

CRIME IN DELAWARE 1981

Two widely used indicators of crime are the number of complaints reported to the police and the number of arrests made by the police.

This report compares the levels of these indicators, complaints, adult arrests and juvenile arrests for 1981 to the levels experienced in the previous five years, 1976 through 1980.

The report focuses upon the seven major crime offenses which comprise the major crime index. These offenses are

1) Murder, 2) Rape, 3) Robbery, 4) Aggravated Assault, Burglary, 6) Larceny and 7) Motor Vehicle Theft.

The comparisons of 1981 crime levels to 1976-80 levels will cover each offense and each category. For example, murder offenses, adult arrests for murder, and juvenile arrests for murder. The number of events experienced in each group for 1981 will be compared to the general "trend" or pattern of events which has occurred from 1976 through 1980. This trend is used to predict the number of occurances we might have expected for 1981, by comparing the prediction to the actual events for 1981 we may determine if the trend is continuing or changing.

Each graph of an offense group depicts two lines. The line denoted by "+++" is the straight trend line and indicates the

general direction of events over time, either constant, upward or declining. The monthly average line depicted by "000" shows the average movement around the trend. Note this line is a smoothed average line and does not depict the actual number of events but only the general movements of events over time.

A problem which constantly occurs in any description of Delaware crime is the ability to express differences in crime occurance, for example, Murder. Due to the relatively low number of occurances in some categories an increase of only one or two events may precipitate a large relative, or percentage, increase. The reader should bear this in mind when making conclusions regarding the state of crime in Delaware and is cautioned to compare any relative change in crime occurance with the number of events.

SYNOPSIS

Trends are based on average monthly events.

Trend

MURDER

Complaints. Murder complaints are stable at approximately 3 per month. This trend continued through 1981.

Adult Arrests. Adult Murder arrests have declined moderately over the years 1976-1980. Arrests for 1981 indicate a change towards more arrests.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile arrests for Murder are a rare occurance in any month. Two arrests per year are expected annually. This trend continued in 1981.

RAPE

Complaints. Rape offenses have increased moderately over the years 1976-1980. Offenses reported in 1981 indicate a continuance of the increasing trend.

Addt Arrests. Arrests for Rape have experienced large increases from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 indicate a continuance of the rising trend.

Juvenile Arrests. Few Juveniles are arrested for Rape. The number of arrests from 1976-1980 has shown a relatively large increase. Arrests in 1981 continued this trend.

ROBBERY

Complaints. Robbery complaints showed a very slight decline from 1976 to 1980. Complaints for 1981 indicated a shift toward more offenses.

Adult Arrests. Adult arrests have been constant from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 remained at the constant level.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile arrests have declined slightly from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 continue to decline at the same rate.

Trend

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

Complaints. Aggravated Assaults climbed steadily for a very large increase from 1976 to 1980. Complaints for 1981 deviate from the increasing trend and suggest stabilization. This is partially due to a change in the definition of Aggravated Assaults which occurred in 1979.

Adult Arrests. Arrests for Aggravated Assaults have shown a large increase from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 indicate this trend is continuing.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile arrests have shown a large steady growth from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1980 indicate a shift in this trend toward fewer juvenile arrests per month.

TOTAL VIOLENT CRIME. Violent Crime is the Composite of Murder, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assault.

Complaints. Complaints for Violent Offenses have indicated a large increase from 1976 to 1980. Reported offenses in 1981 deviate from this trend and appear to be leveling.

Adult Arrests. Arrests for Violent Crime has shown a large increase from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 indicated a continuation of this growth.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile Arrests have shown a moderate increase from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 are significantly fewer than the 1976-1980 trend.

BURGLARY

Complaints. Burglary Complaints have been constant from 1976 to 1980. Reported offenses in 1981 have shifted toward more offenses however.

Adult Arrests. Adult Arrests indicated a relatively large increase from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 indicate a continuing increase at the same rate.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile Arrests are constant from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 remained at the constant level.

Trend

LARCENY

Complaints. Larceny Complaints have shown very slight growth from 1976 to 1980. Reported Offenses in 1981 indicate a continuance of the growth.

Adult Arrests. Arrests for Larceny shows slight growth from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 indicate a continuation of the increasing trend.

Juvenile Arrests. The number of juvenile arrests for Larceny has declined very slightly over the years 1976-1980. Arrests in 1981 indicate an increase in arrests contrary to the thend.

MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT

Complaints. The number of Motor Vehicle Thefts has shown only a very slight increase for 1976 to 1980. Complaints for 1981 shifted toward fewer offenses.

Adult Arrests. Arrests for Motor Vehicle Theft are constant. Arrests for 1981 remained at the constant level.

Juvenile Arrests. Arrests of juveniles have remained stable from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 have shifted toward fewer arrests.

TOTAL PROPERTY CRIME. The composite of Burglary, Larceny and Motor Vehicle Theft.

Complaints. Reported offenses have shown steady growth at a very slight rate from 1976 to 1980. Complaints in 1981 indicated a continuation of the growth.

Adult Arrests. Property Crime Arrests have shown a very steady moderate growth from 1976 to 1980. Arrests in 1981 indicated a continuation of this growth.

Juvenile Arrests. Juvenile Arrests have shown a tendency to decline very slightly from 1976 to 1980. Arrests for 1981 indicated a continuation of the decline.

COMPLAINTS

For 1981 there were a total of 39,888 Crime Index Offenses reported to the police statewide. Table 1.1 is a comparison between offenses in 1981 and the average yearly number of offenses by category for 1976 to 1980.





Figure 1 MURDER RAPE ROBBERY ASSAULT BURGLARY LARCENY MY/THEFT COMPOSITION OF COMPLAINTS FOR INDEX CRIMES 1976-1980



Murder

1981 saw a total of 40 Homicide offenses reported in Delaware, compared to the five year average of 37. The trend for Murder offenses is shown in the graph, Figure 3. This graph shows the trend for Murder to be stable at approximately 3 offenses per month for the five year period, with a movement around the trend varying from 2 to 4 offenses per month. The monthly offense average for 1981 is indicated by the "X" on the plot. The comparison between the predicted number of Murder offenses for 1981 and the actual number of offenses revealed no statistically significant departure from the trend.



Rape

There were 169 Rape complaints in 1981, compared to a 5 year average of 133. The trend for Rape complaints is shown in Figure 4. This trend shows a steady growth in Rape offenses, at the rate of only one more offense per year. The comparison between the trend prediction of an average of 14 Rape offenses per month and the actual average of 14 per months shows no deviation from the 5 year trend.



Robbery

There were 838 reported Robberies in Delaware in 1981, an average of 70 per month, compared to the 5 year yearly average of 809 or 67 per month. Figure 5 is the trend of Robbery complaints over the years 1976-1980. It shows a slightly decreasing slope, at the rate of approximately 2.4 complaints per year. The movement of Robbery complaints around the trend suggest a varying cycle of complaints from a maximum average of 76 per month to a low of 58. The comparison of the trend prediction of an average of 60 complaints per month versus the actual of 70 complaints per month indicates a significant deviation from the trend and suggests a continuation of the short term upward movement noted in the last 9 months of the graph, despite the long range trend of a slight decrease. (Point A)




Aggravated Assault

There were 1,987 reported Aggravated Assaults in Delaware in 1981, an average of 166 per month, compared to the yearly average of 1,523 and monthly average of 127 noted from 1976 to 1980. Figure 6 is the graph of the trend of Aggravated Assaults and shows a steady growth over the past five years at a rate of 2.3 complaints per month or 28 per year. The comparison of the predicted offenses for 1981 of an average of 290 offenses per month and the actual rate of 245 per month indicates a significant deviation from the established trend, and suggests a new trend may be evolving from approximately 1979 onward. (Point A). However, known reporting variations in 1979 may have resulted in significant overreporting of Aggravated Assaults and the short term decline may be spurious.

Total Violent Complaints

Combining all categories of Violent Crime, (Murder, Rape, Robbery and Aggravated Assault), we find that there were 3034 reported violent offenses in Delaware for 1981, an average of 253 per month compared to a monthly average of 208.5 for the period 1976-1980.

As shown in Figure 7, the trend of violent complaints has been increasing over the past five years at a rate of 26 more complaints each year. (Notice that this pattern closely approximates the trend for Aggravated Assaults). The comparison between the predicted number of violent complaints, of an average of 290 per month for 1981 and the actual of 253 per month results in a significant deviation from the trend, and suggests a new trend which may be resulting in lower overall violent offenses, continuing a trend shift which started approximately July 1979 (Point A).



Burglary

In 1981 there were 9612 Burglary offenses reported in the State of Delaware for an average of 801 per month compared to the monthly average of 775 for the 1976-1980 period.


The five year trend for Burglary offenses shown in Figure 8 indicates a decreasing trend at a rate of approximately 6 Burglaries per year,

The predicted average of 750 offenses per month from this trend versus an actual of 801 offenses for 1981 shows a significant deviation from the trend. This deviation follows the upward curve of the average line (000) beginning around November 1979 (Point A).

Larceny

For 1981 there were 24,686 Larceny offenses reported statewide. This is an average of 2,057 per month compared to the monthly average of 1,899 for the five years 1976-1980.

The trend for Larceny has been toward steady growth particularly in the last three years of the trend. This growth has been at a rate of 4.7 more Larceny offenses per month.

The comparison between the predicted monthly average offenses of 2,044 per month and the actual number experienced in 1981 of 2,057 indicates no significant shift from the trend of increasing Larceny offenses.





Motor Vehicle Theft

There were 2556 Motor Vehicle Thefts reported Statewide in 1981 compared to a yearly average of 2792 for the years 1976-1980. The trend established for Motor Vehicle Thefts indicates a moderately increasing trend rising at a rate of 2.7 offenses per year. The predicted monthly average from this trend was 242 Motor Vehicle Thefts per month in contrast to the actual average of 213. This was a significant deviation from the trend toward fewer offenses, and is a continuation of the average line (000) which has declined since February 1979 (Point A).

Total Property Offenses

Total offenses for all property crime amounted to 36,854 for 1981, for an average of 3071 per month compared to the average of 2907 for the five preceding years.

The trend (Figure 11) for all property crime has been a steadily increasing one, at a rate of 4.4 more reported offenses per month. This trend predicted an average of 3035 property crimes per month for 1981 compared to the actual average of 3071. There was no deviation from the trend for 1981.

The composition of adult arrests for index offenses has for 1981 undergone slight alteration in comparison to the 1976-1980 time period. Figure 12 and Table 12 are the representation of the percent of all adult arrests by each category for the years 1976 through 1980. Figure 13 and Table 13 represent the composition of adult arrests for 1981. Where arrests for Murder, Rape, Robbery and Motor Vehicle Theft have remained constant for 1981, there has been a shift toward more Aggravated Assault and Burglary arrests and fewer Larceny arrests.





Murder

There were 35 adult arrests for Murder in Delaware during 1981, an average of 2.9 per month. The average number of arrests per month for the 5 years preceeding 1981 was 2.6.

The trend of adult Homicide arrests from 1976 to 1980 has been declining slightly at a low rate of only 1 arrest every 3 years. The predicted average monthly arrests for 1981 was 1.3 arrests per month. The experienced average of 2.9 was a significant shift from this trend toward more arrests, continuing the upswing noticed in the average line (000) which begins approximately January 1980. (Point A)



Rape



Robbery

A total of 209 adults were arrested in 1981 for Robbery for an average of 17.4 per month. The five year monthly average from 1976 to 1980 was 15.1. Over these five years the general trend has been relatively stable, increasing at a small rate of one additional arrest every three years, however the movement around the trend has been varied.

The difference between the actual number of adult Robbery arrests, 17.4 per month to the predicted average of 15.6 from the trend line is not large enough to indicate any divergence from the trend and may indeed be a downturn from the peak in the average line (000) noticed at the end of the trend period.



Aggravated Assault

In 1981 there were 743 Adult Arrests for Aggravated Assault, an average of 62 arrests per month. The previous five years had indicated a monthly average of 43.5 per month.




Burglary











Rape










