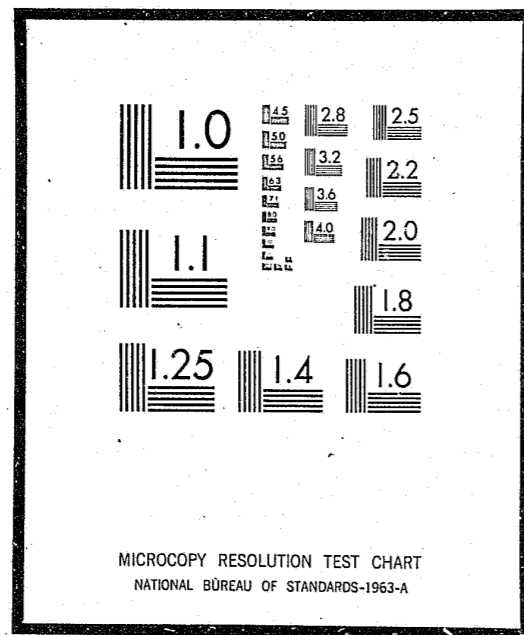



INTRODUCTION

The North Dakota Judicial Council was established as an arm of the judicial branch of State Government in 1927. Present statutory language governing the Judicial Council is found in Chapter 27-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The Council is composed of the following members:

1. All judges of the supreme court, district courts, and county courts of increased jurisdiction in the state;
2. The attorney general;
3. The dean of the school of law of the university;
4. Five members of the bar who are engaged in the practice of law who are chosen by the executive committee of the state bar association;
5. All retired judges of the supreme and district courts of the state.

In general, the Judicial Council is given the duty to make a continuous study of the judicial system of the state to the end that procedure may be simplified, business expedited and justice better administered. The members of the Council serve without compensation, but are allowed necessary expenses which are incurred in the discharge of their duties. The Chief Justice of the North Dakota Supreme Court serves as Chairman of the Judicial Council.

There are two regular meetings of the Judicial Council held each year and the chairman may call special meetings from time to time.

The Judicial Council employs an executive secretary to assist in its duties. Through the Council, the executive secretary is empowered to gather and publish statistical data concerning the courts, judges and officers thereof; to make recommendations to the Council for improvement of the judicial system; hold public hearings on behalf of the Council; and in general to lend any assistance to the Council in its efforts to improve the State's judicial system.

In 1971, the Judicial Council received a two-year grant from the North Dakota Combined Law Enforcement Council to employ a full-time Judicial Council Executive Secretary-Court Administrator. On October 1, 1971, the Chief Justice, Alvin C. Strutz, appointed Mr. Calvin N. Rolfson to fill that position, which appointment was confirmed by the Judicial Council at its October 1971 meeting. Mr. Rolfson serves both in the capacity of Judicial Council Executive Secretary and as State Court Administrator for the North Dakota Supreme Court.

Also in 1971, the Supreme Court, through a grant from the Highway Safety Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-564), administered by the North Dakota State Highway Department, employed an Assistant State Court Administrator with a municipal court and traffic court portfolio. On December 1, 1971, Mr. Howard A. Olson was appointed by Chief Justice Strutz to fill that position.

The present members of the North Dakota Judicial Council (as of June 30, 1974) are shown on later pages. There are presently 46 members on the Council.

The following pages of this report contain various charts, graphs, tables and the like, and represent judicial activity during the first half of calendar year 1974. The statistics portrayed herein do not necessarily indicate judicial accomplishments, nor are they intended to show the amount of work a particular judge has done, but how much he has to do, the status of his docket, and the amount of workload that is placed upon him and his court. With this information, certain trends can be determined in order to assist the Supreme Court in its judicial supervisory capacity and in its desire to see that justice in North Dakota is fairly and expeditiously administered.

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NORTH DAKOTA JUDICIAL COUNCIL

(Chapter 27-15, North Dakota Century Code)

CHAPTER 27-15
JUDICIAL COUNCIL

27-15-01. JUDICIAL COUNCIL ESTABLISHED. There shall be maintained a judicial council consisting of:

1. All judges of the supreme court, district courts, and county courts of increased jurisdiction of the state;
2. The attorney general;
3. The dean of the school of law of the university;
4. Five members of the bar who are engaged in the practice of law who shall be chosen by the executive committee of the state bar association; and
5. All retired judges of the supreme and district courts of the state.

27-15-02. TERM OF OFFICE - VACANCY, HOW FILLED. The judges of the supreme and district courts, the attorney general, and the dean of the school of law in the university shall hold office as members of the council during the time they occupy their respective official positions. The retired judges of the supreme and district courts shall hold office as members of the council during retirement from their respective official positions. The term of office of the county judge chosen by the supreme court, and of the members of the bar, shall be two years, commencing on the first Monday of January of odd numbered years. A vacancy shall be filled by the authority originally selecting the member.

27-15-03. ORGANIZATION OF COUNCIL - RULES OF PROCEDURE. The chief justice, during his term as chief justice, shall be chairman of the judicial council. An executive secretary shall be chosen by the council either from within or without the council. The council shall make rules for its procedure and the conduct of its business.

27-15-04. MEETINGS. The judicial council shall meet as least twice in each year at such times and places as shall be fixed by the council.

27-15-05. DUTIES. The judicial council shall make a continuous study of the operation of the judicial system of the state to the end that procedure may be simplified, business expedited, justice better administered, and shall perform any other duties which may be prescribed by law.

27-15-06. HEARINGS - SUBPOENA OF WITNESSES - COMPELLING TESTIMONY. The judicial council may hold public meetings and hearings and shall have power to require the attendance of witnesses and the production of books and documents. The district court shall have power to enforce obedience to subpoenas issued by the council and to compel the giving of testimony. Each member of the council shall have power to administer oaths in any hearing or investigation instituted by the council.

27-15-07. BUREAU OF STATISTICS - DUTIES OF OFFICERS - INFORMATION REQUIRED. The judicial council shall have the power to organize a bureau of statistics for the purpose of gathering information relating to crime and criminal and civil litigation. Judges, state's attorneys, sheriffs, the attorney general, clerks of the district courts, the board of administration, the superintending officers of penal and reformatory institutions and of asylums and other places of detention, and all other state, county, and municipal officers, boards, and commissions, shall render to the council such reports as it may request on matters within the scope of its powers. Each clerk of the district court of the state shall prepare a statement semiannually under the seal of the court showing the number of cases filed in his county, the number of cases ready for trial, and the number of cases tried during the preceding period of six months, together with such additional information as may be required by the council. Such statement shall be forwarded to the judicial council not later than January first and July first of each year.

27-15-08. REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO GOVERNOR - SUGGESTION OF RULES TO SUPREME COURT. The judicial council shall submit to the governor and the secretary of state a report as prescribed by section 54-06-04 upon the work of the various branches of the judicial system of the state. The council may recommend to the governor or to the legislative assembly such measures as it shall deem advisable and from time to time may submit for the consideration of the supreme court suggestions regarding rules of practice and procedure.

27-15-09. MEETING OF JUDGES. Immediately following each meeting of the judicial council, the judges of the supreme and district courts shall assemble for the purpose of considering matters relating to the administration of justice, including recommendations and complaints submitted to them concerning the business of the courts and their officers.

27-15-10. COMPENSATION - EXPENSES. No member of the council shall receive compensation for any services rendered by him in such capacity, but any necessary expenses incurred by any judge of the county, district and supreme courts in the discharge of his duties as a member shall be deemed expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of his office and shall be paid as such. The expenses of all other members of the council shall be audited and paid from the state bar fund in the same manner as other claims against such fund are paid except that in the matter of mileage expenses, the retired judges who are members of the council shall be paid such only for travel within the state.

THE NORTH DAKOTA JUDICIAL SYSTEM

SUPREME COURT

Chief Justice & 4 Associates. Elected for 10 year terms. Chief Justice appointed by Supreme & District Court judges from ranks of Supreme Court Justices. Chief Justice serves term of 5 years.

Final Appellate Jurisdiction in:

1. All criminal cases (felony or misdemeanor) from District Court.
2. Final judgments, orders or writs of District Court in civil cases.
3. Misdemeanor & civil cases from County Court with increased Jurisd.
4. Such other cases as provided by law.

Original Jurisdiction in:

1. Writs of habeas corpus, mandamus, quo warranto, certiorari & injunction.
2. Cases of public concern affecting sovereign rights of the State.

DISTRICT COURT

19 Judges in 6 judicial districts. Elected for 6-year terms.

Original Jurisdiction in:

1. Issuing all writs, process & commissions as provided by law.
2. All civil cases (concurrently with county justice & county judge with increased jurisd.
3. All criminal cases (concurrently with county justice & county judge with increased jurisd. in misd. cases.
4. All juvenile matters.

Appellate Jurisdiction in:

1. Final judgments of county justice Court (civil or crim.)
2. Final judgments of municipal courts.
3. Judgments, decrees or orders of county court probate matters
4. Determinations of inferior officers, boards or tribunals.

COUNTY COURT WITH INCREASED JURISDICTION

Increased jurisdiction determined by county election. 4-year terms.

Original Jurisdiction in:

1. Civil cases up to \$1000.
2. All misdemeanor cases.
3. Small claims court (up to \$200)
4. Concurrent jurisdiction with county justice court.

Appellate jurisdiction in:

1. Final judgments of municipal courts.

(NOTE: As of 7/1/73, 13 of the State's 53 counties had county courts with increased jurisd.)

COUNTY JUSTICE COURT

County-wide jurisdiction. Elected for 4-year terms.

Original jurisdiction in:

1. Civil cases up to \$200, except boundary or title disputes.
2. All misdemeanor cases.
3. Small claims court (up to \$200).
4. Institute searches & seizures.
5. Hold preliminary hearings & act as committing magistrate in felonies.
6. Other cases as provided by law.

Appellate Jurisdiction: None.

COUNTY COURT

4-year terms. Combined with County Justice Court, it becomes County with Increased Jurisdiction when approved by county electorate.

Original Jurisdiction in:

1. All probate, guardianship & other testamentary matters.

Appellate Jurisdiction: None.

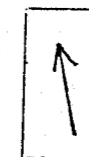

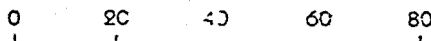

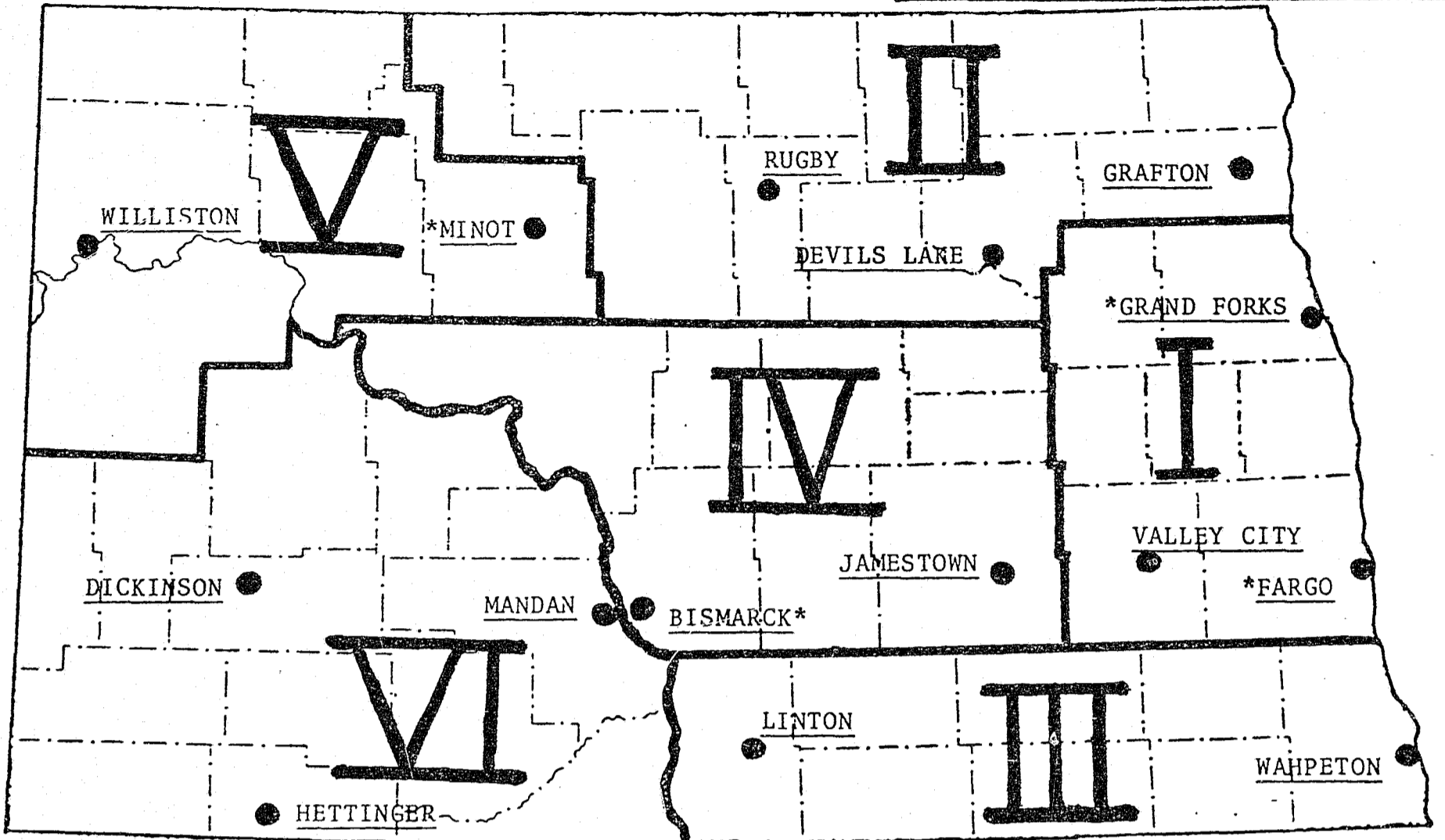
THE JUDICIAL DISTRICTS OF

SCALE OF MILES



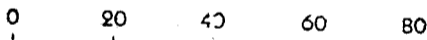

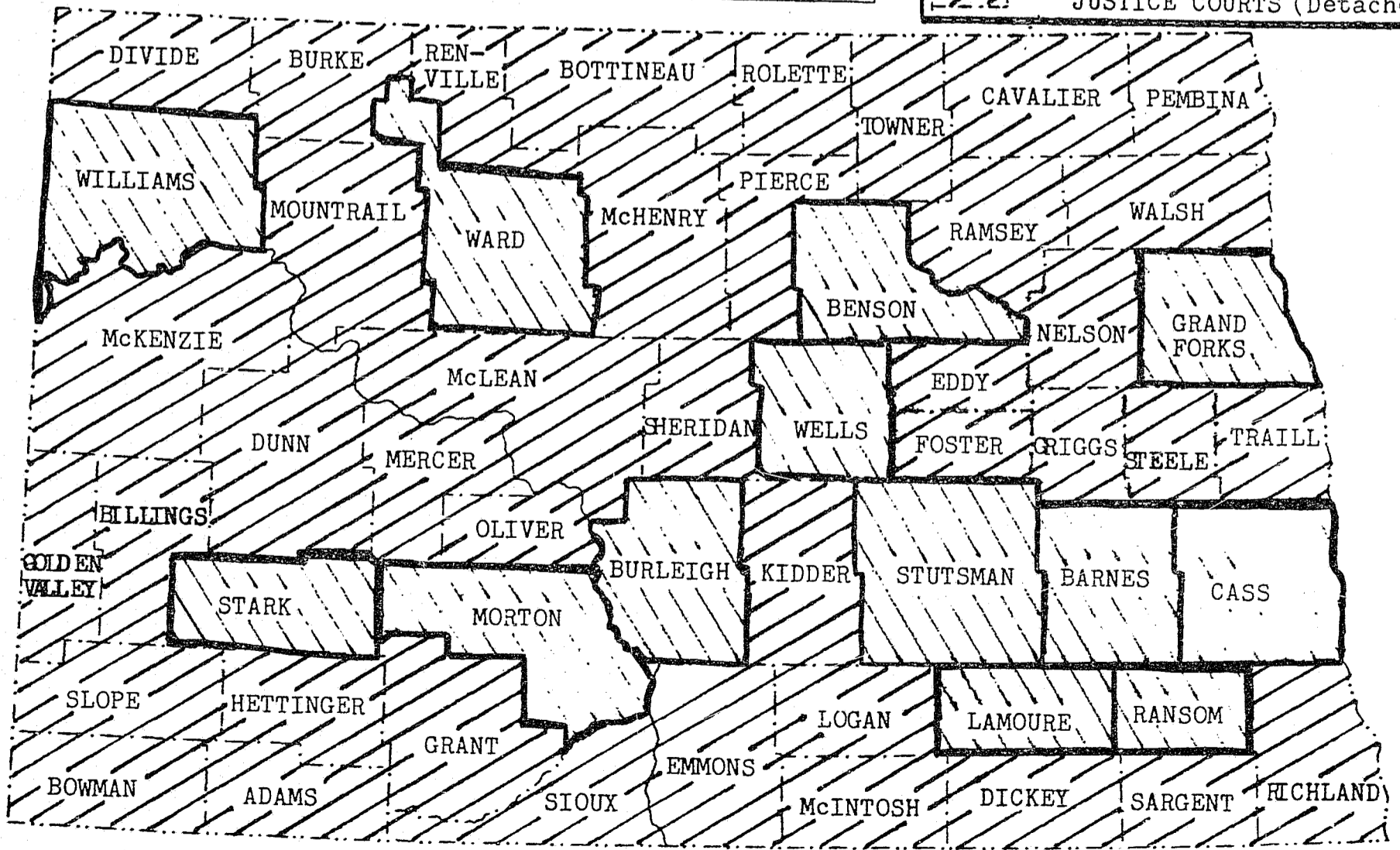
THE COUNTY COURT SYSTEM IN

A STATISTICAL OVERVIEW OF SELECTED
NORTH DAKOTA DISTRICT COURTS

Since the North Dakota judicial system provides a very necessary and vital service to our state and its people, it is important to assess, from time to time, the adequacy of the number of judges and support personnel to meet the needs of any given area and assure efficient and expeditious handling of cases. For this reason the following charts and graphs have been compiled on case load activity of district courts in North Dakota. Selected years, over the last decade, have been used with activity levels divided into three categories, namely, civil cases, criminal cases and juvenile proceedings. Following the graphs in the above categories are additional graphs illustrating the percentage of filed cases decided during the reporting period to show the degree to which case-load has changed and to give the reader an opportunity to review how expeditiously the cases are being decided.

These graphs are not intended to indicate how hard the District Judges in one judicial district are working compared to other districts. This data is merely supplied as one uniform measurement of workload.

The following comments will address current and future problems in the first and fourth judicial districts relative to case load, cases decided, and demographic changes in the last decade. Later publications will focus on statistics from other judicial districts.

FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT

The first judicial district encompasses the counties of Barnes, Cass, Grand Forks, Griggs, Nelson, Steele and Traill. Since 1960 the population has increased by 22,400 with the greatest impact in Cass and Grand Forks counties. 1985 population projections suggest an increase in the twin cities of Fargo, North Dakota-Moorhead, Minnesota of 49% to 142,100. The increase for Grand Forks is anticipated at 27% to 61,900. As the population increases it follows that the level of litigation will increase on a proportionate basis.¹

A review of the following data from selected years of the North Dakota Judicial Council Statistical Compilation and Report shows changes in the number of filings by case categories of civil, criminal and juvenile; and also the percentage increase from the earlier selected reporting period. The bar graph following the data on cases shows the filed number and percentage of cases decided for the same reporting period. The reader should note that the percentage of cases decided has generally decreased. This decrease in percentage of cases decided can be attributed to a host of reasons. Primarily, however, the data shows an ever-increasing backlog of judicial matters in the first district.

FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

The fourth judicial district encompasses the counties of Burleigh, Eddy, Foster, Kidder, McLean, Sheridan, Stutsman, and Wells. From 1960 until 1973 the district population has remained the same. However, this can be expected to change markedly by 1985. Projections suggest a 46% increase for Bismarck-Mandan to 70,600 people. Projections for Jamestown show an increase of 29% to 21,300 people. The increases do not take into consideration potential impact resulting from development of Coal Gasification, and increased electrical generating plant construction north and west of Bismarck-Mandan. Secondly, as the State Capitol and State Penitentiary are located in this district, the vast majority of litigation concerning state agencies flows through the district court in this district.

A review of the bar graphs show an increase in case filings for the last ten years with a stable population base for all categories. As in the case of the first judicial district the percentage of cases decided has been declining suggesting a build up of pending cases.

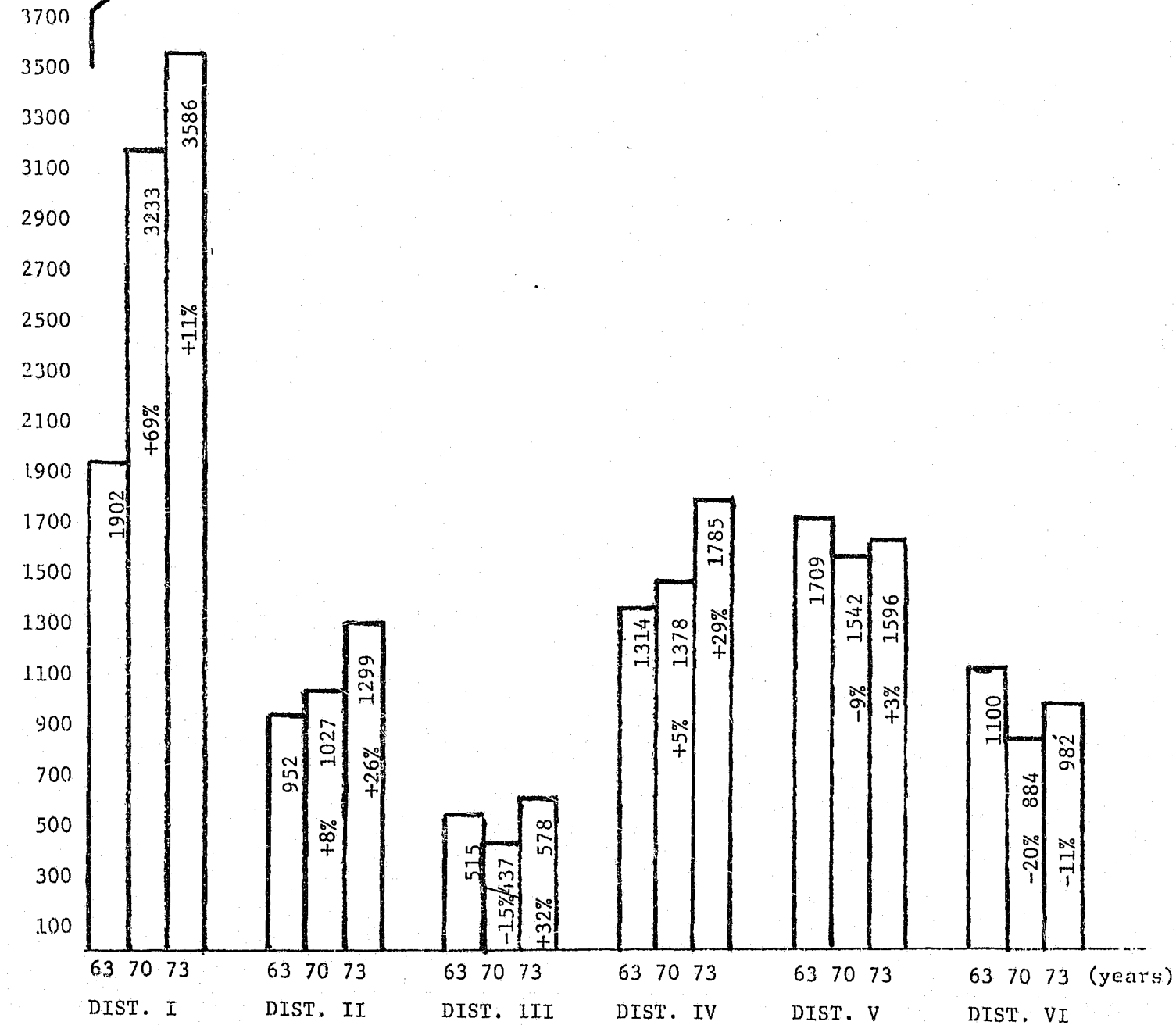

(Total cases pending at beginning of year, and cases filed during year)



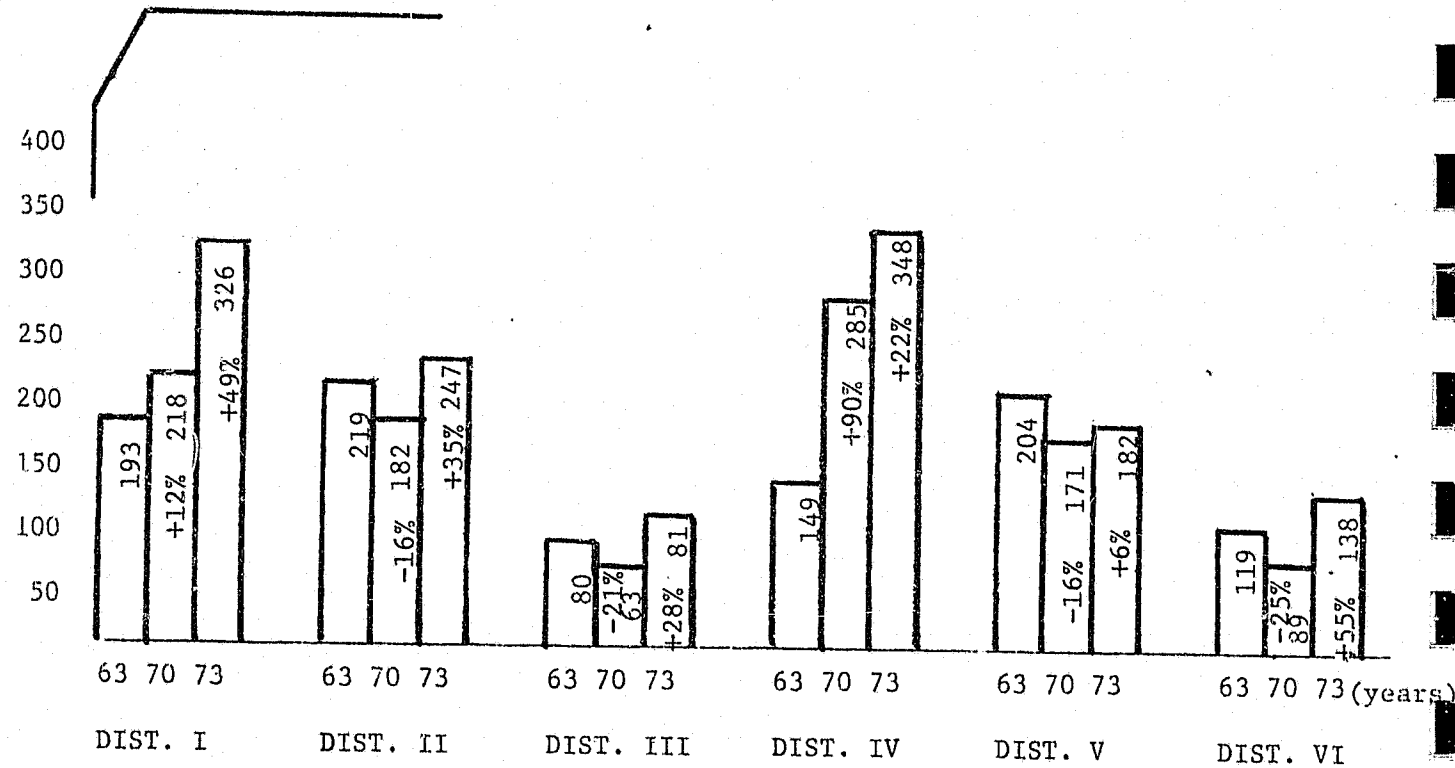

(Total cases pending at beginning of year + cases filed during year.)



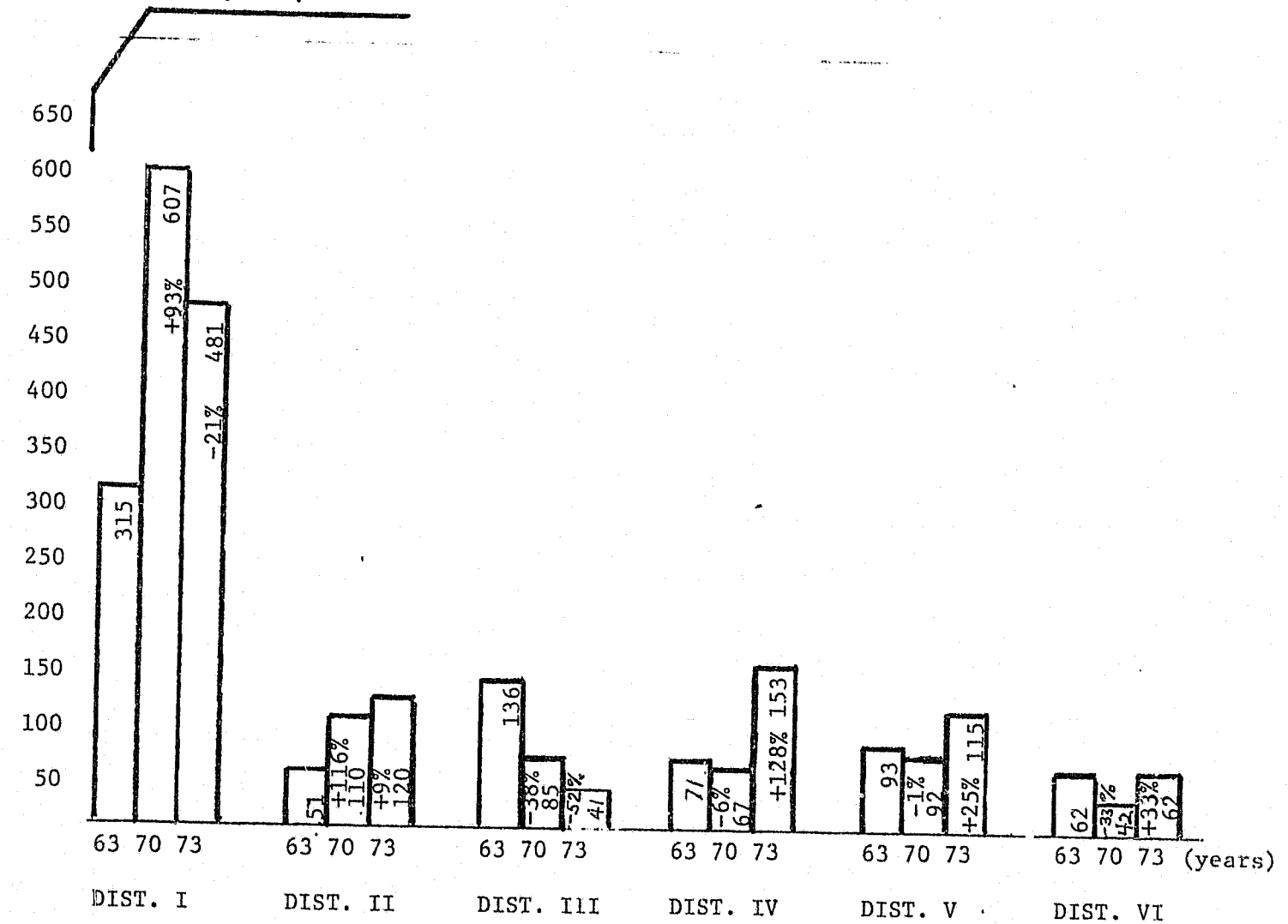

(Total proceedings pending at beginning of year + proceedings filed during the year.)

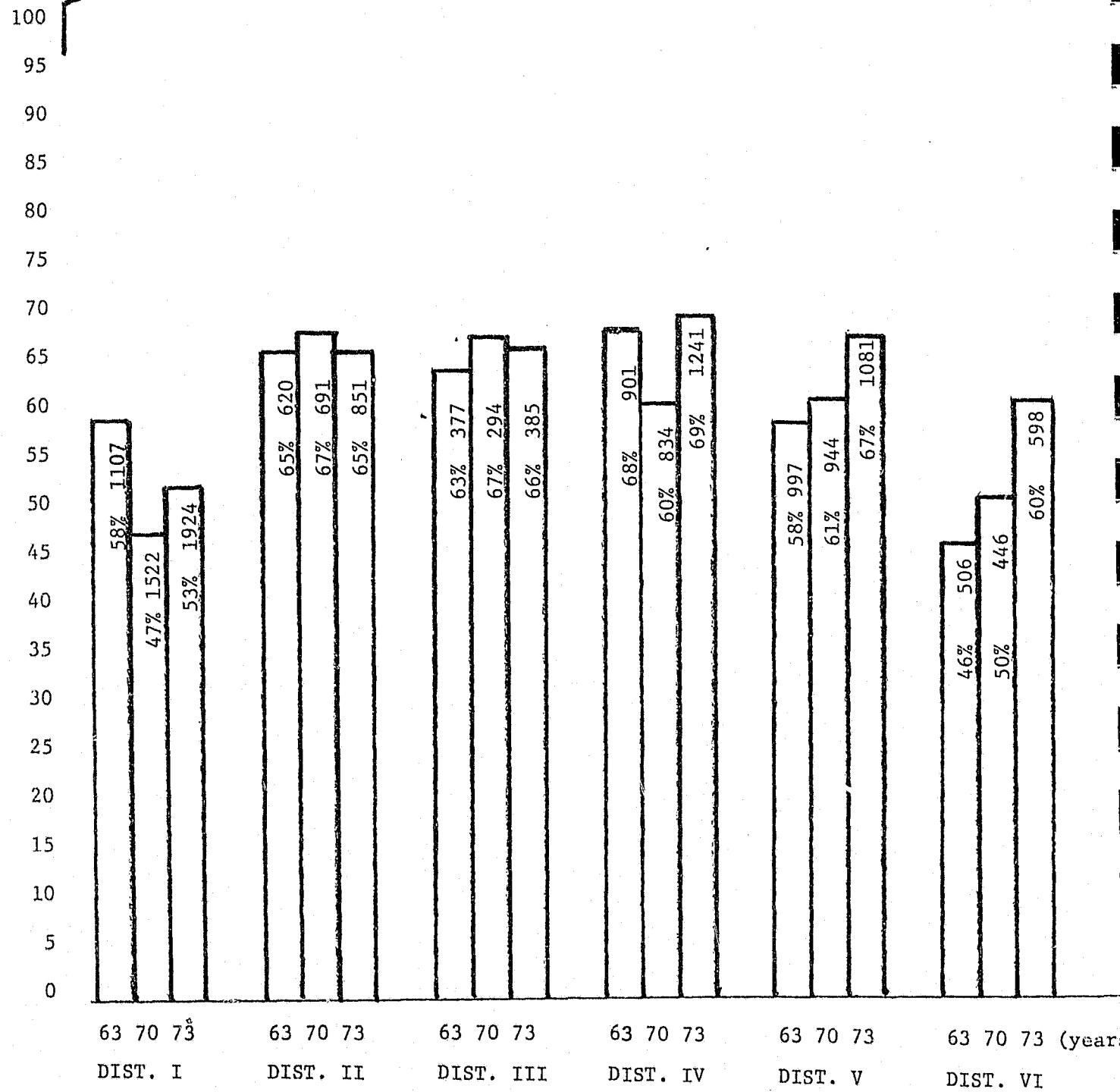

% of cases completed during selected reporting period.

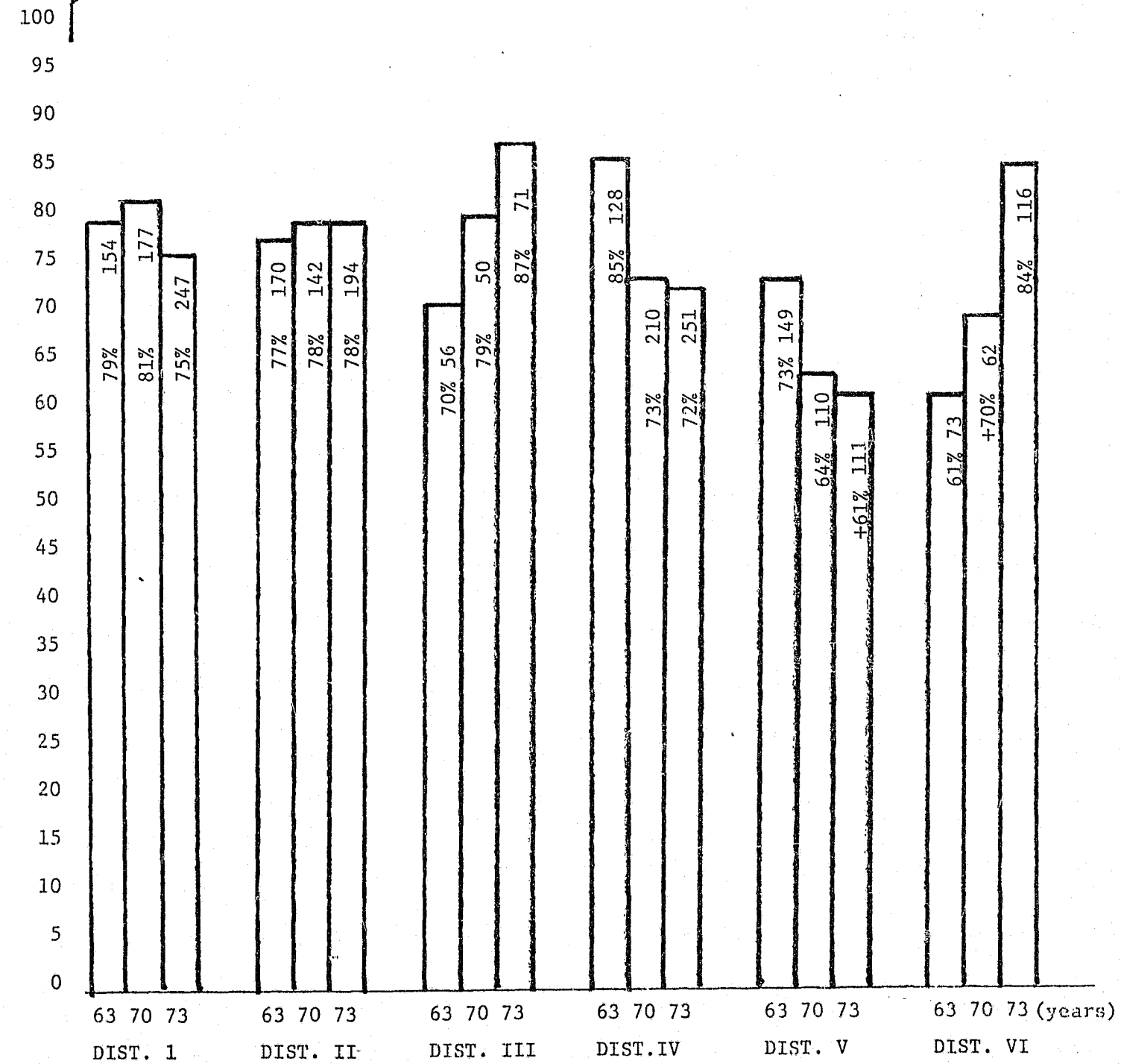

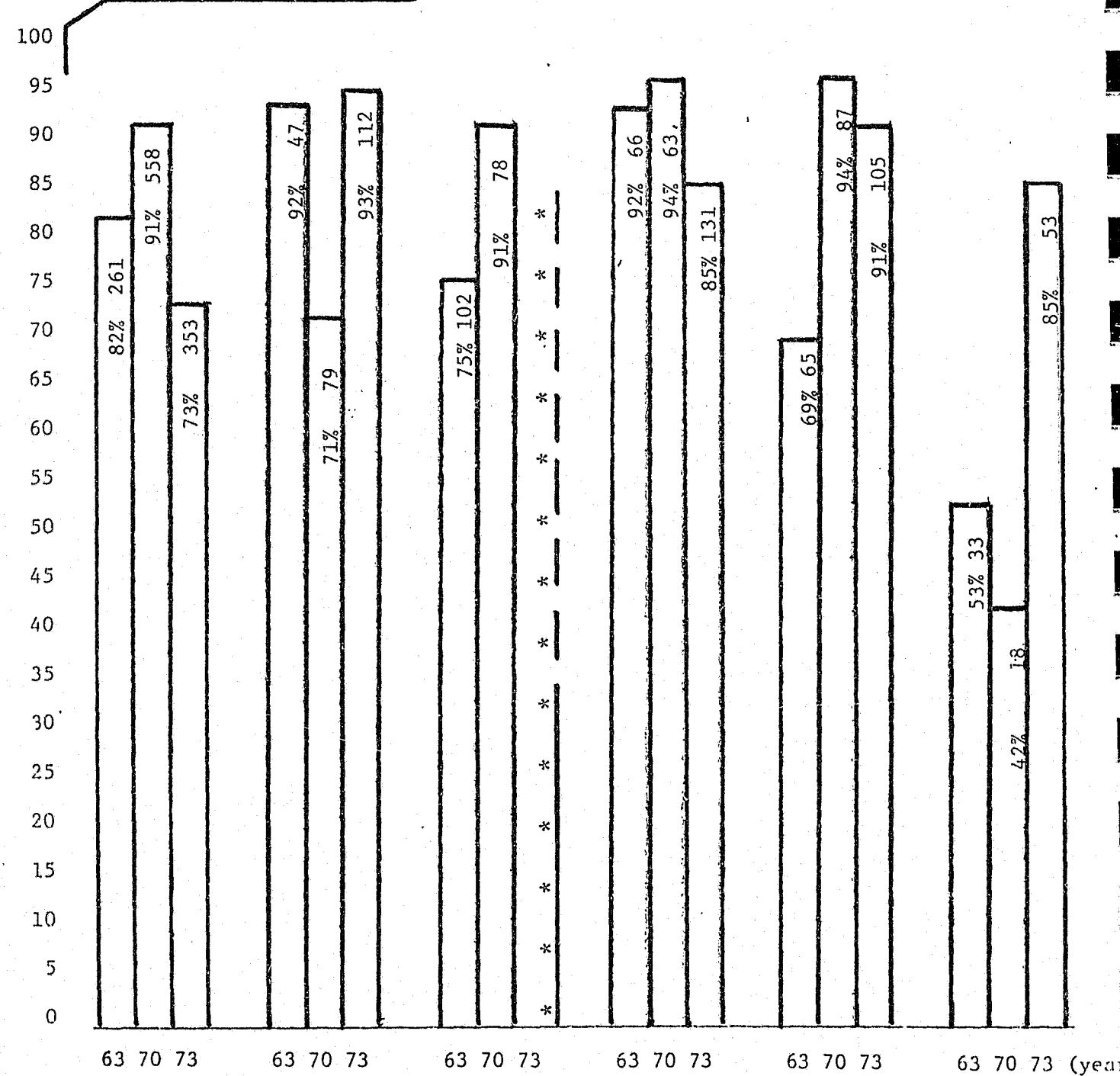
% of cases completed during selected reporting periods.
