

### TIME SERVED ON PRISON SENTENCE


During 1994, 58,044 felon inmates were paroled for the first time from a California Department of Corrections (CDC) institution. The total mean time served in CDC institutions and in custody prior to CDC was 21.3 months. The median time served was 15.8 months.

- The total mean time served, including time in custody prior to CDC, was 21.7 months for males and 17.0 months for females.
- The mean and median time served in CDC institutions was 17.1 and 12.4 months, respectively.
- The mean time served in CDC institutions was 17.5 months for males and 12.9 months for females.
- The mean time in custody prior to CDC was 4.2 months for males and 4.1 for females.

- The total mean time served for violent offenses was 33.4 months, with males serving 6.6 months longer than females (33.7 months for males and 27.1 months for females).
- The total mean time served for property offenses was 18.1 months.
- The total mean time served for drug offenses was 18.9 months.
- The total mean time served for all other offenses was 14.8 months.

Note: Time served is the time spent in CDC institutions plus the time in custody prior to reception at CDC. The prior custody time for 1989 and earlier included both the actual time spent in jail plus additional credits granted by a judge. The prior custody time for the 1994 releases does not include the credits granted by a judge.
