (Atlantic, Hudson, Essex, Camden, Union, Passaic, and Monmouth) account for seventy-two percent (72%) of Total State Correctional Residents. Essex County is the highest contributor with twenty percent (20%).
- Fifty-four percent (54%) of all adult residents housed in the State System have mandatory minimum sentences.
 - Thirty-two percent (32%) of all Department of Corrections residents have been committed for narcotics law violations, including possession, sale and distribution. Over 90% of all narcotics law violations are sale/distribution offenses.

In these tabulations, the Base Offense is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offense at admission only, and do not include offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission, nor are additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the State Correctional System included in the data.


- Violent Crimes include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated assault, robbery, other sex offenses and other persons offenses (i.e. simple assault, weapons offenses, coercion, larceny from a person and negligent manslaughter).
- Property Offenses include burglary, arson, breaking and entering, theft, forgery, embezzlement, auto theft and receiving/possessing stolen property.
- Public Policy Offenses include racketeering, gambling, violation of probation, prostitution, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile or family related offenses and conspiracy. Violation of probation is the commitment offense for the vast majority of those in the Public Policy category.
- Narcotics Violations include distribution, manufacture and possession/use of drugs. Over 90% of these are for distribution, manufacture and sale.


OFFENDERS IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON DECEMBER 31, 1991 BY BASE OFFENSE

 Violent Crimes comprise 55% of Prison Complex inmates, 39% of Youth Complex inmates, 99% of ADTC, 33% of Edna Mahan Correctional Facility and 44% of Juvenile Facility inmates.

- Fifty-five percent (55%) of the male offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of a crime of a violent nature. This is the first time in the history of the Department that this figure has dropped below 60% for the Prison Complex.
- Twenty-nine percent (29%) of all offenders in the Prison Complex have been convicted of narcotics violations.





- Virtually all offenders at the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center were committed for violent crimes.
- Violation of narcotics statutes is now the most frequent commitment offense at Edna Mahan (44%).
- Only 33% of the female residents have been committed for violent offenses.

- Thirty-nine percent (39%) of the Youth Correctional offenders have been incarcerated for crimes against the person and 14% for property offenses.






PRISON COMPLEX MALES BY TOTAL MAXIMUM TERM ON DECEMBER 31, 1991





YOUTH COMPLEX BY TOTAL MAXIMUM TERM ON DECEMBER 31, 1991









PRISON COMPLEX MALES BY RACE/ETHNICITY ON DECEMBER 31, 1991









OFFENDERS IN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS ON DECEMBER 30, 1991 BY AGE GROUPS





PRISON COMPLEX MALES BY AGE GROUPS ON DECEMBER 31, 1991





EDNA MAHAN CORRECTIONAL FACILITY FOR WOMEN



YOUTH COMPLEX BY AGE GROUPS ON DECEMBER 31, 1991







PRISON COMPLEX MALES BY COUNTY OF COMMITMENT ON DECEMBER 31, 1991







YOUTH COMPLEX BY COUNTY OF COMMITMENT ON DECEMBER 31, 1991




In the Youth Complex, more than half (60%) of all residents were committed from the Northeastern counties of Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Passaic and Union.

Essex County committed the highest percentage with 27%.

The seven counties of Atlantic, Camden, Essex, Hudson, Monmouth, Passaic and Union were responsible for commitment of 77% of all offenders housed in Youth Complex facilities.


In New Jersey, since 1979, mandatory minimum sentences have been utilized by the courts. This means that an offender must serve the entire minimum sentence before being eligible for parole consideration. Mandatory minimum terms are not reduced by earned credits (commutation, minimum security or work).

- Fifty-four percent (54%) of all adult offenders have mandatory minimum terms. This is an increase of four percentage points since last year.
- Fifty-three percent (53%) of all mandatory minimum terms fall within the 2-5 year range.
- Thirteen percent (13%) have mandatory minimum terms of 15 years or more.
- In general, mandatory minimums for females at Edna Mahan are lower than for adult males in the system. Seventy—five percent (75%) have mins of 5 years or less, compared to 65% for males.
