# DEFINITION OF RECIDIVISM

The return to a Washington State adult correctional facility of an offender who had been paroled or discharged from such a facility, the return occurring within five years of release, as a result of a conviction for a new felony or violation of a condition of parole.

### FIVE-YEAR RATES OF RECIDIVISM FOR PRISONERS RELEASED

### FROM A WASHINGTON STATE ADULT CORRECTIONAL FACILITY

### FROM FY 1960 THROUGH FY1976

For purposes of this mini-study, recidivism is defined as the return to a Washington State adult correctional facility of an offender who had been paroled or discharged from such a facility, the return occurring within five years of release as the result of conviction of a new felony or violation of a condition of parole. This definition is not meant to be a strict measure of success for releases as it does not include subsequent commitments to other correctional jurisdictions. The concern in this study is limited to the impact of recidivism on the Washington State prison population. A five-year follow-up period is incorporated into the definition because nearly all returns to prison occur within five years at risk. The current prison population projection also uses a five-year time span to project recommitments.

Rates of return are included for all inmates who were either paroled or discharged during the FY1960-1976 period, FY76 being the most recent fiscal year to allow five years at risk by August 31, 1981, the cut-off date in this study.

Over the FY1960-76 period, 36.2 percent of all releases were returned within five years. These rates varied from a high of 41.0 percent for FY1964 to a low of 31.9 percent for FY1971. For releasees who had been imprisoned for person-related crimes, the overall recidivism rate was 29.4 percent with a high of 37.9 for FY1966 and a low of 18.5 percent for FY1960. The comparable rates for non-person offenders were an average of 38.0 percent, a high of 43.7 percent (FY1964) and a low of 32.6 percent (FY1975). These return rates, by year of release, are given in Table 1 and Figures 1, 2 and 3.

In general, the return rates during the seventies were lower than those for the sixties for non-person offenders, although the last year shows a substantial increase. Person offenders do not reflect quite such a long-term trend, but the last several years show a tendency to increasing rates. The return rates for all releasees, therefore, indicate a somewhat declining trend due to the greater impact of non-person offenders offset somewhat by the increasing rates for person offenders.

Table 2 gives the summary raw data from which the return rates where calculated. Tables 3 through 19 give the return rates, by major offense category, for each individual fiscal year.


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


