The size of the criminal justice collection (books, periodicals, AV materials) is indicated as well as special interest areas(s). In addition, online, interlibrary loan, and microfiche capabilities, as well as other services, are described, and any restrictions on the use of library facilities or holdings are explained. Additional information is included under "notes."

At the back of the *Directory* is a listing of 49 GPO Regional Depository Libraries, which permanently hold all documents selected for the Depository Program, including many criminal justice documents. As regional depositories, they also provide reference service and interlibrary loan. Some of these are CJIE members and are so indicated with an asterisk(*).
