Tables 1-8 of this bulletin contain information concerning 3,212 males and 126 females residing in Wisconsin adult correctional institutions on December 31, 1978. Adult males were housed in the Wisconsin State Prison, Wisconsin State Reformatory, Wisconsin Correctional Institution-Fox Lake, Kettle Moraine Correctional Institution, Oakhill Correctional Institution, and seven camps of the Wisconsin Correctional Camp System. Adult females resided in Taycheedah Correctional Institution, which had been coeducational until February 1978.

Tables 9-16 present characteristics of the 73 men and 21 women who resided in the five Community Correctional Residential Centers supervised by the Bureau of Community Corrections: Baker House, St. Johns, Men's Community Correctional Center, Women's Community Center, and Abode. These facilities, intended for persons who will soon be re-entering the community, are all located in Milwaukee.

The Youthful Offender Act, Chapter 54 of the Wisconsin Statutes, with respect to new institutionalization, was repealed by Chapter 418, Laws of 1977, effective July 1, 1978. Consequently, characteristics of youthful offenders are not described separately in this report. There were 93 youthful offenders residing in adult correctional institutions and one youthful offender in a Community Correctional Residential Center on December 31, 1978; they are included in the data contained in this report.

RESIDENTS IN ADULT INSTITUTIONS

The end-of-year adult male population rose by 3.7 percent from a year ago, reaching a five-year high of 3,212. For the second successive year, the number of females declined. The year-end total of 126 women was 6.7 percent lower than the 135 women resident on December 31, 1977.

The proportion of male residents institutionalized for less than a year dropped steadily, from 51.3 percent in 1974 to 40.2 percent at the end of 1978. Meanwhile, the percentage of men who stayed two years or more rose from 22.1 percent to 34.5 percent. Median length of time in institutions on current stay rose to 16.1 months from 15.5 months a year earlier and 11.7 months at yearend 1974.

Length of time in correctional institutions for adult females varied considerably from year to year. The proportion of women who had been in the institution less than two years ranged from a high of 88.5 percent at year-end 1976 to a low of 74.6 percent at the end of 1978. Average (median) length of time in the institution rose from 6.7 months in 1975 to 12.5 months in 1977 before dropping to 10.3 months in 1978.

The proportion of men who had entered the institutions as new admissions rose slightly to 83.3 percent, while the percentage of newly-admitted women declined one percentage point to 93.6 percent. (Table 2)

Burglary and robbery continued to be the most prevalent offenses committed by men, 25.6 percent of the male residents having been sentenced for burglary and 25.3 percent for armed or unarmed robbery. Over one-fifth (22.2 percent) of the women were sentenced for forgery or issuing worthless checks. (Table 3)

The proportion of non-white residents declined from 43.7 percent to 40.8 percent for men and from 54.9 percent to 51.6 percent for women. (Table 4)

Median age of male residents edged up slightly to 25.8 years, while the median age of female residents declined from 27.1 years to 26.4 years. Since 1975, the median age of females has remained higher than that of males. (Table 5)

Median length of sentence for men declined for the third successive year, dropping from 5.5 years to 5.4 years. Median length of sentence for women declined for the first time during the five-year period, dropping from 5.0 years to 3.8 years. (Table 6)

Milwaukee County was the committing county for 46.7 percent of the men and 52.4 percent of the women. Both percentages were the lowest during the five-year period. (Table 7)

For the fourth successive year, median time in the institution increased for men, rising from 15.5 months to 16.1 months. By contrast, median time in the institution for women declined from 12.5 months to 10.3 months. One—third of the females resident on December 31, 1978, had been in the institution less than six months, compared with 20 percent a year earlier, while the proportion of women resident for one year or more dropped from 51.1 percent to 43.7 percent. (Table 8)

RESIDENTS IN COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL RESIDENTIAL CENTERS

There were 73 men and 21 women resident in Community Correctional Residential Centers on December 31, 1978. All but one of the 94 persons had been committed for felonies, 80.9 percent were from Milwaukee, and nearly three-fourths (73.4 percent) were non-white.

Average (median) age of the individuals in residential centers was slightly higher than that of institution residents at 26.2 years for men and 26.9 years for women. Median length of sentence was also slightly higher, at 5.6 years for men and 4.3 years for women. The men had been institutionalized for an average (median) of 25.5 months and the women for an average of 19 months.
