INTRODUCTION

History of California's Juvenile Court and Probation Statistical System

California's Bureau of Criminal Statistics and Special Services (the Bureau) has been compiling and publishing data describing California's juvenile justice system since 1947. Current authority for the California Department of Justice to collect such data is found in California Penal Code Sections 13010-13020 and the Welfare and Institutions Code Section 285. The Bureau collects information on the chain of events which depict a juvenile's progress through the juvenile justice system from time of referral to probation intake (which performs the intake function for the state's juvenile court system) to final court disposition through their Juvenile Court and Probation Statistical System (JCPSS). These data aid the Governor's Office, the Legislature, the Bureau, various criminal justice planning agencies, local agencies, researchers, and others in allocating resources, planning for the future, and developing new ways to deal with the juvenile delinquency problem.

Data Collection Methods

Juvenile delinquency case processing in California begins with a referral to a county's juvenile probation department. Some referrals to the probation department for a specific law violation (delinquency or status offense) are handled at the intake level and proceed no further in the system are reported to the Bureau as "referral" actions. For these cases the probation department can close the case after investigation or because of insufficient evidence; place the youth on informal probation; maintain prior status without further action; transfer the case to another agency or state for disposition. All delinquency or status offense cases petitioned to court for formal adjudication are reported only after the court disposition (or court action) is known. These cases can be dismissed by the juvenile court, transferred to another jurisdiction after a juvenile court hearing, remanded (waived) to adult court, placed on supervision, committed to the California Youth Authority, or ordered by the court to have prior status maintained. Data on a case are reported at the time of disposition; a single disposition record may include referrals that were received by intake on separate days but combined during processing. Therefore, the unit of count of the JCPSS system is case "disposition," not referrals disposed.

All delinquency and status offense cases handled by the probation department are to be reported to the Bureau. Most county probation departments (48 of 58) use the paper Juvenile Court and Probation Statistical Report form (see Appendix I), while others extract information from their local automated information systems. The form is completed only after the appropriate disposition has been made. The completed forms and the automated data files are forwarded to the Bureau on a monthly basis. Internal validity checks are run and errors which cannot be corrected by the Bureau are returned to the probation department for correction and resubmission.

All 58 counties report information on delinquency and status offense cases handled by their juvenile probation department, but some reporting is not complete. Prior to the current system, the Bureau had established reporting guidelines which did not require that probation departments report information on a special class of cases. These cases are labeled as "re-referrals closed-at-intake." These are cases which involved a new referral on a youth who was already under the supervision of the probation department (i.e., on informal probation or court-ordered supervision) and referred for a new offense to the probation department. This latter or subsequent referral would be closed at the intake level. In the old data collection system, petitioned subsequent referrals were reported, while nonpetitioned re-referrals were not. When the new reporting system was introduced, most counties began reporting these cases. But the 4 counties (i.e., Alameda, Los Angeles, Santa Clara and San Diego) that had developed their own unique automated case tracking systems did not change their extract software which generated the JCPSS data to comply with the new reporting guidelines; therefore these counties did not report information on this class of nonpetitioned referrals. However,

in 1987 Alameda county began to report these data. Likewise, Los Angeles and Santa Clara counties began reporting them in 1988.

The four counties which extracted the JCPSS data from their own automated case tracking systems were also unable to report some individual data elements found in the current reporting system. In some instances partial information existed and some data were "force fitted". For example, the data supplied by these four counties indicated that a youth was detained, but did not indicate the type of facility. The recoding of these data into the current format assumed that all delinquency referrals were detained in a secure detention facility and all status offense referrals were held in a nonsecure facility. This was the only legal possibility for status offense cases when the program was established. (This "force fitting" still occurs with data from San Diego county.)

An additional problem with the data is that the reporting from Los Angeles County is known to be a substantial undercount prior to 1988. The reason for this is unknown, but it probably relates to the software used to extract state data from the independent automated case tracking system in the Los Angeles County probation department. Without knowing the exact reason for the undercount, it is impossible to determine if missing cases in the Los Angeles data represent a random error or if specific case types are routinely lost.

Publications

Each year, using these data, the Bureau has published Crime and Delinquency in California and Criminal Justice Profile, which include summaries of juvenile court activity for the year. Periodically, the Bureau publishes additional "special topic" reports.

Archived Data Files

The data files contain a separate record for each delinquency or status offense disposition that occurred during the calendar year. Two types of transactions are included: 1) dispositions of juvenile delinquency or status offense referrals by a probation department; and 2) dispositions of juvenile delinquency or status offense referrals by a juvenile court. Records contain a county code and information on: the type of case; the youth's date of birth, sex, race and prior probation department status; the referral source; the referral offense; detention status; the prosecuting attorney action; defense representation; the court sustained offense; case disposition; and the date of disposition. In the data file the unit of observation is a delinquency or status offense case disposition. A case may have included more than one offense, but only the "most serious" offense (based on the severity of possible sanctions) is recorded. A juvenile may be involved in more than one case during the calendar year.

The 1980 data file does not contain information from Alameda, Los Angeles, Santa Clara and San Diego counties. The subsequent data files are complete, with the exception of the previously described undercount from Los Angeles. The data in the files are stored as numeric characters (which are in whole numbers). The Archive staff has replaced any out-of-bounds codes with missing data codes. The record for each case in the file is 46 characters in length and contains 22 variables.

Terms of Availability

The data are stored in single year files and are available for selected years or all years since 1980 as desired. To maintain the confidentiality of these records it is necessary that each request to use these data be processed through the Archive. The Archive will contact the California Bureau of Criminal Statistics and Special Services regarding their release. Upon the Bureau's authorization to release and disseminate the data, the files will be supplied to the requester by the Archive or directly by the Bureau with any necessary cautions or restrictions.

The Archive provides the data on magnetic tapes AS IS and shall not be held responsible for any liability incurred as a result of any error or omission in the data as it appears on the magnetic tapes. However, should any inconsistencies be found, the Archive asks to be notified so that corrections can be made to the data.

USING THE CODEBOOK

The information that follows is based on a study of available documentation from the data supplier (i.e., the Juvenile Court and Probation Statistical System's reporting and technical manuals and its automated conversion manuals), interviews with the data supplier and court personnel, and diagnostic analyses performed by the Archive staff. The example below is a reproduction of information appearing in the codebook for a typical variable. The numbers in brackets do not appear in the codebook, but are references to the descriptions which follow this example.

- [1] The starting location and width of the variable in the machine-readable data file. This is the format information needed to read the data into other systems.
- [2] The variable number. The variable number is used as a variable name when the file is processed by systems which use alphabetic variable names (e.g. SPSS).
- [3] The variable label used by statistical systems to identify the variable on program output.
- [4] A description of the variable contents.
- [5] The code values occurring in the data for the variable.
- [6] The textual definitions of the codes. The first 20 characters form a short value label which some systems use to document the output of analysis programs. A longer description follows the short label when necessary.

- [7] The designation of missing data. The Archive staff has replaced any out-of-bounds codes with missing data codes. Many analysis packages require that certain types of data which are usually excluded from analysis be designated as "missing data". Fields with no entry were left blank and "() No entry" is listed as a code value. Some variables also have response options representing "unknown" which are also listed as code values.


