The fiscal year report presents statistical information on select categories of convicted adult felons admitted to, confined in, and released from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) Institutional Division from September 1, 1992 through August 31, 1993. Descriptive data are presented for male, female, and total inmates by race, age, Metropolitan Statistical Area of conviction, offense, education, prior prison confinements and probations, good conduct time class, custody level, sentence length, and time served.

Following are definitions of the various categories of inmates that comprised the 69,054 inmates in the Texas prison population on August 31, 1993.

TDCJ-Institutional Division Inmates. These are inmates confined in state operated prison units throughout the state. At the end of August 1993, there were 62,317 inmates in these facilities, including 301 inmates in Boot Camps and 4,238 inmates in Trusty Camps.

Private Prison Inmates. In 1987, the state legislature gave the Department of Criminal Justice authority to contract with private vendors for the construction and operation of prison facilities. Presently there are four 500-bed facilities that housed 1,996 inmates at the end of fiscal year 1993. Their demographics are combined in the On-Hand section of the report. Four more 500-bed private prisons are scheduled to open in the winter of 1994. Inmates in these facilities are generally minimum custody trusties with good disciplinary records who are within two years of parole.

On-Hand Inmates. These are Institutional Division inmates "on-hand" in state prison and in private prisons on the last day of the fiscal year. Demographics on these 64,313 inmates are presented in the On-Hand section of the report.

Substance Abuse Felony Punishment (SAFP) Inmates. Programs for the treatment of offenders with significant substance abuse problems were authorized by the legislature in 1991. Currently, approximately 2,600 beds located throughout state prisons are dedicated to these programs. One of the private facilities also operates a substance abuse treatment program. Demographics on these inmates are combined in the On-Hand section of the report. Another four 1,000-bed and ten 500-bed SAFP facilities are scheduled to begin operation between July 1994 and August 1995.

Pre-Parole Facility Inmates. Eligible Institutional Division inmates within six months of their parole date can be placed in these facilities privately contracted by the Pardons and Paroles Division. On August 31, 1993 there were 1,320 inmates in these facilities. Demographics are not presented on these offenders. During the fiscal year 1,902 inmates were released on parole from pre-parole units. These inmates are not counted in the 18,887 releases from prison this year.

Detention Center Inmates. Six detention centers housed 3,421 inmates at the end of the fiscal year. Inmates are transferred to these centers from county jails to ease the crowding caused by the jail backlog. They are not included in the on-hand fiscal year statistics.

The following terms address the population of felony offenders who were convicted and are still in county jails awaiting transfer to the Institutional Division.

Jail Backlog Inmates. These are felons who have been convicted but remain in the county jails until there is room for them in the Institutional Division. As of September 1, 1993, there were 24,320 of these offenders in county jails throughout the state awaiting transfer to prison. Statistics are not available on these inmates.

Transfer Facilities. Funded by the 73rd Legislature, three of these facilities, each with 2,000 beds, are scheduled to open in December 1993. Another 4,000 beds will go online a year later. These facilities will help accommodate the county jail backlog of felons awaiting transfer to the Institutional Division.

State Jail Facilities. The 73rd Legislature also authorized the establishment of the State Jail Division which will oversee 22,000 beds planned to begin operating between November 1994 and December 1995. Funds have already been allocated for 10,000 beds and Texas voters recently approved bonds to finance the remaining 12,000 beds. These facilities will principally house inmates with convictions for the new fourth degree felony class of drug or property crimes with relatively short sentences.

The following definitions apply to inmates who were admitted to the Institutional Division with convictions for felony offenses.

New Receives. These inmates are admitted to the Institutional Division with new convictions, either as first offenders or as prison recidivists. Statistics on these 17,120 offenders are presented in the report.

Parole Violators. These admissions to the Institutional Division are felons who violated conditions of release on parole either for technical reasons or because of convictions for a new offense. In the case of a new offense, if the prison time required to satisfy the new sentence is equal to or less than the time required to satisfy the original sentence that resulted in parole, no new identification number is issued and the inmate is counted as a Parole Violator. If the new sentence requires more time than the original sentence, the violator is given a new prison number and counted as a New Receive. The report provides information on these 14,104 inmates.

Mandatory Supervision Violators. These are inmates admitted to the Institutional Division who violated conditions of release on mandatory supervision either for technical reasons or because of a conviction for a new offense. In the case of a new offense, if the prison time required to satisfy the new sentence is equal to or less than the time required to satisfy the original sentence that resulted in parole, no new identification number is issued and the inmate is counted as a Mandatory Supervision Violator. If the new sentence requires more time than the original sentence, the violator is given a new prison number and counted as a New Receive. See the Mandatory Supervision Violator section in the report for information on these 1,140 inmates.

Shock Probation Violators. These are inmates admitted to the Institutional Division who violated the conditions of supervision in the community on Shock Probation. Statistics are not presented in the report on these 680 inmates.

Total Receives. Combined demographics are presented in the report on New Receives, Parole Violator Receives, and Mandatory Supervision Receives, a total of 32,364 inmates. The 680 Shock Probation Violators are excluded from the receive statistics.

The following groups of inmates were released from the Institutional Division during the fiscal year.

Discharge Releases. These are inmates released from the Institutional Division either by full expiration of sentence or by court order. Statistics are not included on these 310 inmates.

Parole Releases. These are inmates released from the Institutional Division to the supervision of the Pardons and Paroles Division. Eligibility generally requires prison time plus good conduct time to equal either 1/3 or 1/4 of the sentence, depending on the nature of the offense. Information is presented on these 14,250 offenders.

Mandatory Supervision Releases. These inmates are likewise released from the Institutional Division to the supervision of the Pardons and Paroles Division. Eligibility generally requires prison time plus good conduct time to equal the total sentence. Demographics on these 3,354 inmates appear in the report.

Shock Probation Releases. These offenders are released from the Institutional Division to Community Justice Assistance Division supervision. The prison records of eligible candidates who have served six months are reviewed by the court to see if probation is appropriate. These 973 inmates have a section in the report.

Total Releases. Combined demographics are presented in the report on Parole Releases, Mandatory Supervision Releases, and Shock Probation Releases, a total of 18,577 inmates. The 310 Discharge Releases are excluded from the release demographics.

The following group of inmates was released from county jails during the fiscal year.

Parole in Absentia (PIA) Releases. These are jail inmates released from the county jail (prior to transfer to the Institutional Division) to the supervision of the Pardons and Paroles Division. Eligibility generally requires prison time plus good conduct time to equal either 1/3 or 1/4 of the sentence, depending on the nature of the offense. No demographics are available on the 11,317 inmates released by PIA this fiscal year.

Following are highlights of population trends and time served for fiscal year 1993 as compared to fiscal year 1992.

Population Trend. The total prison population grew from 55,234 on August 31, 1992 by 13,820 inmates to 69,054 one year later, an increase of 25%. The Jail Backlog increased by 40% from 17,286 to 24,320 inmates. The total admissions to prison in fiscal year 1993 declined by seven percent from fiscal year 1992 and releases from prison dropped by 36%. Releases from jail by Parole in Absentia increased by 10%.

Crime Rate and Receive Rate. The crime rate declined from 7,819 crimes per 100,000 Texas population last year to 7,057 per 100,000 this year, a ten percent decrease. The rate of receives or admissions to prison likewise decreased from 202 per 100,000 last year to 183 this year, a drop of nine percent.

Time Served by Releases. The average time served by inmates released from prison in fiscal year 1992 was 1.9 years. The 1993 releases served 2.4 years, an increase of 26% over last year. Percent of sentence served jumped from 19% to 21%. This year, releases served an average of 2.5 months for each year of sentence compared to 2.0 months per year in fiscal year 1992.

The following demographic highlights are presented for the on-hand population on August 31st.

Race. The on-hand population by racial composition was 47% Black, 28% White, and 24% Hispanic, not significantly different from last year.

Age and Sex. The average age of on-hand inmates increased slightly from 32.4 years to 32.8 years. Female inmate composition decreased slightly from 4.7% of the on-hand population to 4.5%.

Offense. Inmates on-hand with convictions for violent offenses accounted for 47% of the population this year compared to 51% last year. Property offenders changed from 27% in fiscal year 1992 to 28% of all inmates in fiscal year 1993. Drug offender composition was also similar for both years (17% to 18%). Other and unclassified offenders comprised five percent of last year's on-hand inmates and seven percent of this year's. Aggravated offenders on-hand decreased from 33% of last year's population to 30% of the 1993 population.

Education. This year's on-hand education characteristics were not significantly different from last years's. The average inmate IQ was 92, the average educational achievement score was 7.0 (seventh grade level), and the average school level claimed completed by inmates on-hand in fiscal year 1993 was the 10th grade. Approximately 59% of the on-hand inmate population claimed to have dropped out of school before completing the twelfth grade.

Prior Prison Confinement. In 1992, 52% of the on-hand population had previously been confined in Texas prison. This year that proportion increased to 55%.

Time Earning and Custody Categories. On August 31, 1993, eight out of every ten inmates on-hand were in trusty good time earning categories and seven out of ten were classified as minimum custody inmates. These proportions were the same last year.

Sentence Length. Inmates on-hand the last day of fiscal year 1992 were serving an average sentence of 25.6 years; in 1993 the average sentence decreased by 1.5 years to 24.1 years.

The computer generated raw data for the 1993 fiscal year report were provided by Data Services of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice in Huntsville. Crime and state population information was provided by the Texas Department of Public Safety in Austin.


















PERCENT ON-HAND BY SELF-REPORTED SCHOOL LEVEL COMPLETED
