



INTRODUCTION

This supplemental report deals with the Arresting Agencies,
Offenses and Final Dispositions from the Justice Courts in District 6,
Douglas County, Oregon during the year 1970.

The initial Research Findings report, published February 25, 1972, displayed the jail bookings data and District Court data for District 6 during 1970. Justice Court data was unavailable at that time.

Municipal Court data was not collected because the relatively large number of cases would require a significantly longer period of time be spent collecting data. Also, a large percentage of the cases are relatively minor in nature and not pertinent to the general purpose of this study.

The data from the two District 6 Circuit Courts was omitted because a significant amount of this information is derived from the jail records data in the original Research Findings.

The data in this report was compiled from the reports (continuation sheets) which the courts provide to the State Department of Revenue. Pretrial dispositions are not recorded on those reports and, therefore, not displayed herein.

Justice of the Peace Courts in Oregon are restricted in jurisdiction to traffic offenses and petty misdemeanors. Fines are widely used as dispositions for these cases as evidenced by Justice Court statistics found in other Feasibility Study reports: District 1, 92%; District 3, 95%; and District 9, 81%.

In District 6, the municipalities of Canyonville, Drain, Glendale and Reedsport have Justice Courts.

FINDINGS

Canyonville Justice Court

Table 1 shows the arresting agency responsible for 75% (994 of 1328) of Canyonville's Justice Court cases is the Oregon State Police. The Douglas County Sheriff's Department arrested 19% (251 of 1328) of the total, with all other agencies accounting for the remaining 6% (82 of 1328).

Table 2 indicates that traffic offenses made up 91% (1199 of 1310) of all cases coming before the Canyonville Justice Court.

Table 3 verifies the introductory statement claiming that fines are widely used as dispositions for Justice Courts. Out of 1328 cases, simple fines accounted for 1032 dispositions or 77%. An additional 8 cases were a combination of jail and fine and 90 cases were fines, partially suspended, bringing the total percentage of dispositions involving fines to 85% (1130 of 1328).

Drain Justice Court

Table 4 compares with Table 1 in that the arresting agency accounting for the majority of cases handled by the Drain Justice Court is the Oregon State Police with 75% (634 of 851). The County Sheriff's Department is the second highest contributor to this Court with 133 of the total of 851 or 16%.

Table 5 displays a predominance of traffic offenses (92% or 779 of 851), with Minor In Possession totalling 22 of the total 851 cases for 3%.

Table 6 lists the fines for the Drain Justice Court which represents 79% (676 of 851) of all its dispositions. Suspended fines equal 51 of all actions or 6%. Ninety-one cases were dismissed.

Glendale Justice Court

Table 7 is consistent with previous tables in that 84% (365 of 432) of all cases brought to the Glendale Justice Court were arrested by the Oregon State Police. The Douglas County Sheriff's Office arrested 9% (38 of 432).

As with the other Justice Courts, the Weighmaster accounted for a significant number of citations at Glendale with 7% (29 of 432).

Table 8 verifies that traffic cases are the most common for Justice Courts. Glendale Justice Court had 407 traffic cases or 94% of the total work load.

Table 9 parallels the other courts' dispositions with Glendale Justice Court, having 92% (396 of 432) of its actions involving fines as the disposition. An additional 14 cases had their fines suspended and 4 had part of their fines suspended.

Reedsport Justice Court

Table 10 shows Reedsport Justice Court cases come primarily from the Oregon State Police as the arresting agency (89% or 2349 of 2639). The Douglas County Sheriff's Department and the Weighmaster accounted for 9% (239 of 2639) of the arrests. Reedsport City Police arrested 33 of the cases coming before that Justice Court or 1%.

Table 11 again demonstrates that traffic offenses are by far the most common with 2222 of the total 2639 cases (86%). Game violations stand out, representing 5% (141 of 2639) of all the cases.

Table 12 follows the trend of fines as the most frequent disposition in the Reedsport Justice Court (79% or 2093 of 2639). Fines were involved in 40 other cases to varying degrees. As with the other Justice Courts, jail is seldom used as a Justice Court disposition.

MONTHLY COURT LOADS

Graphs I, II, III and IV show varying peaks in monthly court work loads. Reedsport Justice Court shows the typically high July docket, but Glendale Justice Court had its high in December, and Drain Justice Court in April. Canyonville Justice Court was represented by relatively high monthly dockets during September, November and December.

Number of Cases Per Month



Number of Cases Per Month



Number of Cases Per Month




