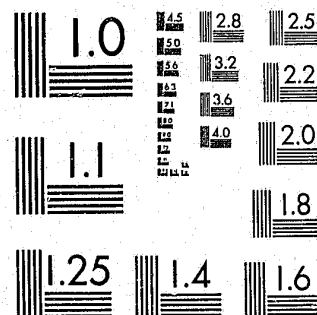

Background

ACQUISITIONS

In its original operating plan the Center proposed to construct criminal, social, and economic profiles for a sample of 2000 offenders in California. The basic concept of constructing such profiles was accepted by the Institute. However, it was mutually agreed upon to conduct a pilot study before proceeding with the full scale data collection project.

Our pilot study involved a target of 100 offender profiles. These offenders were selected from random samples of offenders drawn by the Bureau of Criminal Statistics and the California Department of Corrections. Each agency supplied a sample of 1000 individuals. The BCS sample was a random sample of persons arrested for a property crime in Southern California between 1968 and 1975. The CDC sample involved 500 offenders who were in prison in 1975 and 500 offenders who were released from a California prison in 1970.

The pilot project is now basically complete and the number of individuals actually included in the data set described in this code book is 92. Of this pilot sample, 68 came from the CDC sample and 24 from BCS. However, all these individuals committed at least one crime in the County of Los Angeles.

Information on criminal and economic histories can be obtained from the summary files of the CDC and BCS in Sacramento. Detailed data is also available from the local probation departments. These offices must prepare a report on each offender for the use of the judge in determining the appropriate sentence. Files will therefore

be kept even for offenders who do not receive probation. In order to test the cost effectiveness of using the detailed Los Angeles probation files, 20 offender profiles did not make use of the probation data.

Arrangement of Data

The data for each individual are coded on a series of 72-character card images. A number in column 1 of each card identifies the type of information to be found on that card.

Each individual profile begins with two cards having the identifier 1. The first "1" card contains general information about the offender, such as age, sex, race, education, and IQ. The second "1" card gives the number of data points contained on the other cards.

The item "type of profile" in columns 3-6 of the first "1" card tells whether the individual was drawn from the BCS sample or the CDC sample. The code also identifies those CDC profiles for which the Los Angeles probation department information was not used. Some CDC profiles lack parole information from the CDC files in Sacramento. These are identified as well.

The "1" cards are followed by cards identified by the number "2". These describe felonies with which the offenders were charged, and for which detailed information is available from CDC or BCS files. The "2" cards come in pairs; each pair describes one charge. If the offender was charged with several offenses at the same time, there will be corresponding pairs of "2" cards.

Within each pair, the first "2" card gives details about the offense and its disposition. The second "2" card provides economic information about the offender at the time of the offense, including wages, other income, and assets.

Cards with identification numbers 3, 4, or 5 give information about the individual for periods when he was, respectively, on probation, on parole, or in prison. In the case of "3" or "4" cards, the date on which the individual was arrested for the offense to which the probation or parole is related is coded on the card. The card itself may follow the corresponding pair of "2" cards (which will also carry this date), or it may appear behind all of the "2" cards. The "5" cards, however, carry no dates; each "5" card is related to the pair of "2" cards which most nearly precedes it in the profile.

Cards with identification numbers 6 and 7 carry information about the individual's employment record and his location, respectively. The employment record contains gaps where information is not available; each entry carries the date the job began, and the number of months it lasted. As many as three employment records are coded on each "6" card. The location entries on the "7" cards do not carry dates; only the number of months in each location is coded. The entries are arranged to completely fill the time from the individual's date of birth to the most recent entry. Gaps in the available information are filled with "unknown" entries. As many as seven entries are coded on each card, beginning with the most recent location.

Each individual profile ends with a set of cards having the identification number 8. These contain a complete arrest record, or "rap sheet," for the individual. The offenses coded on the "2" cards also appear on the "8" cards. The "8" cards, however, also include arrests

for misdemeanors, arrests on suspicion, and arrests for which detailed information is not available. The date of each arrest is coded; the "8" card entries are not always in chronological order. As many as four entries are coded on each "8" card.

A listing of the BCS offense code is enclosed with this code book. The BCS occupation code may be found in the Dictionary of Occupational Titles, published by the Department of Labor.

An example of a coded offender profile is shown on page 9.

### Data Presentations

Three alternative methods have been prepared for presenting subsets of the information contained in the pilot data set.

Presentation 1 displays the data for each individual in chronological order, starting at age 0. For each year, the available information is grouped in columns for location, expenditures, income and assets, employment and work history, criminal activity, punishment, and personal traits. When information is available from two different sources, both are printed together. The "individual number" shown in presentation 1 is a counter internal to the program which created the presentation. It is not the same as the "I.D. Number" for that individual coded in the data set.

Presentation 2 arranges the data by offense. For each offense appearing on a "2" card, the information coded on the "2" cards is displayed, together with general information about the offender. The crimes are divided between those against property and those against individuals. For each crime, the presentation tells how many crimes of each type the offender had committed previously.

At the end of Presentation 2, there are two frequency counts. One gives the frequency of each type of crime by BCS code. The other gives the frequency of crimes by the number of prior crimes the offender had committed. An example of presentation 2 is shown on page 10.

Presentation 3 gives general information about each individual, and then supplies a frequency count of his rap sheet entries by BCS offense code. An example of presentation 3 is shown on pages 11-13.

A Note on Data Limitations

The information coded in the offender profiles is sometimes incomplete. Economic data in particular have been difficult to obtain. Chart 1, on page 14, gives a summary of the number of crimes detailed on "2" cards for which information on location, wage rates, rent, or assets is available. All of these items are coded for 45 of a total of 365 crimes, or 12.3%.

Chart 2 on page 15 gives a breakdown of some characteristics of the information found on the "8" cards.

Of the 92 profiles in the pilot data set, 31 contain some wage information. Sixteen profiles contain a sequence in which wage information is available both before and after an arrest. Of those 16 profiles, eight drew all of their wage information from the Los Angeles probation files, seven drew upon both the probation files and the summary files in Sacramento, and one profile used information from Sacramento only.
