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CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES SEIZED IN CALIFORNIA, 1978

INTRODUCTION

This report was prepared by the Bureau of Criminal Statistics (BCS) to comply with Section 11487 of the California Health and Safety Code, effective from 1977 through 1979. This section requires that the Attorney General submit an annual report to the Governor and the Legislature showing the amounts, types, and dispositions of controlled substances seized by California city, county, and state agencies

Data on controlled substances seized by federal agencies operating in California are also included. Although the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) reported the amounts, it was unable to report the number of seizures made during 1978.

Data on the disposition of seized substances are not included since all agencies reported disposing of such substances in the manner prescribed by law (i.e., turning the substances over to the Attorney General for destruction).

Several factors have, for a number of years, been thought to influence the types and amounts of controlled substances seized in a particular jurisdiction, county, or geographic area. Among these factors are:

- Proximity to an international border;
- Presence of major ports of entry (including international airports);
- Existence of remote areas that support manufacturing, smuggling, and cultivating activities;
- Relationship to large metropolitan areas; and
- Enforcement practices and policies and availability of resources.

This report, however, makes no attempt to evaluate or draw conclusions concerning the effects of these factors on the drug problem in California.

DATA LIMITATIONS

The controlled substance data included in this report are accurate and complete to the extent that contributing agencies met their reporting obligations. Known limitations which apply to the data are as follows:

Duplicate reporting — It is possible that duplicate reporting occurred when two or more agencies were involved in a seizure.

Unidentified substances — Substances reported only as "other pills" or "assorted pills and capsules" were omitted from this report due to the lack of determination of their composition. Those substances reported as "other hallucinogens," "other narcotics," or "other barbiturates" were included and combined in the tables under the heading "All Other (not reported by schedule)."

Weight determinations — Reporting agencies did not always weigh substances, nor did they always report the amounts seized by the gram weight. In some cases, gram weights were determined by estimating or by using a conversion table supplied with the reporting form (shown in Appendix A). This conversion table was prepared using information supplied by the Bureau of Forensic Services of the California Department of Justice. Substances not reported by weight were reported instead by the number of dosage units or plants.

Absence of quantitative analyses — Quantitative analyses of seized substances were not routinely performed, generally due to workload and/or funding constraints. The resulting gram weight data must therefore be presumed, in most cases, to include those adulterants generally associated with particular controlled substances.

Reported number of seizures — Caution should be used when relating gram weights to numbers of seizures. Information was not always available at the agency level to correctly report the number of seizures. As previously stated, these data were not reported by the federal DEA for 1978.

DISCUSSION

The term "seizure," as used in this report, means taking possession of a controlled substance and includes acquiring materials through evidence seizures and buys, as well as taking custody of found or abandoned substances.

The determination of the types of controlled substances to be reported is based on the California Uniform Controlled Substances Act (Health and Safety Code Sections 11000 – 11651). The Act categorizes controlled substances into five schedules which group those substances with similar potentials for abuse, medical uses, and known dependency-producing abilities. The types of substances in each schedule are: Schedule I — marijuana (concentrated and unconcentrated), heroin, lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), and designated opiates, opium derivatives, and hallucinogens; Schedule II — amphetamines, methamphetamines, cocaine, and certain opiates, opium derivatives, and stimulants; Schedule III — phencyclidine (PCP), barbiturates, methaqualone, and designated opium derivatives and depressants; Schedule IV — phenobarbital and certain depressants; Schedule V — opium derivatives, such as cough syrups with codeine. The criteria for placing a substance in one of the five schedules are shown in Appendix B.

Table 1 represents a statewide summary of amounts and types of reported controlled substances seized by federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies during 1978. Table 2 summarizes the number of seizures and the amounts and types of controlled substances seized by state and local law enforcement agencies. A summary for each county of the number of seizures and the amounts seized as reported by local law enforcement agencies (police and sheriff's departments and narcotic task forces) within that county are shown in Table 3. Table 4 displays data for individual district offices and ports of entry for the federal DEA and the United States Customs Service.

Discussion relative to the amounts of controlled substances seized is limited to reported gram weights only. The numbers of reported dosage units and plants are ignored in most instances because gram weight equivalents could not be determined.

STATEWIDE SUMMARY

These statewide data show a combined total of more than 88.8 million grams of controlled substances seized. As shown in Table 1, in 1978, federal agencies accounted for 28.5 percent of the total amount of controlled substances seized, state agencies 12.4 percent, and local law enforcement agencies 59.1 percent.

Schedule I substances represented the highest volume of seizures primarily because marijuana (a substance easily identified and usually found in bulk) was seized more often and in greater amounts than any other controlled substance. Total reported grams of marijuana seized were 85,598,141, or 96.4 percent of the total 88,826,100 grams of all controlled substances seized in California. Although this is a substantial amount, it does not necessarily indicate that marijuana is California's major drug problem.

Table 2 presents state and local law enforcement data and shows that, in 1978, local law enforcement agencies reported 88.2 percent of the seizures, which accounted for 82.7 percent of the grams seized. State agencies reported 11.8 percent of the seizures and 17.3 percent of the grams seized. Although a variety of state agencies have been involved in controlled substance seizures, the California Department of Justice has the only active statewide narcotic enforcement program. This program, administered by the Investigation and Enforcement Branch (IEB), provides assistance to federal and local law enforcement agencies in the apprehension of major and multijurisdictional violators. In 1978, many seizures resulting from the combined efforts of IEB and local or federal agencies were reported by the local or federal agency involved.

COUNTY SUMMARY

As shown in Table 3, local law enforcement agencies in all California counties reported a combined total of 86,532 seizures in 1978. This resulted in reported substance seizures of 52.5 million grams, as well as 255,119 unweighed dosage units and 10,437 unweighed marijuana plants. There were four counties in which local law enforcement agencies reported seized substances in amounts exceeding 2.0 million grams. These counties — Humboldt, Los Angeles, Santa Cruz, and Trinity — which represent only 33.2 percent of the state's population, reported 30,138 (34.8 percent) of the total 86,532 seizures, and 44.8 million (85.2 percent) of the total 52.5 million grams reported for all counties.

Los Angeles County, the most populous county with 31.9 percent of the state's total population, accounted for 28,774 (33.3 percent) of the total reported seizures, but only 9.3 million (17.6 percent) of the total grams seized.

The remaining three counties, Humboldt, Santa Cruz, and Trinity, have remote areas that support marijuana cultivation activities. These counties, each with less than one percent of the state's population, together had a combined total of 1,364 (1.6 percent) of the total seizures in the state as reported by local law enforcement agencies. However, these counties accounted for 35.5 million (67.6 percent) of the total grams seized. Trinity County, the least populous of the three counties, accounted for 25.4 million (48.4 percent) of the total gram seizures. Marijuana was the primary substance seized.

FEDERAL AGENCIES

Data reported by the DEA and the U.S. Customs Service are displayed in Table 4 by district offices and ports of entry in California. Neither agency reported any seizures of substances named under Schedules IV or V and as previously mentioned, the DEA did not report the number of seizures it made.

Of the 25.3 million grams seized by the federal agencies, 11.7 million (46.3 percent) were seized by the DEA, and 13.6 million (53.7 percent) by the Customs Service. Federal agency seizures at border cities such as Andrade, Calexico, San Diego, San Ysidro, and Tecate amounted to 11.2 million grams, or 44.5 percent of the total federal seizures in California. The two agencies reported a combined total of 9.4 million grams of controlled substances seized in the Los Angeles area. This represents 37.0 percent of total federal seizures in California.

COMMON WEIGHTS OF STREET QUANTITY DRUGS (Gross Weights Including Adulterants)

The following table may be used to convert dosage units to gram weights where it would be impractical to actually weigh the seized material. It must be recognized that the weights shown represent an average. The true weights of materials seized may show a wide variance from these averages. For that reason it is preferable that the agency responsible for a seizure weigh the substance rather than compute its weight by multiplying the number of units by an arbitrary weight per unit. Gross weight including the weight of any adulterants (but not the weight of the container such as paper, balloon, etc.) is called for rather than net weight. It would be impossible to determine the true net weight of many substances without actually subjecting them to laboratory analysis. The following list is not intended to be all inclusive. It can be used as a guide in computing the weights of other controlled substances not specifically listed.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This reporting form must be completed and forwarded to the Bureau of Criminal Statistics (BCS) in compliance with Section 11487 of the Health and Safety Code which requires that "each city, county, or state agency coming into possession of a controlled substance pursuant to the provisions of this chapter shall report semiannually to the Attorney General the amounts, kind, and disposition of controlled substances so seized."

For purposes of this report, only law enforcement agencies directly involved in the seizure of controlled substances are required to report. All substances turned over to a laboratory for analysis will be reported by the law enforcement agency which sent the material to the laboratory. In the same manner, substances held as evidence by county clerks or court clerks will be reported by the law enforcement agency responsible for the seizure.

It is not necessary that all seizures be subjected to laboratory analysis for determination of drug content or weight. Determinations based on officers' experience or field tests are adequate. The weights of seized material need not be precise. The conversion table attached should be used to convert dosage units to a gram weight when the substance seized has not actually been weighed.

In those instances where two or more agencies are involved in a particular seizure it is essential that it be reported by only one of the agencies to prevent duplication. Unless there are other commitments, the agency having responsibility for storage of the seized material should be the one to report.

Reports for the first half of the year should be submitted no later than AUGUST 15TH. Those for the second half of the year should be sent by FEBRUARY 15TH. In no instance should any report reflect amounts of controlled substances seized prior to, or following, the six-month reporting period. If no substances are seized during a six-month period, please submit a negative report by recording "none" diagonally across the form.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Reporting Agency - Type, or print clearly, the agency name.

Reporting Period - Check the box that indicates for which half-year the seizure data are being reported and type, or print clearly, the last two digits of the year.

Code - Do not use this space; this space is for BCS use only.

Schedule — To identify names of controlled substances to be listed, refer to the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, Sections 11054—11058 of the Health and Safety Code.

Type, or print clearly, the specific name of the controlled substance under the appropriate schedule number.

Number of Seizures - Show the number of seizures made for each specific drug. When two or more types of drugs are seized at one time, count one seizure for each drug.

Weights — Type, or print clearly, the amounts, in grams and tenths of a gram, of each controlled substance seized. When converting from ounces or pounds to grams, use 28.35 grams to the ounce or 453.60 grams to the pound. Enter gross weights including weight of the adulterant if any. Do not include the weight of the container (can, box, bottle, paper, etc.). The amount shown should reflect an accumulated (summary) total for the entire six-month period for each specific controlled substance seized. If the total quantity of a specific substance seized during the entire six-month period is less than one-tenth of a gram it should not be reported.

Dosage Units - Show the number of dosage units seized for substances such as LSD where weights would be inappropriate.

Exceptions — If, after completing the sections above, you determine that a controlled substance is not being retained as evidence; is not in storage pending destruction; or has not been destroyed in a manner prescribed by law; this must be noted in the "exceptions" section of the form. Type, or print clearly, the specific name of the substance, the amount, and the disposition.

Criteria for Classifying Controlled Substances

The California Uniform Controlled Substances Act is based upon the Federal Controlled Substances Act, which sets forth the following criteria for establishing the placement of a particular substance in any one of the five schedules:

Schedule I

- The substance has a high potential for abuse.
- The substance has no currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States.
- There is a lack of accepted safety for use of the drug or other substance under medical supervision.

Schedule II

- The substance has a high potential for abuse.
- The substance has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States or a currently accepted medical use with severe restrictions.
- Abuse of the substance may lead to severe psychological or physical dependence.

Schedule III

- The substance has a potential for abuse less than the substances in Schedules I and II.
- The substance has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States.
- Abuse of the substance may lead to moderate or low physical dependence or high psychological dependence.

Schedule IV

- The substance has a low potential for abuse relative to the substances in Schedule III.
- The substance has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States.

• Abuse of the substance may lead to limited physical dependence or psychological dependence relative to the substances in Schedule III.

Schedule V

- The substance has a low potential for abuse relative to the substances in Schedule IV.
- The substance has a currently accepted medical use in treatment in the United States.
- Abuse of the substance may lead to limited physical dependence or psychological dependence relative to the substances in Schedule IV.

The eight specific factors shown below are considered prior to placing a controlled substance in a particular schedule:

- 1. Its actual or relative potential for abuse;
- 2. Scientific evidence of its pharmacological effect, if known;
- 3. The state of current scientific knowledge regarding the drug or other substance;
- 4. Its history and current pattern of abuse;
- 5. The scope, duration, and significance of abuse;
- 6. What, if any, risk there is to the public health;
- 7. Its physical or psychological dependence ability; and
- 8. Whether the substance is an immediate precursor of a substance already controlled.

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
