# **Planning Board**

Handles major sub-divisions. Maintains map files, etc.

#### **Prosecutor's Office**

Chief law enforcement officer of county. Trial of all criminal cases, etc. See pages 41-43 for addresses and list of New Jersey County Prosecutors.

#### Sheriff's Office

Supervises the county jail personnel. Supervises court attendants. Serves civil suit papers—conducts foreclosure sales, etc.

# Surrogate's Office

Probates wills, maintains records of estates, administrators, executors, etc.

# Taxation, Board of

Hears appeals from municipal tax assessments. Prepares equalization tables and orders reassessments by municipalities.

#### Treasurer

Collects all monies due the county, maintains records of accounts and reports to Board of Freeholders all receipts and disbursements.

#### Welfare Office

Controls and supervises granting of funds to qualified individuals subject to county, state and federal regulations.

Reviews applications for subdivisions of land. Prepares master plan for the community. Advises governing body re planning and zoning. Reviews for approval zoning ordinance amendments. Power of boards vary—See N.J. Statutes as to any particular municipality.
