

ACQUISITIONS

The earnings of parolees for the calendar year 1981 are compiled, classified and capsulated from data submitted by the nine district parole offices in the Bureau of Parole. (See attached table)

There were 11,998 parolees under supervision in New Jersey in 1981 (an increase of 477 from 1980) and they earned, as qualified herewith \$33,166,411.

In comparison to 1980 this was an increase of \$3,845,172.

Forty-seven percent (5,720) of those under supervision during the year were classified as employed (worked all or part of the period under supervision, which period of supervision could be from one week to the full year) and twenty-five percent (2,943) were unemployed throughout their entire period of supervision, although employable. The other twenty-eight percent (3,335) were classified as unemployable by reason of being missing or in custody for the entire period of supervision during the year, or attending school, being engaged in home-making, or being incapacitated.

Fifty-two percent of the 11,998 parolees supervised were under supervision for a period of 10 months to the full year in 1981; 14% from 7 months to 9 months; 16% from 4 months to 6 months; and 18% from 1 day to 3 months. Caution should be used in drawing inferences from the foregoing data and accordingly the average earnings of employed parolees is presented below for comparative purposes only.
