The State Supervisory Board members are set out on Exhibit 4.

Official Bond:

The surety bonds are set out on Exhibit 5.

Statutory Provisions:

The Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency (ALEPA) evolved from the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended. Under this act the authority to establish the ALEPA was vested in the Governor. On November 14, 1968, Executive Order Number eight established the ALEPA, and a State Supervisory Board was created with members from all areas of the State. Supervisory Board members are appointed by the Governor and represent police, courts, corrections, juvenile justice, state and public agencies, city and county governments, and the general citizenry.

Executive Order Number eleven, dated April 22, 1969, established a State Executive Committee to review and either approve or deny applications from local and state units of government for financial assistance. This executive order also divided the state into seven geographical areas designated as Law Engorcement Planning Regions.

The Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency presently operates under the provision of Act 820, Acts of Alabama 1978, pages 1195-1207.

Audit Comments:

Board Minutes: The minutes appeared to reflect the official actions of the Board; however a quorum was not present at one Grievance Committee meeting, the minutes of three Grievance Committee meetings were not approved, the Juvenile Justice Committee minutes were not approved, and one set of the Juvenile Justice Committee minutes was not signed by the chairman or secretary. Also, one set of Management Information System Task Force minutes was not signed by the chairman.

Receipts: Receipts consisted of Federal funds, State funds and subgrantee refunds. Part of the Federal funds received were not deposited in the State Treasury but were deposited in commercial banks. These were

561 20 discretionary grant funds awarded by the U. S. Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) to the ALEPA.

<u>Disbursements:</u> Sample disbursement vouchers were examined for coding, legality and mathematical accuracy. The audit disclosed that the Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency Audit Division maintains a supply of blank travel vouchers signed by the field auditors and the chief auditor.

Discretionary Grants: The Law Enforcement Assistance Administration can, at its discretion, directly fund projects of state and local units of government. These grants are termed discretionary. The following eight grants awarded the ALEPA were either continued or terminated during our audit period.

1. and 2. Implementation of the Alabama Juvenile Justice Master Plan (72-ED-04-0026) and (73-ED-04-0016):

The purpose of these grants was to enable the State of Alabama to implement its Juvenile Justice Master Plan. Exhibits 6, 11 and 12 show the financial operation for the audited period. No disbursements were made from these grants after the 1975-76 fiscal year.

The files of these grants were reviewed and the following was found:

- a. Prior audit adjustments were not entered on the books nor were all transactions during the audit period entered on the accounting records.
- b. The grant obligation balance shown as a liability on the September 30, 1977, Balance Sheet represents unspent funds that should be returned by the subgrantees to the Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency.

3. Alabama Diversion Investigative Unit (76-AS-10):

This action grant continues the original discretionary grant 72-DF-04-0072, Alabama Diversion Investigative Unit. This grant was to provide a unit of investigators trained to investigate cases of controlled substances diverted from legitimate professional channels of distribution to an illicit market. Exhibits 7, 13 and 14 show the financial operation for the audit period. This grant closed out in fiscal year 1976-77.

4. Statistical Analysis Center (75-SS-04-0003):

The purpose of this grant was to establish a statistical analysis center which will serve as a focal point for criminal justice statistics throughout the state. Exhibit 15 shows the financial condition for the period audited. This grant closed out during the 1975-76 fiscal year. The files on this grant were reviewed and it was found that persons whose signatures were not on bank signature cards signed checks.

5., 6., 7. and 8. Alabama Standards and Goals (74-DF-04-0013) (74-ED-04-0003) (76-DF-04-0001) and (76-ED-04-0001):

The purpose of these grants was to initiate the development of a program to evaluate criminal justice standards and goals for the State of Alabama. Exhibits 16 through 21 show the financial operation for the audit period. These grants were closed out during the 1976-77 fiscal year.

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The files on these grants were reviewed and it was found that fifteen blank checks were missing; no explanation was given.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that:

Committee minutes be signed by their respective chairman and recording secretary.

No official business be done in a committee meeting unless a quorum is present.

Committee minutes be approved by their respective committee.

The practice of keeping signed blank travel vouchers on hand be discontinued.

Charges Against Officials:

Funds available to the ALEPA consisted of Federal awards and State contributions. All expenditures are subject to the approval of the Federal Government. At the time of this report, it is not known if any expenditures will be disallowed.

There are no charges made against officials in this report. transactions disallowed by the Federal Government could become charges if the State suffers a loss.

CERTIFICATE:

Our examination was made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, and accordingly included such tests of the accounting records and such other auditing procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

In our opinion, the financial statements listed in the table of contents present fairly the financial position of the various funds of the Alabama Law Enforcement Planning Agency at September 30, 1977, and the results of operations of such funds for the year then ended, in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles applied on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year.
